

#### 《英语在练——剑桥英语单词王 1》具有以下特色:

1. 分层设级,循序渐进。

全书按认知规律和词频理论分六级归类,本级 30 个主题单元,3 个综合测验,步步为营。

2. 语境记忆,科学新颖。

内容取材剑桥国际语料库,时尚真实,方法贯彻"在语境中学习语言"的理论,生动高效。

- 2. 单词对比记忆法:反义联想,事半功倍(比如 beautiful/ug-ly, hot/cold)。
- 3. 图画单词记忆法: 青少年读者或学生可以尝试画实物图, 调动多感官参与记忆单词(比如 hand, fish)。
- 4. 生词收集记忆法:提高生词的敏感度,将学习中遇到的生词或熟词新义记下来,并尝试造句和使用。




