# FOREWORD

There has been a dramatic increase in legal activity over the past several years which has created a demand for a bibliography of law related materials that is comprehensive and is updated frequently, accurately, and dependably on an ongoing basis. In 1981 R. R. Bowker responded to this challenge by introducing *Law Books 1876-1981*, the most extensive bibliography of the legal field ever published. This was a comprehensive work capable of forming the basis upon which an efficient bibliographic updating service could be based. Approximately one year after the introduction of this basic work, R. R. Bowker introduced a bibliographic updating service consisting of two types of publications: *Law Information* and *Law Information Update*. *Law Information 1982* was the first of a series of annuals cumulating the bibliographic information published during a given year and providing current information on law and related books and serials in print. *Law Information Update*, first published in January, 1983, provided information on forthcoming law and related titles ten months a year. When combined with *Law Books 1876-1981* these publications promise to fully meet the demands of the legal profession for a detailed and current bibliography of law and law related materials.

The latest annual cumulation, *Bowker's Law Books and Serials in Print 1984-1985* contains some 53,166 in-print titles and approximately 6,300 Library of Congress subject headings. As in *Law Books 1876-1981* there are indexes for locating authors, titles, subjects, publishers, and serials. In addition, each bibliographic entry in each index contains full information. There is also a law catalog index which continues the coverage of Library of Congress cataloged entries since *Law Information 1983* was published. These cataloged entries will include those which appeared in the *American Book Publishing Record* and MARC August 1983 through August 1984. The scope of cataloged titles includes English titles worldwide. Additional effort was also made to collect relevant United Nations publications and government publications—state, local and federal. In addition to other sources, federal government titles were selected from the Government Publications Office Published Reference File.

Throughout *Bowker's Law Books and Serials in Print 1984-1985* there is evidence of a conscious effort on the part

of the publisher to be attentive to the many details which are a necessary part of the development of quality publications. As with *Law Books 1876-1981*, I had the opportunity to view this publication in various stages of its development and am aware of the care taken by the staff at R. R. Bowker to ensure this work would meet their high standards.

One of the problems concerning bibliographic literature in the area under discussion which was deemed very critical by many of those making comments and responding to questionnaires is the lack of current bibliographic information available in law and related areas on an ongoing basis. One typical respondent to the questionnaire concerning *Law Information 1982* commented that "currency, fast cumulation, and good subject headings are the three most important aspects of this type of service... If you could put the package together... [I would be] willing to use your service exclusively."

Such strong sentiment was an indication that R. R. Bowker would be providing the legal profession a great service if it would develop a publication designed to provide bibliographic and cataloging information on a frequent and ongoing basis to those in law and law related fields. After carefully reviewing data related to the questionnaires and interviews it was decided to publish *Law Information Update* in addition to the annuals in order to fulfill a need so clearly felt by so many.

*Bowker's Law Books and Serials in Print Update*, appearing as ten issues a year in an arrangement corresponding to *Bowker's Law Books and Serials in Print*, is designed to provide the current bibliographic and category information concerning new and forthcoming books, pamphlets, serials, and other materials in law and areas related to law on a continuing and timely basis.

Law librarians need a bibliographic information service which they can depend upon to provide accurate information quickly on an ongoing basis. Many of them are constantly being asked about books and other materials which have either just been published or are about to be published and can ill afford the luxury of withholding their answers until a bibliography containing the answer arrives at some later date. To ensure that their bibliographies of law and law

related materials will be accurate, timely, and ongoing, R. R. Bowker has created an extensive network to be used for maintaining contact with a broad range of publishers of materials in law and fields related to law. This network goes far beyond those publishers who are primarily concerned with only legal materials.

Given the enormous commitment in time and resources, both financial and bibliographic, required to produce works such as those being discussed here it is not surprising that a law bibliographic information service of this magnitude has been produced by a publisher such as R. R. Bowker. This publisher has several large bibliographic databases already in place featuring comprehensive, accurate, verified and machine-readable data. It is also supported by over a century's experience in producing publications in special areas of knowledge.

By listening again to the needs of those using law and law related materials on a regular basis; by continuing to impose high standards to the collection and organization of data included in various publications comprising its bibliographic information service for law and law related areas; and by responding to those who have voiced so strongly a need for an extensive bibliographic information service for law and related areas which will provide currency and fast cumulation, R. R. Bowker has made an outstanding contribution to the bibliographic literature of law and related fields.

# PREFACE

In December 1981 the R. R. Bowker Company published *Law Books 1876-1981*, a retrospective subject bibliography of 130,000 law and law-related titles. This four volume set was considered "... the most extensive subject survey of the legal field ever published."<sup>1</sup> The positive response to the scope and comprehensiveness of *Law Books 1876-1981* coupled with the many requests from law librarians for a regular publication covering current information led the R. R. Bowker Company to publish a new annual entitled *Law Information 1982: Current Books, Pamphlets, Serials*. *Bowker's Law Books and Serials in Print 1984-1985* is the 3rd edition of this annual.

*Bowker's Law Books and Serials in Print 1984-1985* is designed to provide all forms of printed information in a comprehensive package. In the tradition of the R. R. Bowker Company, publishers of *Books In Print*, *Ulrich's International Periodicals Directory* and the *American Book Publishing Record* this bibliography is as complete as possible, covering law in its entirety as well as law-related subjects. This high standard was achieved through extensive research and qualified staff.

## *Why Bowker is publishing current law information.*

For some years Bowker has been made aware by the professional library community of the need for current, regularly updated information for law libraries. It was natural for law librarians to express this need to the publisher of *Books in Print*, *American Book Publishing Record* and *Associations' Publications in Print*.

Development of a new reference work at Bowker involves extensive study and consultation to assure that there is a need for the publication and that it will be designed to best meet the needs of the potential user. Before deciding to publish *Law Books 1876-1981* we surveyed professional librarians involved in research in law and related subjects to determine their attitudes and outlook toward the publication of the retrospective law bibliography and subsequently to current bibliographic services in law. A major number of those queried urged Bowker to publish current law information as well as the retrospective bibliography.

After the publication of *Law Books 1876-1981* another survey was made to this audience attempting to confirm the need for current information. Once again a major number of law librarians queried told us of their need for high quality comprehensive, up to date information, acknowledged that the services we described were superior to those then available, and said they would purchase *Law Information 1982* and *Law Information Update* (a monthly supplement first published in January 1983).

## ACQUISITION OF DATA

Titles for *Bowker's Law Books and Serials in Print 1984-1985* were examined for eligibility and selected from several bibliographic databases: the Books In Print Database, the American Book Publishing Record Database, the Associations' Publications Database, the Library of Congress MARC (machine readable cataloging) Tapes, and the United States Government Printing Office's Publications Reference File. In addition, special efforts were made to solicit legal titles from publishers known to specialize in law to insure complete coverage of their publications. Publishers whose titles appeared in *Law Information 1983* were also mailed lists of their entries and were asked to update them as necessary. These changes are reflected in *Bowker's Law Books and Serials in Print 1984-1985*. Many English language foreign legal publications have also been included. In some cases, these titles may be found twice, once as supplied by the originating foreign publisher, once with the U.S. distributor given.

Publishers who did not respond to the requests directly were identified on the *Books In Print* and *Associations' Publications* databases and relative titles were selected for inclusion in *Bowker's Law Books and Serials in Print*.

Entries for the Serials section were selected from the Bowker International Serials database. These entries have been included in and/or received since publication of *Ulrich's International Periodicals Directory*, 23rd edition; *Irregular Serials and Annuals*, 10th edition; and *Ulrich's Quarterly*; Vol. 8, No. 3.

Due to the inclusion of entries beyond Library of Congress' cataloging scheme, this bibliography expands coverage over *Law Books 1876-1981* in such areas as banking law, consumer law, international economics, international relations, nuclear energy law, international policy rules and regulations and tax law.

## CONTENT AND ARRANGEMENT OF ENTRIES

*Bowker's Law Books and Serials in Print 1984-1985* includes some 53,166 entries. Complete entries appear in all book indexes. Index arrangement is as follows: Volume 1 Books—Subject Index; volume 2 Books—Author Index; Volume 3 Books—Title Index, Books—Subject Index to Cataloged Titles, Serials—Subject Index, Serials—Title Index, and Key to Publishers' and Distributors' Abbreviations.

The Books—Subject Index entries are arranged alphabetically by author within some 6,300 subjects. The Books—Title and Books—Author indexes are arranged alphabetically by title and author respectively. The Books—Subject Index to Cataloged Titles includes some 5,800 entries arranged by main entry within some 5,270 Library of Congress subjects. This index contains entries selected from new entries added to the *American Book Publishing Record* database from August 1983 through August 1984.

The arrangement of the serials indexes and entries follows the format of Bowker's serials bibliographies. The Serials-Subject Index contains some 7,300 entries appearing 9,282 times under some 295 subject headings from the Bowker International Serials Database. Entries are arranged alphabetically by title under each subject heading. Complete bibliographic information, including title, frequency, Dewey Decimal Classification number, frequency and publisher name and address appears in the entry under the primary subject of the serial; cross-references to the main entry appear under secondary subjects. The Serials-title Index lists current, former, and parallel language titles in alphabetical sequence. Page references to the main entry in the subject section are given following each title in italic type; references to secondary subjects appear in roman type.

The Key to Publishers' and Distributors' Abbreviations is alphabetically arranged by the abbreviations used in the books entries and located at the end of each entry. The publisher directory contains complete address information. Complete descriptions of all indexes can be found in the "How to Use" section beginning on page xi.

# HOW TO USE BOWKER'S LAW BOOKS AND SERIALS IN PRINT 1984-1985

## GENERAL EDITORIAL POLICIES

In order to ensure that the essential information in these listings is uniform, complete, and easy to find, the following editorial policies have been maintained:

Every effort is made by most contributing publishers to prepare their material with consideration for its accuracy throughout the life of this edition of *Bowker's Law Books and Serials in Print 1984-1985*. Most Publishers anticipate price changes when they revise their material, list forthcoming books even if publication dates and prices are not set, and for the most part, try not to list books that may shortly become unavailable. In spite of these efforts, a number of changes in price will occur and a number of titles in this edition will become unavailable before the new edition is published. All prices are subject to change without notice.

Most prices are list prices. Lack of uniformity in the individual catalogs prohibits indicating trade discounts. A lowercase "t" indicates a tentative price; "x" indicates a short discount, 20 percent or less. Short discount (20% or less) information is generally supplied by publishers to Bowker for each publication. However, all publishers do not uniformly supply this information, and Bowker can only make its best efforts to transmit this information when it is provided.

An "i" following the price indicates an invoice price. Specific policies for such titles should be obtained from individual publishers.

Publishers' and distributors' names in most cases, are abbreviated. A key to these abbreviations will be found in the *Key to Publishers' & Distributors' Abbreviations* following the *Serials-Title Index* in Volume 3. Entries in this "Key" are arranged alphabetically by the abbreviations used in the bibliographic entries. The full name, ordering address, telephone number, and ISBN prefix follow the abbreviation.

SAN (Standard Address Number) is a unique identification code for each address of each organization in or served by the book industry.

For example:

Bowker, (Bowker, R. R. Co.; 0-8352), A Xerox Information Co., 205 E 42nd St., New York, NY 10017. Tel. 212-916-1600 (SAN 214-1191); Orders To: P.O. Box 1807, Ann Arbor, MI 48106. (SAN 214-1205).

If an entry contains a "Pub. by" note after the price, the title should be ordered from the company whose abbreviation appears at the end of the entry. For example, an entry for a book published by Martin Robertson but distributed by Biblio Distribution Center, will convey this information by the form "Pub. by Martin Robertson England" after the price with "Biblio Dist" at the end of the entry.

## ALPHABETICAL ARRANGEMENT OF ENTRIES IN TITLE AND AUTHOR INDEXES

Each entry is filed alphabetically by word, with the following exceptions:

*M'*, *Mc*, and *Mac* are filed as if they were spelled *Mac* and are interfiled with other names beginning with *Mac*: for example, Macan, McAnnally, Macardle, McAree, McArthur, Macarthur, Macartney, M'Aulay, Macaulay. Within a specific name group *Mc* and *Mac* are interfiled according to the given name of the author: for example, Macdonald, Agnes; McDonald, Alexander; MacDonald, Annie L.; McDonald, Austin F.; MacDonald, Betty. In the *Books—Author Index*, compound names are listed under the first part of the name and cross-references appear under the last part of the name.

Entries beginning with initial letters (whether authors' given names or titles of entries) are filed first: Smith, H. C. comes before Smith, Harold A.; *J. B. Priestly: The Man and His Ideas* comes before *Jade*.

Numerals, including year dates, are written out in most cases and are filed alphabetically.



## INFORMATION INCLUDED IN ENTRIES

Entries include the following bibliographic information, when available: author, co-author, editor, co-editor, translator, co-translator, title, number of volumes, edition, Library of Congress catalog card number, series, whether or not illustrated, year of publication, price with type of binding if other than cloth over boards, publisher's order number, International Standard Book Number, and publisher's name. (Information on the International Standard Book Numbering System in the United States and other English-speaking countries is available from the R. R. Bowker Co.)

## BOOKS—SUBJECT INDEX

Entries are arranged alphabetically by author within subject. If no author is given, the entry is filed alphabetically by title within the author arrangement.

Headings and cross-references were updated to conform to the ninth edition of *Library of Congress Subject Headings* and its supplements.

## ALPHABETICAL ARRANGEMENT OF SUBJECT HEADINGS

Subject headings arranged alphabetically:

ABDUCTION  
ABOLITIONISTS  
ACCIDENT LAW  
ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCIES

Many of the main headings are broken down still further:

COMMERCIAL LAW  
COMMERCIAL LAW—CASES  
COMMERCIAL LAW—AFRICA  
COMMERCIAL LAW—GERMANY

There are also many cross-references:

INSURANCE, INDEMNITY  
*see* INSURANCE, LIABILITY  
ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH  
*see also* POLLUTION: PUBLIC HEALTH

Headings, patterned after those used in the card catalog in the Library of Congress, are explicit rather than general. Thus books on Bankruptcy are under BANKRUPTCY, not under BANKS AND BANKING.

In looking for books on Law, search past the main entry to the various subheadings:

LAW  
LAW—ABBREVIATIONS  
LAW—BIBLIOGRAPHY  
LAW—CODIFICATION  
LAW—CALIFORNIA  
LAW—DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA  
LAW—FLORIDA

Although a constant effort is made to maintain consistency and to avoid splitting entries on a given subject among several headings, a certain amount is inevitable. The Library of Congress updates its subject headings constantly but cannot make such updating retroactive to cards and catalogs previously issued. If previously published titles which appeared under the older, more general headings did not indicate by their titles that they should have been moved to

newer, specific headings they may have been left under the old headings.

## SUBJECT INDEX TO CATALOGED TITLES

Entries featured in this Index were selected from new entries added to the *American Book Publishing Record* database from August 1983-August 1984.

Entries appearing in this index are arranged alphabetically by main entry within subject.

Headings were derived from the primary subject and uniform name tracings in the original cataloging entries. Some of these headings were made uniform due to variances in the styling of tracings in these entries.

Subject headings are arranged alphabetically:

*Corrections*  
*Estate Planning—United States*  
*Lawyers—United States*

Many of the main headings are broken down still further:

*Corrections—Barbados*  
*Estate Planning—United States—Forms*  
*Lawyers—United States—Directories*

As noted previously, headings, as used in Library of Congress cataloging practice, are explicit rather than general—thus books on *Bankruptcy* are under *Bankruptcy*, rather than *Banks and Banking*.

## SERIAL INDEXES

### SERIALS—SUBJECT INDEX

Entries with bibliographic and buying information for selected, current serials which are published periodically or irregularly are arranged alphabetically by title within subject heading. If a serial covers more than one subject, cross-references direct the user from related subjects to the subject under which the complete entry is listed.

### SERIALS—TITLE INDEX

Title Index entries include the following: title, ISSN and country code, name of issuing body if main entry title contains only the initials of the issuing body. Cross-references for variant titles, parallel language titles, and former titles are included. The page number where the complete entry appears is printed in italic type: page numbers in roman type indicate pages of related subject listings.

## INFORMATION INCLUDED IN MAIN ENTRIES

*Basic Information.* The following items are mandatory for listing: title, frequency of publication, publisher name and address, country of publication code, Dewey Decimal Classification number.

*Title Information.* Main entry title: ISSN; subtitle, key title (entered only if different from main entry title); parallel language title, variant title, title variation note, former title and ISSN; original title of translation and ISSN; translated edition title and ISSN; and "issued with" title and ISSN (ISSN given only when available).

*Buying and Ordering Information.* Publisher name and address and, when applicable, subscription address and/or

distributor name and address; subscription price in currency of country of publication and U.S. rates for foreign publications when supplied by the publisher; price per issue if subscription rate is not applicable; the designation ‡ for a title not available from a subscription agency (printed after price information); the micropublisher if not the same as publisher (following notation on microform edition).

**Abstracting and Indexing Information.** Services which index the listed title on a regular basis are given in abbreviated form.

**Author and Editor Information.** Name of corporate author if corporate author is not also the publisher, name of editor or the abbreviation Ed. Bd. which indicates editorship by three or more persons (usually advanced degrees and titles have been omitted with the exception of medical, military, and clerical titles; absence of a title does not mean that the editor has none).

**Bibliographic Notes.** Year first published or year of first known issue; frequency of publication; year and number of latest issue if frequency is irregular; language notation if text is in language other than official language of country of publication; special features contained in the serial (such as book reviews, illustrations, charts, statistics); availability of cumulative indexes; availability of microform and other alternative formats; subject annotations additional bibliographic notations, such as title of main series in cases of subseries entry, or irregularities in volume numbering.

## RULES FOR MAIN ENTRY

Whenever possible, main entry cataloging is done from a sample page of the most recent issue, according to the following rules:

Serials with distinctive titles are usually entered under title. For example:

*Lawyer's Microcomputers*

If the title consists only of the name of the issuing body and a generic term, or if the name of the issuing body clarifies the content of the publication, entry is under the name of the issuing body. For example:

*Journal of the Indian Law Institute*  
is entered as  
*Indian Law Institute. Journal.*

A title is considered nondistinctive if it consists of a subject modified generic term and the name of the issuing body and is entered under the name of the issuing body. For example:

*Law Forum Series of the College of Law of  
Ohio State University*

is entered as  
*Ohio State University. College of Law.  
Law Forum Series.*

Government publications with nondistinctive titles are usually entered under the name of the government jurisdiction of the issuing body; distinctive titles of government issuing bodies are entered under title. For example:

*New South Wales. Law Reform Commission.  
Report*  
but  
*Review of Ghana Law*

Multilingual titles are entered under the first title given on the title page (or first title as reported by publisher if title page is not available). Titles in other languages are entered directly after the main entry title.

Titles which begin with the initials of the issuing body are entered under the initials of the issuing body. Cross-references from full name of issuing body to initials in main entry are given in the *Serials—Title Index*.

## FILING RULES

Articles at the beginning of titles have been omitted: articles and prepositions within titles are alphabetized as words:

*Journal of Psychiatry and Law*  
precedes  
*Journal of the Legal Profession*

Hyphenated words are treated as separate words:

*Lawyer-Pilots Bar Association Journal*  
precedes  
*Lawyers Marketplace*

Titles entered under corporate author or government jurisdiction are sequenced before distinctive titles which begin with the same words:

*Ghana. Supreme Military Council. Budget Proposals*  
will precede  
*Ghana Law Reports*

Acronyms and initials are treated as such and are listed at the beginning of each letter of the alphabet with the exception of the abbreviations U.N. (United Nations), U.S. (United States), Gt. Britain (Great Britain), and St. (Saint) which are filed as words:

*U M K C Law review*  
*Uganda Law Focus*  
*U.S. Department of Justice.*  
*Opinions of Attorney General*
