DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA CIRCUIT

CHIEF JUSTICE EARL WARREN, of California.

Appointed Chief Justice by President Eisenhower; took office October 5, 1953.

FIRST CIRCUIT.

Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, and Puerto Rico.

JUSTICE ARTHUR J. GOLDBERG, of Illinois.

Appointed by President Kennedy; took office October 1, 1962.

SECOND CIRCUIT.

Connecticut, New York, and Vermont.

JUSTICE JOHN M. HARLAN, of New York.

Appointed by President Eisenhower; took office March 28, 1955.

THIRD CIRCUIT.

Delaware, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and Virgin Islands.

JUSTICE WILLIAM J. BRENNAN, Jr., of New Jersey.

Appointed by President Eisenhower; took office October 16, 1956.

FOURTH CIRCUIT.

Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Virginia, and West Virginia.

CHIEF JUSTICE EARL WARREN, of California.

Appointed Chief Justice by President Eisenhower; took office October 5, 1953.

FIFTH CIRCUIT.

Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, Texas, and Canal Zone.

JUSTICE HUGO L. BLACK, of Alabama.

Appointed by President Roosevelt; took office August 19, 1937.

SIXTH CIRCUIT.

Kentucky, Michigan, Ohio, and Tennessee.

JUSTICE POTTER STEWART, of Ohio.

Appointed by President Eisenhower; took office October 14, 1958.

ALLOTMENT OF THE JUSTICES

SEVENTH CIRCUIT.

Illinois, Indiana, and Wisconsin.

JUSTICE TOM C. CLARK, of Texas.

Appointed by President Truman; took office August 24, 1949.

EIGHTH CIRCUIT.

Arkansas, Iowa, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, and South Dakota.

JUSTICE BYRON R. WHITE, of Colorado.

Appointed by President Kennedy; took office April 16, 1962.

NINTH CIRCUIT.

Alaska, Arizona, California, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, and Washington.

JUSTICE WILLIAM O. DOUGLAS, of Connecticut.

Appointed by President Roosevelt; took office April 17, 1939.

TENTH CIRCUIT.

Colorado, Kansas, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Utah, and Wyoming.

JUSTICE BYRON R. WHITE, of Colorado.

Appointed by President Kennedy; took office April 16, 1962.

NEW RULE 62

ORDER

May 20, 1963

It is ordered that the Rules of this Court be amended by inserting the following section after Rule 61:

PART XII. APPLICATION OF TERMS

Rule 62.

TERM "STATE COURT" INCLUDES SUPREME COURT OF PUERTO RICO

The term "state court" when used in these rules includes the Supreme Court of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, and references in these rules to the law and statutes of a state include the law and statutes of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.
