EDITOR'S PREFACE

With respect to this second volume of the work of the late Professor O'Connell, the same general remarks that were made in the preface to the first volume apply.

After the first volume went to press the United Nations Third Conference on the Law of the Sea concluded with the signing of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea on 10 December 1982. A late decision was made by the Conference to sign the Convention in Montego Bay, Jamaica, instead of in Caracas, Venezuela. In volume 1 references were made to the draft Convention text as the 'Draft Caracas Convention' in accordance with the popular name then in currency in anticipation of the expected place of signature. References in the present volume to the Convention as signed are to the 'Montego Bay Convention', and to the earlier drafts as, 'the Draft Convention', the 'ICNT', or the 'RSNT', as appropriate.
