

The conceptions that maintained souls would never vanish and the sacrificial systems exerted much influence on the construction of imperial mausoleums and tombs. They were mostly built in the vicinity of the capitals. Their forms and layouts were in simulation of the palaces where they had lived prior to death. The burial objects were articles of their daily life and typical gods of the time. Imperial mausoleums and tombs will provide references for the study of the architectural layout of the imperial palaces and the prevailing ornaments.

Imperial mausoleums and tombs experienced four stages of development. 1. Graves without mounds and above-ground structures. Before the Spring and Autumn Period and the period of the Warring States, the dead were buried in the earth without any signs on the ground. 2. Earth pyramids. Earth mounds were piled upon the coffin chambers. Tombs of this kind are scattered along the reaches of the Wei and Yellow Rivers. The mausoleums and tombs of the Qin, Han and Northern Song dynasties are representative of this kind. 3. Hills and mountains used as mausoleum sites. The underground palaces were built on the sides of hills and mountains and the peaks were used as mounds. The imperial mausoleums and tombs of the Tang Dynasty belong to this kind. 4. High earth mounds and enclosing walls. Upon the underground palaces were circular walls made of bricks enclosing the mounds which were higher than the walls. Typical mausoleums are those of the Ming and Qing dynasties built in the vicinity of Beijing.




