

# Preface

The main problem confronting the editor of a biographical dictionary is one of selection, and some explanation is needed of the principles which have been followed. No living persons have been included, and only those who had achieved prominence before 1939. In making up a selection, the emphasis has been placed upon English common law; consequently, most individuals included are English or Welsh. But I have tried also to reflect the expansion of the common law overseas by including a very select company from Eire, from Commonwealth countries and from the USA. In order to keep the book within a reasonable compass, numerous important people have, of necessity, been omitted; this is regrettable but inevitable. Systems of legal thought do not exist in complete isolation, and so the dictionary also includes entries dealing with people who belonged to other traditions, but whose names are met by serious students of the law. And, for fun, there are also some miscellaneous entries – for example, on all Roman jurists connected directly with Britain, and on the patron saint of lawyers.

It would be impossible within the constraints of space for the contributors to have written comprehensive lives; what is provided here is an introduction to their biography, some indication as to where to go next and, because it is interesting to know what people looked like, some information as to where a portrait or photograph or even mosaic can be found. Some degree of standardisation has been imposed on the contributors, but not I hope too much. To some readers history may be seen primarily in terms of forces which override individual choice and decision, but perhaps this dictionary may encourage at least some of those who use it to develop in contrast an interest in legal biography, which has been a rather neglected field. For others, I hope we have provided interest and some amusement.

I must thank all the contributors for their patience and tolerance of the editor in the years during which this book was being compiled, and particular thanks are due to Joan Denning for the immense amount of work she has devoted to helping me to organise the dictionary. I am most grateful, also, to the publishers, who first suggested that the work should be undertaken.
