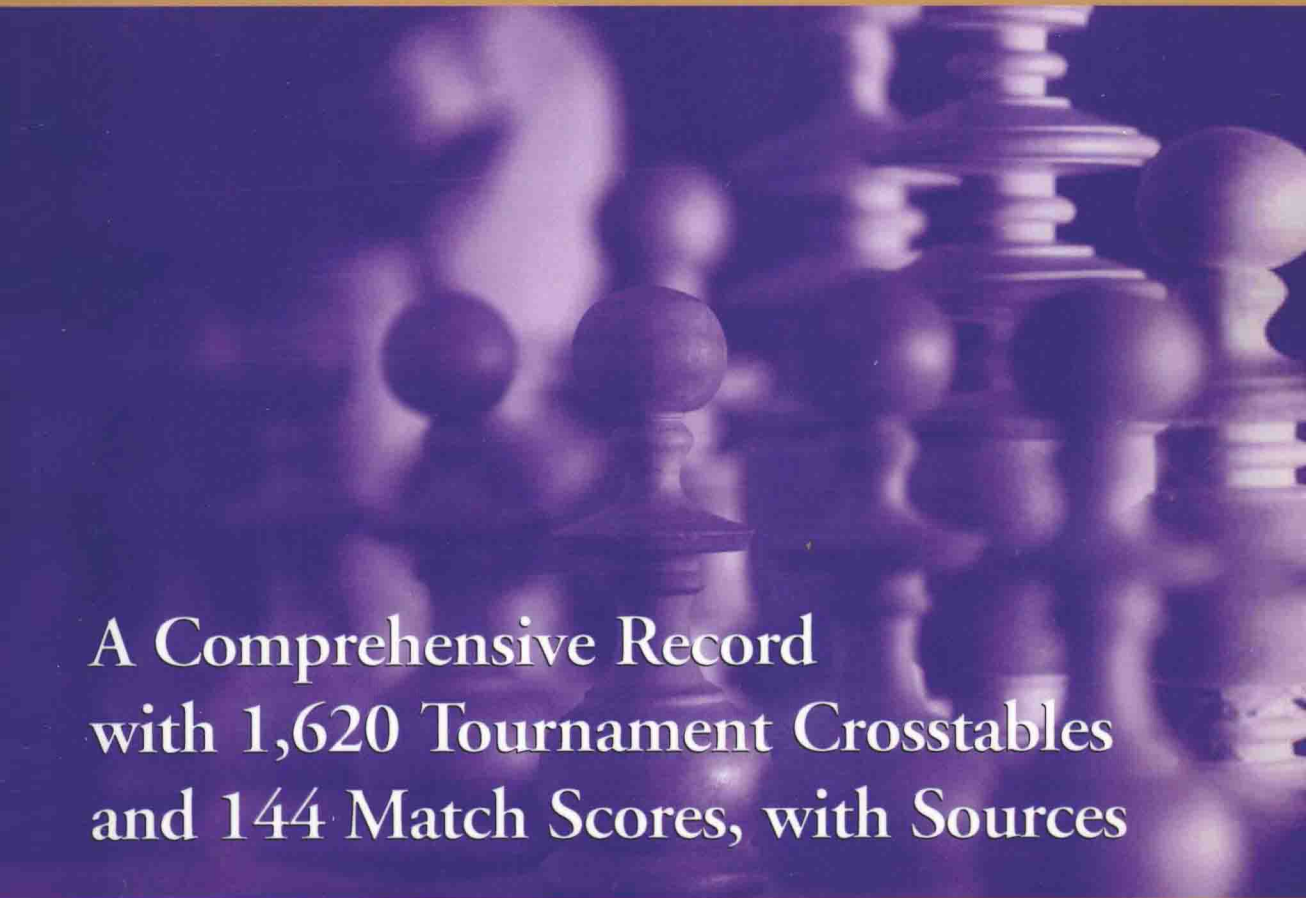

PREFACE

This work documents the results of the main chess competitions that took place all over the world from 1951 through 1955.

Jeremy Gaige's excellent and ground-breaking four volumes of *Chess Tournament Crosstables* stopped at 1930.

Later on, Gaige published other fundamental works such as *Chess Personalia: A Biobibliography*; *Chess Tournaments: A Checklist*, vol. 1, 1849–1950, and *Chess Tournaments: A Checklist*, vol. 2, 1951–1980. The present work refers to these volumes for names and results.

In the second of the *Checklist* volumes, Gaige lists a series of tournaments in the period 1951–1960, whose crosstables he indicates he possesses for the most part; so far, they have not been published. They number, by my count, 1,234 crosstables (for 1951–1960). I have found most of those listed, as well as many more; my two volumes of *Chess Results* for the decade of 1951–1960 include exactly 3,010 tournament crosstables.

My research for the present volume focused primarily on the most important magazines for the 1951–1955 period: I would like to thank the Koninklijke Bibliotheek in The Hague for allowing me to gather much of the material. Even more is still left to do.

Women's and correspondence competitions have both been excluded in the present volume, with the thought that they can be the object of separate works.

Standardization of full names was deemed

essential, since various sources carry different spellings for a player (because of different alphabets, transliterations, translations and pronunciations across countries): Jeremy Gaige's *Chess Personalia* was the authority.

Whenever possible, for every contest I report the place where it was played, together with the nation in parentheses, partial or full dates and the name of the event. In nearly all instances I have provided a citation to the published source of information.

Competitions are presented in chronological order by year; within each year, the reader will find individual tournaments, individual matches, team tournaments and team matches. For each of these sections, competitions are given in alphabetical order. The chronological-and-then-alphabetical ordering has been very slightly altered in some cases, purely to more economically store the crosstables and match scores without wasting space. The reader should have no difficulty finding a chess event.

Events played over two years are entered in the year in which they ended: for example, results of tournaments that began in 1951 and ended in 1952 are at the beginning of 1952.

The book is completed by a bibliography, an index of sections (year by year), an index of events and an index of players.

Many thanks go to my dear friend Ivo Fasiori for the advice that brought this work to its final draft.
