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PREFACE TO FOURTH EDITION

It is five years since the last edition. During this time, the criminal law of Scotland has continued to respond to its new, devolved and human rights influenced legal environment. Scottish judges and lawyers have accommodated this transformation without significant disruption to the legal system. No doubt the forthcoming period will see further changes, some of which cannot be anticipated at this date. It is encouraging, however, that the Scottish Law Commission has undertaken a thorough review of the law pertaining to sexual offences. It is anticipated that legislative activity will result.

Through all the editions of this book, we have endeavoured to present an account of Scottish criminal law which is sensitive to its traditions, since we value a body of law which has strong roots in the history of the country. At the same time, we have tried to take account of modern, theoretical work on the criminal law. We do not see a conflict between valuing tradition and being open to new ideas. We believe that in this way the criminal law of Scotland will continue to meet contemporary needs as successfully as in the past.

We have been pleased by the generally positive response to the approach that we have taken. This edition therefore adopts substantially the same format as previous editions. We have updated the text to take account of judicial and legislative developments up to March 1, 2008.
