时下,各种英语词汇记忆法和学习法五花八门,各领风骚,但总有“为赋新曲强说愁”的感觉。《英语在练——剑桥英语单词王》1-6 以剑桥国际语料库为依据,撷取 3300 个高频词和词组进行科学分级、联想归类;涵盖各级各类课程标准和大纲;彻底贯彻“在语境中学习语言”的先进理论,充分强调实用与使用;辅以生动、鲜活的训练方式,摒弃纷繁和神秘;摧毁枯燥和无趣,可谓“小单词,大风景”,是剑桥大学出版社畅销全球的词汇书。

《英语在练——剑桥英语单词王 2》具有以下特色:

1. 分层设级,循序渐进。

全书按认知规律和词频理论分六级归类,本级 30 个主题单元,3 个综合测验,步步为营。

2. 语境记忆,科学新颖。

内容取材剑桥国际语料库,时尚真实,方法贯彻“在语境中学习语言”的理论,生动高效。

3. 结构简约,生趣盎然。

练习与运用巧妙地融入图片、漫画、游戏等丰富形式,激发读者的学习兴趣和信心。

4. 目录清晰,索引实用。

目录按主题归类,一目了然;索引词表按音标、词性、释义及简要说明列项,方便对照。

最后,我们建议读者或学生第一次做练习时使用铅笔,达到一定阶段或程度后,可以尝试重新做题,前后钩沉,巩固记忆。亦可在词汇练习中采取这样的方法:

1. 同类词群学习法：分类归纳记忆（比如 skirt, coat, trousers, etc）。

2. 单词对比记忆法：反义联想，事半功倍（比如 beautiful/ugly, hot/cold）。

3. 图画单词记忆法：青少年读者或学生可以尝试画实物图，调动多感官参与记忆单词（比如 hand, fish）。

4. 生词收集记忆法：提高生词的敏感度，将学习中遇到的生词或熟词新义记下来，并尝试造句和使用。

全书可以自学使用，培训学校采用教材使用更佳。
