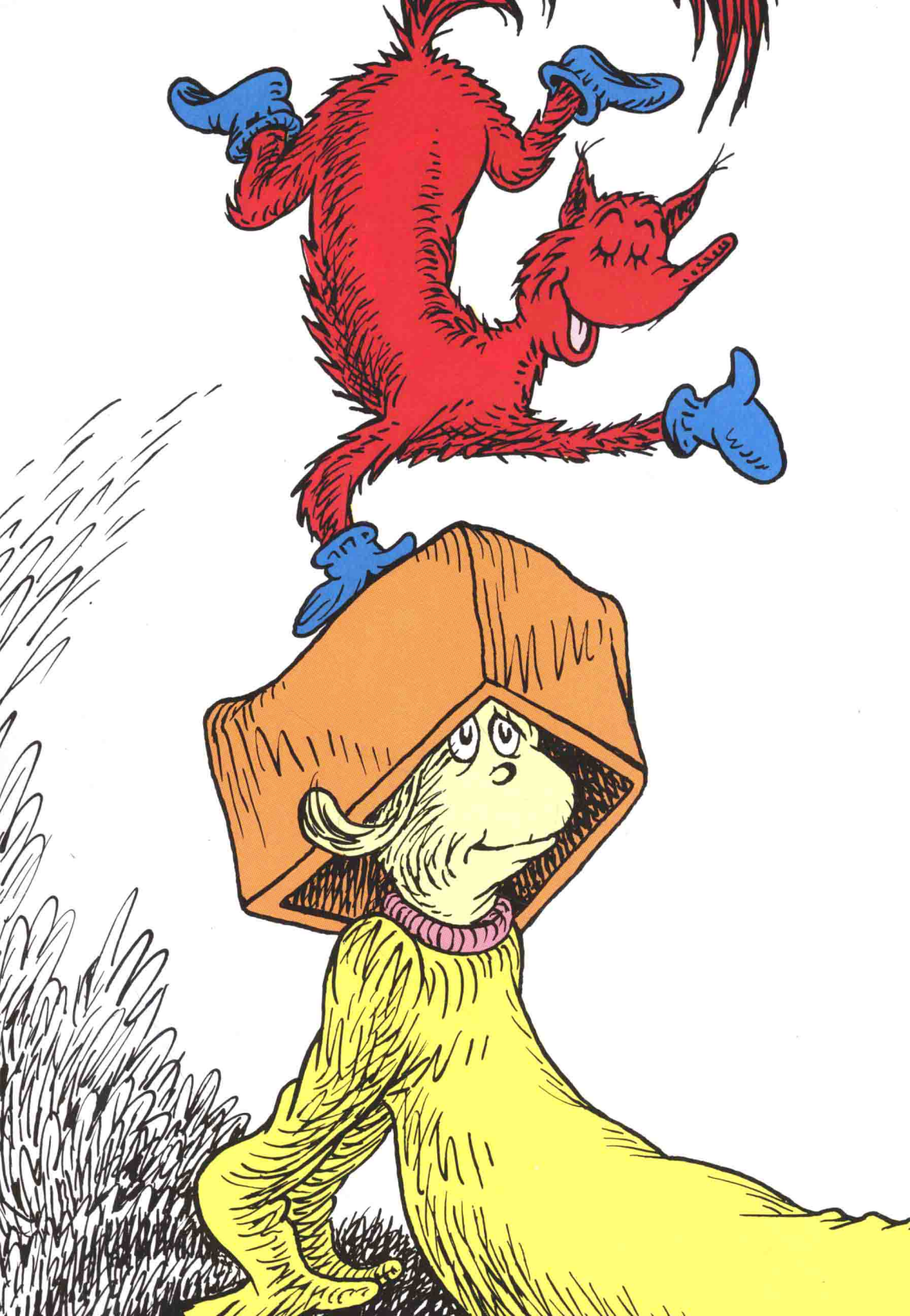


Knox in box.

in socks in box.

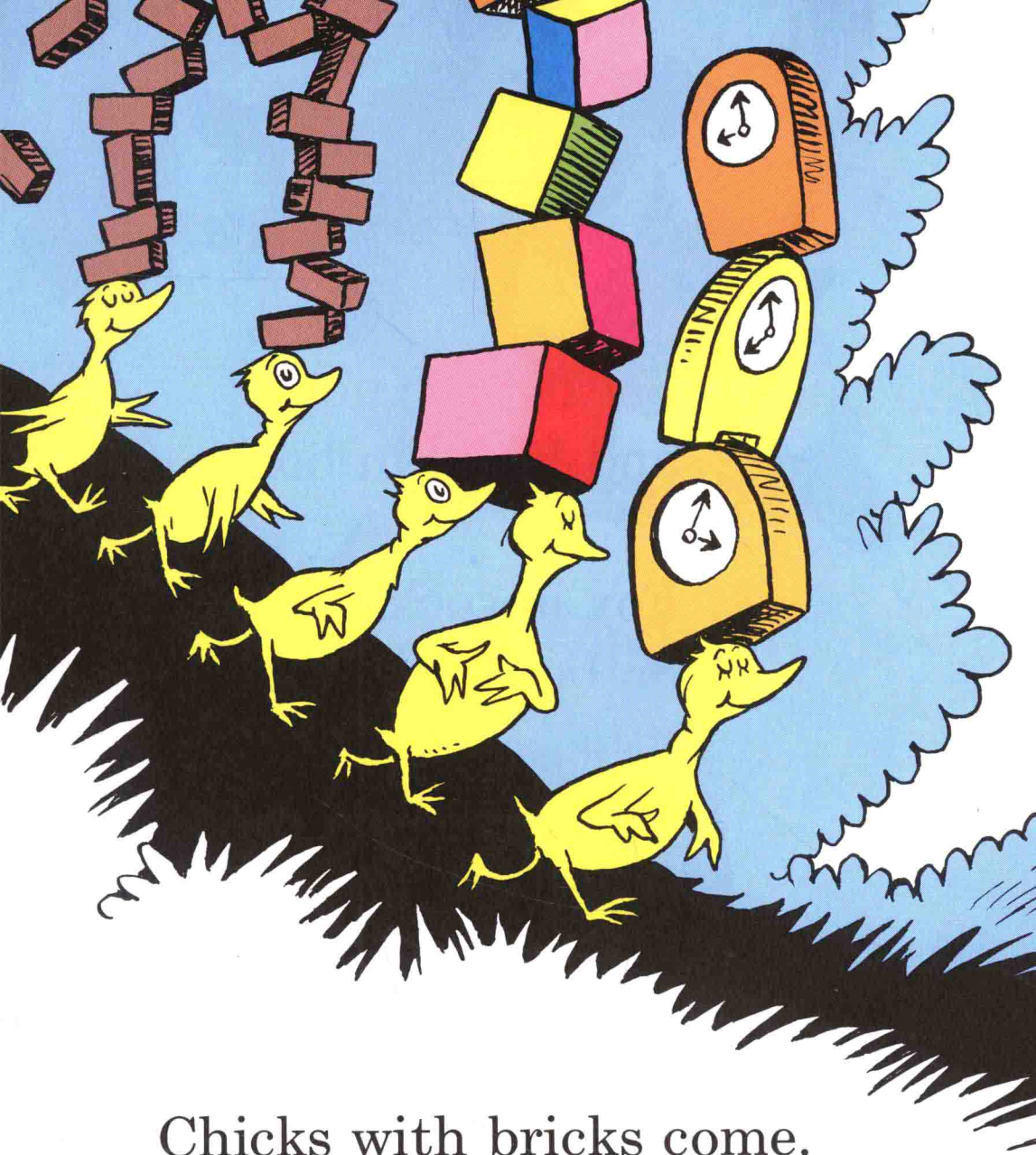




Socks on Knox

on box on Knox.



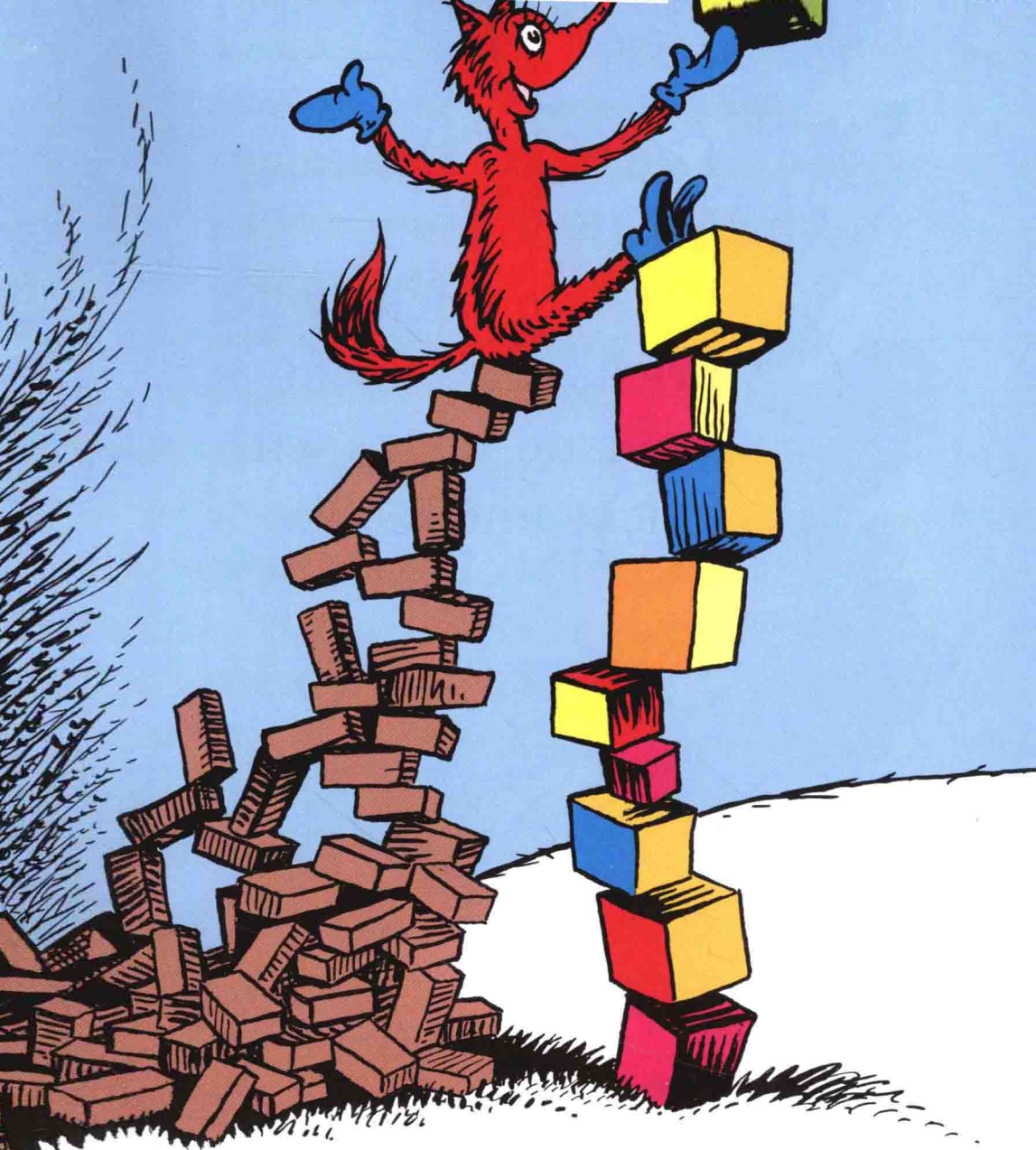


Chicks with bricks come.

blocks and clocks come.



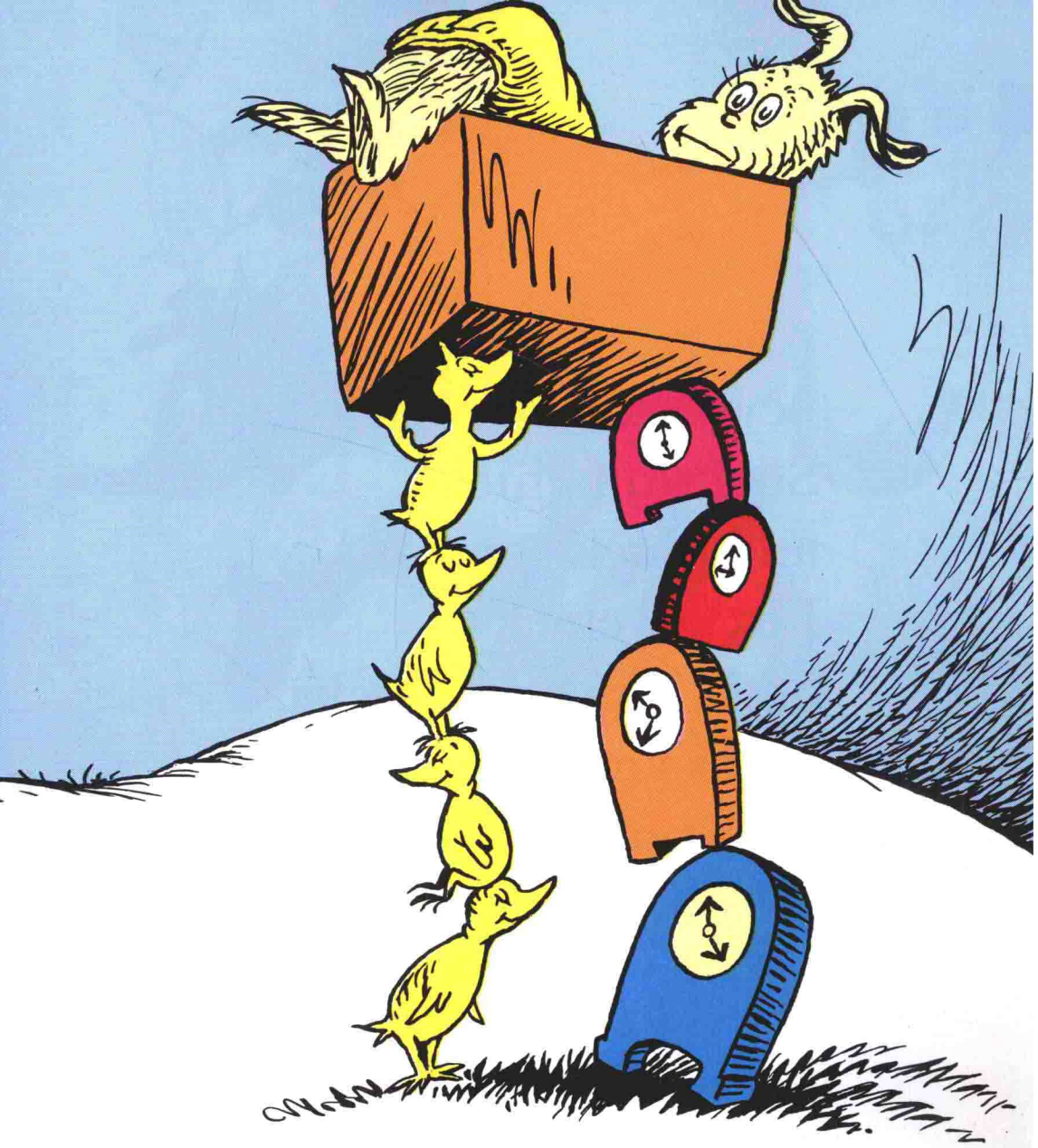
Look, sir. Look, sir.

chicks and clocks, sir.





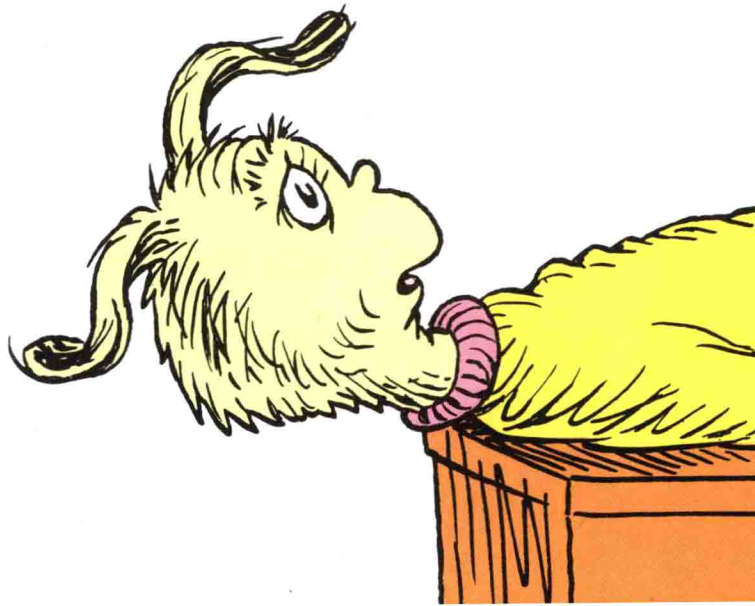
First, I'll make a

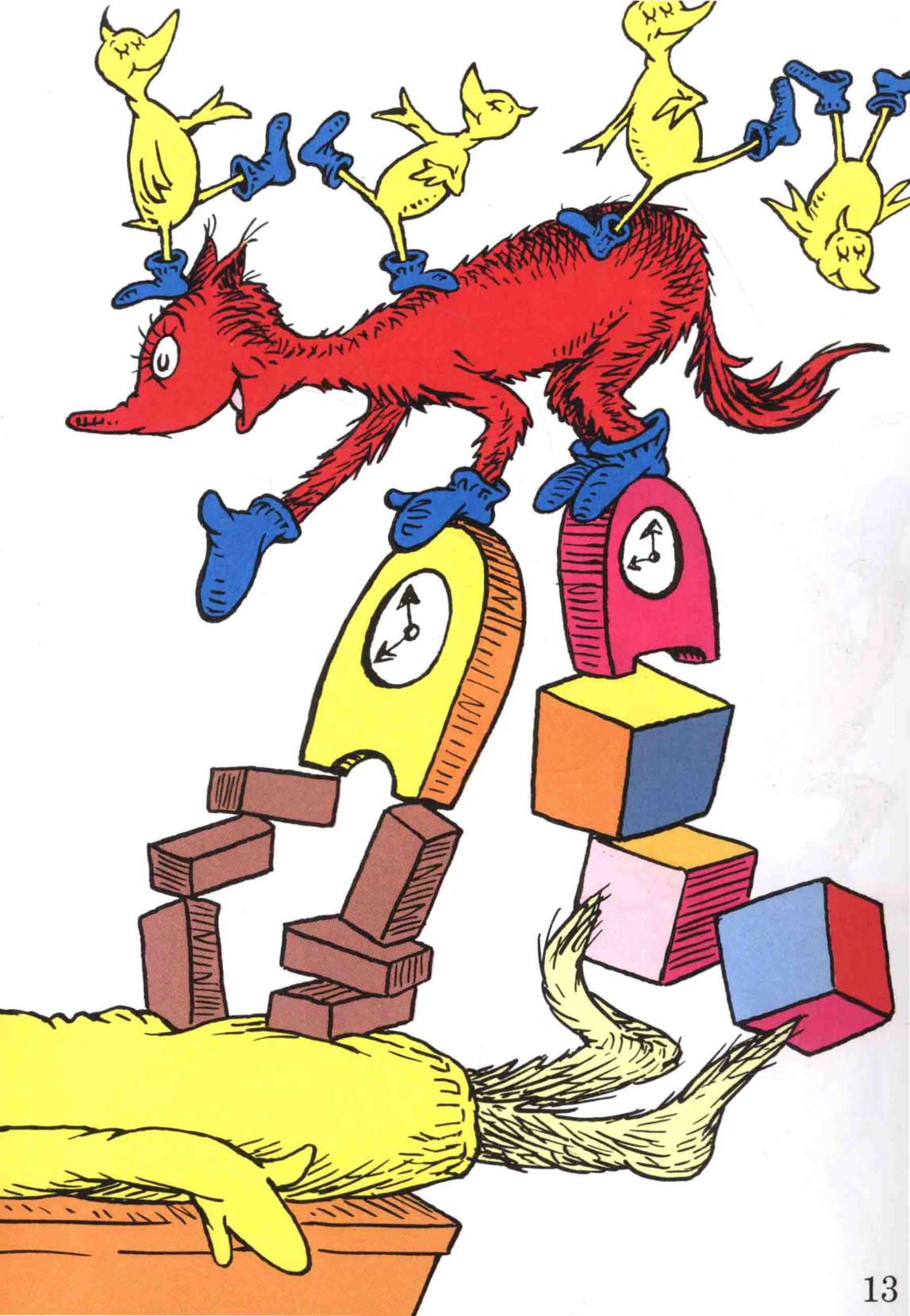


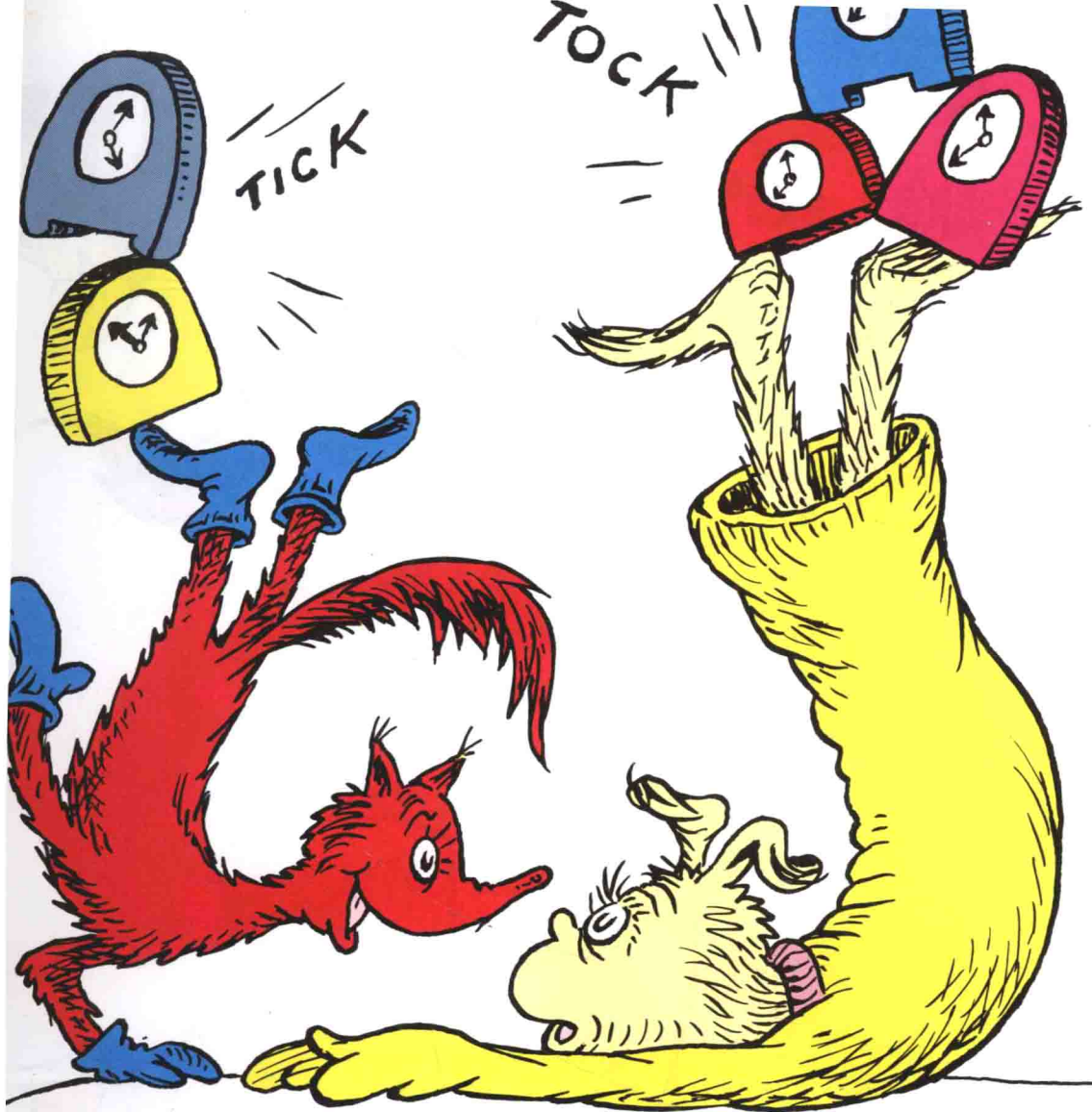
