#### TARIFF OF GENERAL RATES ON IMPORT

GENERAL RULES FOR THE INTERPRETATION OF THE HARMONIZED SYSTEM In force July 10, 1988 (\*)

Classification of goods in the Tariff shall be governed by the following principles:

- 1. The titles of Sections, Chapters and sub-Chapters are provided for ease of reference only; for legal purposes, classification shall be determined according to the terms of the headings and any relative Section or Chapter Notes and, provided such headings or Notes do not otherwise require, according to the following provisions:
- 2. a) Any reference in a heading to an article shall be taken to include a reference to that article incomplete or unfinished, provided that, as presented, the incomplete or unfinished article has the essential character of the complete or finished article. It shall also be taken to include a reference to that article complete or finished (or falling to be classified as complete or finished by virtue of this Rule), presented unassembled or disassembled.
  - b) Any reference in a heading to a material or substance shall be taken to include a reference to mixtures or combinations of that material or substance with other materials or substances. Any reference to goods of a given material or substance shall be taken to include a reference to goods consisting wholly or partly of such material or substance. The classification of goods consisting of more than one material or substance shall be according to the principles of Rule 3.
- 3. When by application of Rule 2 b) or for any other reason, goods are, prima facie, classifiable under two or more headings, classification shall be effected as follows:
  - a) The heading which provides the most specific description shall be preferred to headings providing a more general description. However, when two or more headings each refer to part only of the materials or substances contained in mixed or composite goods or to part only of the items in a set put up for retail sale, those headings are to be regarded as equally specific in relation to those goods, even if one of them gives a more complete or precise description of the goods.
  - b) Mixtures, composite goods consisting of different materials or made up of different components, and goods put up in sets for retail sale, which cannot be classified by reference to 3 a), shall be classified as if they consisted of the material or component which gives them their essential character, insofar as this criterion is applicable.
  - c) When goods cannot be classified by reference to 3 a) or 3 b), they shall be classified under the heading which occurs last in numerical order among those which equally merit consideration.
- 4. Goods which cannot be classified in accordance with the above Rules shall be classified under the heading appropriate to the goods to which they are most akin.
- 5. In addition to the foregoing provisions, the following Rules shall apply in respect of the goods referred to therein:
  - a) Camera cases, musical instrument cases, gun cases, drawing instrument cases, necklace cases and similar containers, specially shaped or fitted to contain a specific article or set of articles, suitable for long-term use and presented with the articles for which they are intended, shall be classified with such articles when of a kind normally sold therewith. The Rule does not, however, apply to containers which give the whole its essential character;
  - b) Subject to the provisions of Rule 5 a) above, packing materials and packing containers presented with the goods therein shall be classified with the goods if they are of a kind normally used for packing such goods. However, this provision does not apply when such packing materials or packing containers are clearly suitable for repetitive use.
- 6. For legal purposes, the classification of goods in the subheadings of a heading shall be determined according to the terms of those subheadings and any related Subheading Notes and, mutatis mutandis, to the above Rules, on the understanding that only subheadings at the same level are comparable. For the purposes of the Rule the relative Section and Chapter Notes also apply, unless the context otherwise requires.

#### ADDITIONAL RULES

- 1. The principles set out in the General Rules for the Interpretation of the Tariff shall also be valid for the determination, within each heading, of the subheading or subdivision to be applied.
- 2. The Tariff is divided into 21 Sections, the numerical notation of which, given in a progressive form, in Roman numerals, does not affect the number code of the Tariff subdivisions. The classification of subdivisions defining the goods and the duty applicable shall be composed as follows:
  - a) The Chapters are laid out progressively from 01 to 97, with the exception of Chapter 77, which is reserved for possible future use, and form the first two numbers of the classification.
  - b) The headings are indicated by the third and fourth digits in the classification.
  - c) The subheadings are indicated by adding a fifth and sixth digit to the heading number. (\*) d) The subdivisions are indicated by the addition of a seventh and eighth digit to the
  - subheading code and range from 1 to 98, 99 being reserved for goods not elsewhere specified or included and corresponding to the tenor of the subheading in question.

- 3. For the purposes of interpreting and applying the Tariff, the "Secretaria de Comercio" and the "Secretaria de Hacienda y Credito Publico", shall jointly publish in the "Diario official" of the Federation the Agreements establishing modifications of any kind relative to the Explanatory Notes to the Tariff, the application of which shall be compulsory for the determination of the heading corresponding to goods.
- 4. For the purposes of maintaining the consistency of the classification criteria for goods within the Tariff framework, the "Secretaria de Hacienda y Credito Publico" shall publish, in the "Diario Oficial" of the Federation, circulars which contain classification opinions certified in conformity with the established procedures. The application of such criteria shall be compulsory.
  - Likewise, the differences in criteria which may arise in Tariff classification shall, in the first instance, be resolved by a procedure laid down by the "Secretaria de Hacienda y Credito Publico"
- 6. In this Tariff the expression "weight limitations" shall be taken to mean the weight of the merchandise expressed in kilograms, multiples and fractions thereof, except where otherwise specified.
- 7. In order to implement negotiations which the United States of Mexico concludes with other countries and through which they grant preferential import tariff rates on goods, which shall be included in the corresponding subdivisions of the Tariff stipulated in Article 1 of this Law or in an Appendix thereto; this Appendix covers: the goods concerned by the negotiation, the preferential treatment accorded in each case and the country or countries to which they apply.
- 8. Prior authorization by the "Comercio" :
  - a) The expression "complete or finished articles" shall be taken to mean goods imported in one or more staged consignments or through one or more Customshouses by one or more enterprises dependent on an industrial support programme approved by the "Secretaria de Patrimonio y Fomento Industrial" .

Parts of articles manufactured or assembled in Mexico may be imported under the specifically designated subheading when imported by enterprises dependent on an industrial support programme approved by the "Secretaria de Patrimonio y Fomento Industrial".

In order to avoid unnecessary repetition, resulting in a considerable increase in the volume of this Journal and for the sake of clarity in the presentation, the Bureau has modified the presentation of the original Tariff slightly, adapting it to the presentation of the Harmonized System Nomenclature and that of Tariffs which, based on that Nomenclature, the Bureau has already published.

b) Articles, unassembled or disassembled, corresponding to complete or finished articles or falling to be classified as such, may be imported in one or more stages, via one or more Customs posts.

Goods imported under this rule must be used for the respective development programmes, for enlarging an industrial complex, repairing equipment or in articles manufactured or assembled in Mexico.

- 9. The term "goods" shall be taken not to apply to the following, which shall not therefore be liable to the payment of duty:
  - a) Corpses in coffins and human ashes in urns;
  - b) Franked mail defined as "correspondance" by international postal conventions.
  - c) Articles imported by post for which the duty is not more than that laid down by the "Secretaria de Hacienda y Credito Publico" in a general customs regulation.
  - d) Samples and sample collections which, due to their status as such, have no commercial value;

The following shall be considered as having no commercial value:

- i) Articles having lost any commercial value due to physical operations carried out thereon, so as to render them unusable and therefore unsaleable.ii) Articles obviously for use as samples or collections of samples due to their
- Articles obviously for use as samples or collections of samples due to their quantity, weight, volume or other characteristics.

In both cases, commercial, bank, consular or Customs documents must clearly certify that such goods are samples or collections of samples.

10. The General Customs Directorate may, in the case of doubt or dispute, require that documents allowing the tariff identification of goods be produced; the parties concerned must produce the required documents within 15 working days and may apply for an extension of the same duration.

On expiry of the time-limit or notice, goods shall be classified under the heading to which they correspond.

- Except where the context otherwise requires, throughout the Tariff any reference to "dried" products also covers products which have been dehydrated, evaporated or freezedried.
