INTRODUCTION

With the accession of the United Kingdom to the European Communities on I January 1973, English law came into that unique relationship with Community law which is one of the principal features of the legal structure of the Communities. Community law in the form of both treaty provisions and secondary legislation became part of English law with the added obligation of making those changes to English law necessary to comply with the terms of membership. English lawyers are, therefore, faced with the unprecedented challenge of a large and steadily increasing body of law which is unfamiliar to them in terms of philosophy, content and format.

The primary purpose of Halsbury's Statutes of England has always been to render easily available the correct and amended text of enactments; here that purpose is extended to the Law of the European Communities. The aim of this volume is to make that law available and accessible to English lawyers.

The quantity of Community law and the limited application of some of its specialist areas demanded selection. This has been done in an attempt to reduce the bulk of material to manageable size whilst at the same time attempting to cover all aspects which a practitioner is likely to want. Included in this volume are those materials which the Editors believe to be either of a fundamental nature or of general legal significance. Three types of treatment are adopted in relation to such material. (1) The Treaties themselves and so much of the secondary legislation as relates to the constitution and objectives of the Communities or which are likely to affect individuals or corporate bodies are printed in full with annotations in the usual Halsbury style. (2) In other cases where the practitioner needs to be made aware of the scope of a branch of Community law, but its nature does not justify the reproduction of the complete texts, annotated summaries are printed. (3) In certain cases it has been thought sufficient merely to list subordinate instruments under the text, or summary of the text, of the empowering legislation. But in all cases, both the reference to the Official Journal of the European Communities is given, so that the text may be quickly found, and any amendments are noted (and will continue to be noted in the supplement to this volume). Provisions which make temporary adjustments or are concerned with matters which are subject to frequent changes are not dealt with in this work.

The arrangement and terminology of the law of the European Communities will be unfamiliar to most English lawyers and may provide a stumbling-block to ascertaining the relevant Community law and placing it in relation to English law. In order to help the practitioner overcome such initial difficulties the material contained in this volume has been arranged under the most appropriate of the familiar Halsbury titles. Cross-references to implementing United Kingdom legislation have been given throughout the volume.

This volume contains Community law made between the years 1952–1972; amendments to that law made up to the time of going to press have been incorporated or noted. The annotations to the texts which are printed or summarised include the case law of the Court of Justice of the Communities. In the absence of an authorised English text of most of the Court's judgments, reference is made to the Common Market Law Reports. The annotations also include references to the growing body of United Kingdom case law on Community

matters.

Note 1: The Official Journal. The Official Journal is published in two series: the "L" (Legislation) series and the "C" (Communications and Information) series. Both series are published in each of the official languages of the Communities. The references are identical for all the different language versions.

Secondary legislation of the Communities made before the date of accession of the new Member States (I January 1973) and still in force after that date was published in a Special Edition of the Official Journal in the Danish and English languages. Certain texts which were not included in the original Special Edition have been, or are to be, published in a Second Series of the Special Edition. At the time of going to press the Second Series had not completed publication.

NOTE 2: SECONDARY LEGISLATION.

A. REGULATIONS

- From 1958 to 1967. Regulations were numbered in two separate sequences, one for EEC and one for Euratom, as follows:
 - (a) From 1958 to 1962. EEC and Euratom Regulations were numbered in separate sequences from No. 1 onwards, each sequence of numbers being continuous throughout the five-year period. References are given thus:

EEC Council Reg. 17 of 6 February 1962. Euratom Council Reg. 4 of 15 September 1958.

(b) From 1963 to 1967. Each sequence of numbers recommended at No. 1 in each year, the number being followed by the appropriate year date and the name of the relevant Community. References are given thus:

Reg. 204/64/EEC. Reg. 11/64 Euratom.

(2) From 1968 onwards. All Regulations of both EEC and Euratom have been numbered in one single sequence of Regulations. The numbers recommence at No. 1 each year, and are followed by the year date. The name or names of the relevant Communities precede the number. References are given thus:

Reg. (EEC) 1629/70Reg. (Euratom) 1372/72 in the same sequence.

(But, as stated at point B (2) below, in the case of those ECSC Decisions which are included in the Regulations sequences, the name of the Community follows the date.)

B. DECISIONS, DIRECTIVES AND OTHER INSTRUMENTS

- (1) Until the end of 1967, Decisions and Directives were grouped in separate sequences for each of the three Communities:
 - (a) EEC and Euratom, 1958 to 1962. Decisions and Directives were un-numbered, and are identified only by their title, date and Community. References are given thus:

EEC Council Decision of 9 October 1961 on standardisation of the duration of trade agreements with third countries.

Euratom Council Directive of 5 March 1962 amending Annexes 1 and 3 to the Directives laying down the basic standards for health protection.

(b) EEC and Euratom 1963 to 1967. Each Community numbered its Decisions and Directives in a separate sequence which also covered Resolutions, Recommendations, Financial Regulations, Opinions, draft Decisions, draft Directives, and draft Regulations. The numbers recommence at No. 1 each year. The year date precedes the number and is followed by the name of the Community. References are given thus:

Dec. 63/21/EEC
Dir. 66/400/EEC
Dec. 63/27/Euratom

in the same sequence.

Dec. 63/27/Euratom
Dir. 66/45/Euratom

in the same sequence.

(c) ECSC 1952 to 1967.

(i) High Authority. Decisions were numbered in annual sequences, the numbering recommencing at No. 1 each year, and incorporating the year date. References are given thus:

ECSC High Authority Dec. 18-64.

Recommendations were numbered similarly, though in their own sequence. References are given thus:

ECSC High Authority Rec. 1-61.

(ii) Special Council of Ministers. Decisions and Agreements were un-numbered, and are identified by title and date only. References are given thus:

Decision of 22 May 1962 of ECSC Special Council of Ministers determining the emoluments of members of the High Authority.

(2) From 1968 onwards. All Decisions and Directives of all three Communities have been numbered in *one* sequence which also includes Recommendations, Opinions and Financial Regulations. The numbers recommence at No. 1 each year, preceded by the year date, and followed by the name of the Community or Communities. References are given thus:

Dec. 70/381/EECDir. 72/182/Euratom } in the same sequence

A few ECSC Decisions after 1968 are included in the Regulations sequence of numbering. (see point A (2) above)
An example is:

Dec. 3/71/ECSC.

(Note the different position of the year date and Community name.)

All Financial Regulations are included in the annual Decisions and Directives sequence. An example is:

Financial Regulation 72/19/Euratom/ECSC/EEC.
