

PREFACE

There have been considerable developments in administrative law over the last five years. There has been important legislation on matters as diverse as tribunals, inquiries and local government. The courts have continued to be active and there have been many important new judicial decisions. There has been much interesting secondary literature. The Human Rights Act 1998 has, not surprisingly, generated a large amount of case law, as the courts have grappled with many of the key issues under this statute.

I have sought to incorporate all these changes, and to give a balanced account of the subject, which will be of equal use to those who are interested in the administrative system and those whose primary interest lies in judicial review. All chapters of the book have been revised to take account of the new developments, and several chapters have been substantially rewritten. The 6th edition contains two new chapters concerning review of fact and judicial review on grounds of equality. The discussion of the Human Rights Act and judicial review is now contained in a separate chapter, and the implications of the Act are also considered in other chapters of the book where appropriate.

I would like to thank all those at Sweet & Maxwell who have provided support in the production process with the book. I would also like to thank Anita and Ciaran for their help and understanding when work on the book impinged on family time.
