Preface

As Richard Mays indicated in his preface to the first edition of this text, writing a book is no easy venture. I also agree that writing one's first book is particularly daunting. I would add, however, two other comments. Firstly, although I have found the task of writing this book difficult, I have also found it to be immensely enjoyable. Secondly, part of the reason for the task having been challenging in this case has related to the fact that this is a practical text, designed to be used by those involved in the summary cause courts. This means that it must not only be, as far as is possible, accurate; it requires to be of a practical (as opposed to academic) use.
