

FOREWORD

“Criminal Law,” comprising the major part of original Volume 21 of *Am Jur 2d*, has been an active area of the law. The activity of the legislatures and the courts in this area since the publication of the original volume in 1965 mandates the rewriting of this much grown topic, and Volume 21 is now reissued as Volumes 21 and 21A.

Attention is specifically directed to the following areas of rapid growth and change in “Criminal Law”: the relief of victims under the Uniform Crime Victims Reparations Act and similar legislation; the capacity to commit crimes, or to be tried or punished therefor (the insanity issue); defenses, such as entrapment and former jeopardy; the rights of an accused under the federal and state constitutions, as interpreted in numerous landmark decisions of the United States Supreme Court; procedural matters, including jurisdiction, venue, pleas and the withdrawal thereof; sentencing and punishment, including probation under various conditions such as restitution to the victim or consent to future searches; and the application of modern technology in the courtroom, including broadcasting or televising court proceedings, testimony by closed-circuit television, and videotape recordings of depositions. These and other changes have resulted in a completely rewritten and greatly expanded article.

The article “Customs Duties and Import Regulations,” as rewritten, reflects increasing litigation under the Federal Anti-Dumping Act (19 USCS §§ 160-173), and with respect to applicable searches and seizures, including problems arising in connection with border searches and strip and body searches.

The topics “Creditors’ Bills,” “Crops,” and “Customs and Usages,” appearing in original Volume 21, have also been completely researched and rewritten in the light of subsequent statutes and decisions, and are now reissued in these new volumes.
