The popularity of independent education has grown over the years. Parents from many backgrounds realise that a good education is an essential requirement in today's world. They look increasingly to the independent sector for excellence and individual care, variety and choice

What makes independent education so attractive is the breadth of choice and the quality of education on offer.

The wealth of tradition and experience behind independent schools is balanced with a forward looking approach. They are able to incorporate the best new ideas. Independent schools are financed by fee paying parents and so are little affected by political and bureaucratic influence.

The endowment funds and scholarships now available mean that pupils from a wide variety of backgrounds can enjoy the benefits on offer.

Outstanding facilities

The facilities at most independent schools are outstanding, often built up over many years and constantly renewed. Classes are smaller and teacher/pupil ratios can go as low as one-to-one.

Boarding Schools

Boarding at an independent school provides a quality alternative for parents in a variety of situations. Many schools have spent large sums of money refurbishing accommodation and building new boarding houses. There is a recognition that schools are a home-from-home and that it is important to provide a high level of comfort. Staffing is also most important and schools rely on experienced and caring adults to look after children.

Boarding schools bring children of the same age group together from all points of the globe, allowing them to live and study together, to form friendships and develop social confidence within a multi-cultural environment. Pupils learn to be more tolerant, understanding and flexible.

Academic work is similarly timetabled to that in a day school, but schooling may be extended to include a weekend morning. Libraries, computing and other facilities are also often open in the evenings and at the weekend. Boarding school staff live on campus and can help with homework or other personal concerns outside lesson-time.

Guardianship

Most boarding schools will require the appointment of a local guardian for your child if guardianship is not provided by the school. The guardian should help in emergencies such as illness, with travel arrangements or take your child in during some school holidays if no home journey is planned.

It is wise to register with a company which runs a full guardianship service.

A reputable guardianship company will provide a responsible and caring 'guardian family' to look after your child. The guardian family should visit the school and take an interest in your child's progress and welfare. Your child should be given his/her own bedroom where they can leave their belongings, work quietly, or just be alone.

Families used by guardianship companies should be visited in their homes by a member of the company's staff, and references obtained. Parents should check with a company before signing an agreement, to make certain that it fulfils their requirements. Parents should obtain a written estimate of the overall annual cost and ask if an account statement is submitted periodically.

Educational Consultants

Some guardianship services also act as educational consultants. With their experience and expert knowledge of schools, educational consultants can help parents identify the right school for their child.

When applying initially, parents should send the child's details to avoid delays. Heads are reluctant to offer a place unless they have some idea of a child's academic ability.

Two or three schools should be visited with the child before making a decision. To have seen the school, met the staff and spoken to other students beforehand can make the first few weeks of school life less stressful.

Working Overseas

The taking up of overseas employment can be a difficult decision to make, especially if school-going children are involved.

Parents need to decide whether to send their children to a school with a different language and culture or to stay close to the education system offered at home, in which case national schools for one country's expatriates are available. Your local embassy can advise about national schools located in many major cities.

International schools mostly follow an American or English model. There is no agreed international curriculum, but the International Baccalaureate programmes are probably the closest. Or your child may attend a local school in the week and a weekend national school for essential language and cultural classes.

Language Differences

Sending your child to a school where the language of instruction is different to that spoken at home means that a good understanding of that language is required.

Changing to a foreign language school could add another year to allow enough time for language study. To benefit fully from a foreign education the whole family needs to understand cultural differences. Every country has schools to prepare its own citizens.

International study centres

For non English speaking families wishing to send their children to a UK boarding school there now exists a number of international study centres specifically designed to cater for such students. These are often attached to well known schools (Bedford, Rossall, Sherborne and Taunton are good examples). These centres specialise in teaching English to non-speakers while also offering teaching across the whole curriculum. They provide an invaluable introduction to the British independent boarding school system and have an excellent reputation for placing students at mainstream independent schools when the students are ready to move on.

Spending one or two years at such a centre is a sensible and, for students with very limited English, a highly recommended way of entering the UK independent schools system.

Finance

The cost of private schooling can be quite substantial – but a tax efficient insurance plan can provide a cheque at the beginning of each term.

Various school fees' insurance plans are available. Sometimes schools offer their own fees' insurance – check with individual schools for advice on forward planning schemes, and also grants, scholarships, bursaries and government assistance.

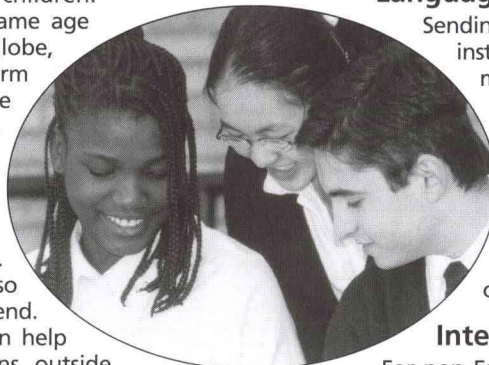

International education is not a new idea. From the days of the Renaissance, individuals have travelled far to seek knowledge which would change not only their own lives but the way of life for whole countries and cultures.

International education has evolved dramatically, becoming not only much more widely available but increasingly taken for granted as part of an individual's education. With many university programmes, study overseas of at least part of the course is common. And to have a worldwide choice offers the opportunity to study at the finest universities in the world, rather than just your own country's.

In America alone, since just 1954 there has been a 1,200% increase in overseas students, with currently nearly half a million students – nearly one third of students worldwide – studying away from home.

The UK follows closely, with over quarter of a million foreign students. The UK government is about to change visa, work and entry requirements in order to make it easier for students.

However, good quality education is not limited to study in the UK and USA. In Asia, many Western universities have established additional campuses offering similar courses to their home country. INSEAD, for example, is a leading business school from France, which runs courses taught in English, in Singapore. In Europe, Spain, France and Italy are attracting more international students, and in Germany a group of 60 universities have in the last year launched courses which are taught in English.

Learning a Language

English is regarded generally as the primary international language, and there is a wide range of courses to study it.

Language teachers have always acknowledged the advantages of travelling into a foreign country to become proficient in its native language. As you are immersed in the environment of the language, you are continually exposed to its vocabulary and its idiom. This intensifies — and therefore accelerates — the learning experience.

At the same time, you have the opportunity to enjoy a new culture, see new sights and make new friends amongst your hosts and fellow students. If you take homestay accommodation you will even experience family life just as it is in a different country.

With careful research, it is possible to locate courses which can offer a truly international experience,

for example two year courses where a student can study in four different countries in that period.

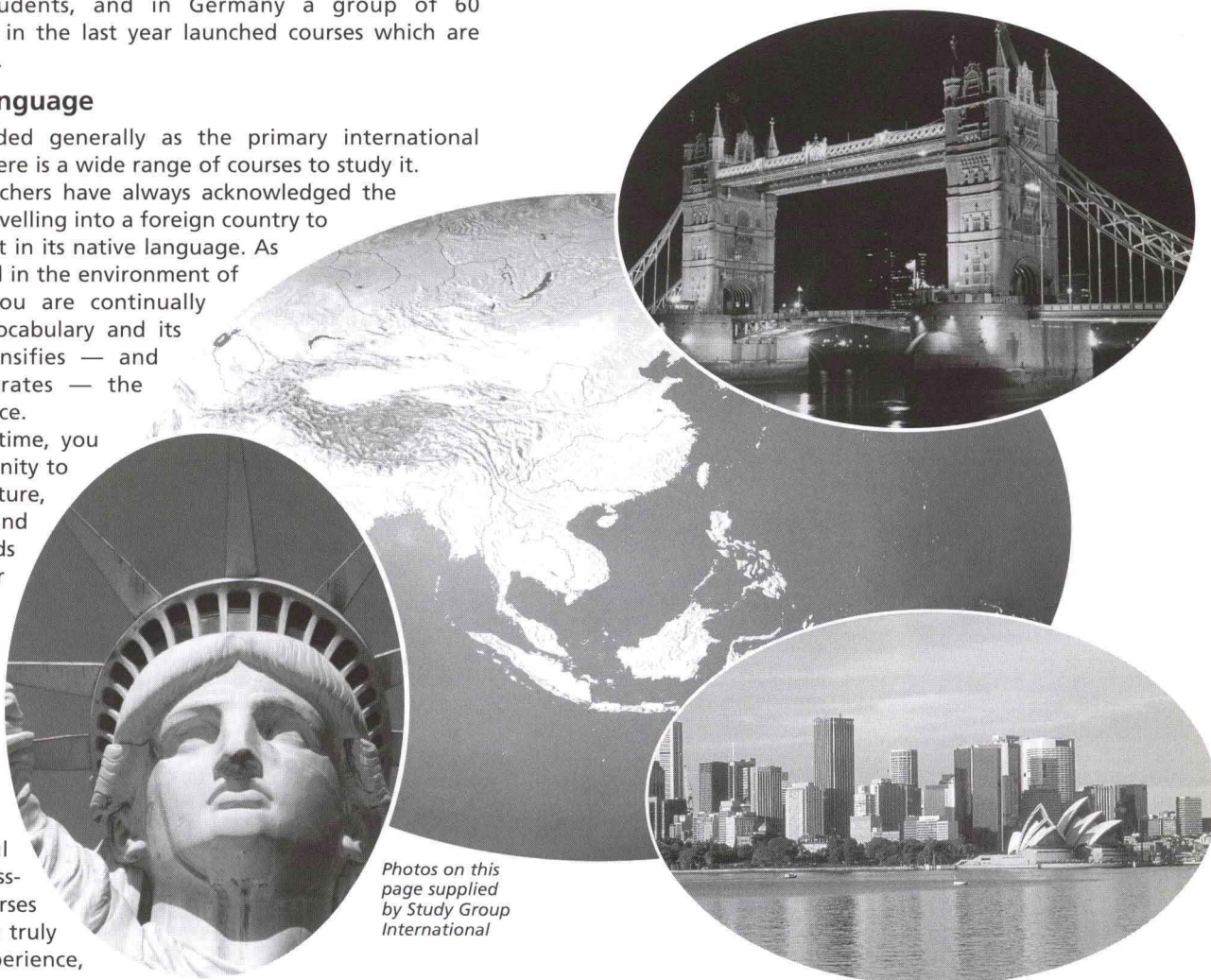
A Degree or MBA Course

More and more students are undertaking a degree or MBA course in a foreign country. Employers, particularly those with an international activity, like to recruit staff who have shown such initiative and who have acquired an international dimension to their study. On the day of your job interview, your interviewer may be swayed by whether you speak another language or if you have studied abroad.

Boarding School

More and more students below university age are recognising the benefits of studying at boarding school, either for language learning or a complete education. This can be for either one or two terms and boarding schools worldwide are offering foreign students this opportunity. You will find many of these listed in this publication.

There are numerous organisations promoting international student relations which can offer advice to prospective students regarding qualifications required, visa regulations, and other preparations for everything from a short language course to a complete degree abroad.
