



Introduction

This book offers you the chance to explore their best interior design work to date carried out at international level. Featuring the most renowned contemporary interior designers, these pages explore the current path of interior design, a sector that according to some people seems to have come of age and calls for a rethinking of the approaches used so far.

Until recently, trends have defined the path to be followed in disciplines related to art and design. However, the current economic recession, demographic problems and lack of space are leading to the emergence of a new generation of interiors characterized by a decline in lifestyle. "Unique things are important. Trends are not," says Li Edelkort, one of the most sought-after specialists in trends in Europe.

Unlike what many believed would be the future, home automation is not progressing as expected into the futuristic rationalism of interiors. On the contrary, interior design is evolving toward a style that focuses on an openly new rural style that focuses on arts and crafts. The digital revolution has prompted society to invest in technological gadgets to optimize working times and quick access to home entertainment, but there is a certain level of mistrust in automated home systems. Furniture is chosen for its durability rather than for its features, and warm textures and natural and sustainable materials such as wood, stone and natural fibers are preferred.

In this digital and arts and crafts revolution, we must add the possibilities that the digital technology offers by encouraging the emergence of a new concept: Do It Yourself. A new actor appears in the design process who up until now has only been considered as a receiver: the actual user.
