INTRODUCTION

This is the first edition of the Who's Who in the U.K. Information World. It has been compiled and published with two main objectives:

- To provide an 'internal contact directory' for all those actively involved in the information profession.
- To publish a directory that illustrates the wide range of skills, expertise and experience of a profession that is growing in numbers and maturity. And to indicate the potential for organisations to capitalize on these skills through their application using the new technologies, new sources of information and new services that are now being developed.

These objectives could only be met if the Who's Who was reasonably comprehensive, and thanks to an exceptionally good response to our questionnaire, we believe we have achieved this. Inevitably, in the first edition, there will be key people we have missed out and regrettably, there were a few who specifically asked not to be included. We hope that in future editions we will, with your help, track down the missing entries and persuade the 'no thank you's' that this Who's Who is of value to our profession and that it would be of greater value if it were completely comprehensive.

Our criteria for inclusion in the Who's Who was that the individual had to have been either, actively involved in the UK Information Sector for at least five years or, currently running a library or information unit. Using these criteria, we have included information specialists, librarians and records managers from companies, government departments, institutes, associations, charities and research organisations. We have included head librarians from public and academic libraries and also librarians that are actively involved in professional groups, committees or associations. Finally, we have included a number of well known senior individuals from suppliers and support organisations.

Most of the entries are full entries compiled from information provided by the individual. Where the individual did not have time to fill in the complete questionnaire, we have included a short entry. The entries, which are listed alphabetically by surname, include the following information.

- Surname, title, first names and qualifications.
- Current position, organisation, address, telephone, telex and fax numbers.
- Number of years experience in the information world both in current job and in total.
- The two most recent positions.
- Activities present responsibilties, professional involvement and skills, and any special hobbies, interests and ambitions.
