The format utilized with the Criminal Code provisions has been applied to the related statutes. Accordingly, each of the acts in volume 6 has been annotated with cross-references, related sections and statutes, history, annotations and articles, and case law digests classified by section and topic. All statutory amendments and all case law updates to June 1993 have been incorporated into this volume.

Attention Subscribers

The CASE LAW and ANNOTATIONS AND ARTICLES in Volume 1 to 4 will be updated to April 1993 in **the first of Crankshaw's bound supplements** to be published by the end of August 1993. Looseleaf replacement pages will be utilized to update the statutory provisions including newly proclaimed sections. As a result researching Crankshaw's Criminal Code will require just two steps, referencing the volumes of the main work and the bound supplements.

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
