#### PREFACE

The coverage of this volume is the entire lawsuit including the decision to litigate, selection of the court, jurisdictional reach of the court, pleadings, motions, discovery, scope of the litigation, pretrial conference, trial, appeal and res judicata/preclusion. This is not just another edition of the earlier book, Procedure Before Trial, by these authors and Claude Brown; this is a new volume in coverage and in much of the material contained in the book.

This book is keyed to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and those state procedural schemes modeled after the federal rules. The starting point is the federal rules. Very little is included on the Code pleading which antedated the federal rules. We believe that the emphasis on the federal rules is desirable for several reasons.

We believe that the federal rule system embodies a basic philosophy of procedure which is manifested in all of the federal rules and results in a close interrelation of all of the rules. This philosophy and the various interrelations can be made much clearer when the materials concentrate upon the rules system. Furthermore, there are many facets to the operation of each major rule which remain obscure unless there is such concentration. All of these matters may well be examined without examination of code state rules. Not only does preliminary examination of code state rules in most areas completely dilute the study of the federal rule system in most areas, but it is unnecessary for understanding the federal rule system. In fact, to the extent that study of the code system is made in any depth, it tends to obscure the federal system operation and may inculcate notions contrary to those manifested in the federal rules. The simple fact is that the federal rules have embodied a successful procedural system only because the judges administering them have been willing to abandon various notions inherent in the code state procedural systems. It is also true that misinterpretations of the rules have often arisen from the process of importing code notions into the rules. On the other hand, while the federal rules properly demand a sympathetic attitude, a study of this rule system for state use furnishes an adequate background for consideration of code state rules by a student who may be later confronted with problems under such rules. Finally, among other considerations is the important fact that students presently in law school will in the future be required to cope with the development of many

new ideas and rules that will stem from the federal rule system and not from the Field Code system of procedure. To equip the student for this future, concentration in depth upon federal rule philosophy and operation is necessary. And this concentration can furnish a basis for class consideration of improvement of procedures in various areas.

Some areas of procedure are not covered by the federal rules or their state counterparts—for example, jurisdiction. In dealing with such areas, we have, as far as possible, dealt with problems and solutions that are common to all jurisdictions.

Several other purposes should be served by the materials. The materials are selected upon a basis which we believe will afford an opportunity to emphasize the adversary nature of the pre-trial stage of a lawsuit, an emphasis which is crucial to an understanding of any court-related procedural system. In this connection we have kept in mind the notion that the materials should impart a background the student will find useful in his other law school courses and also useful for his activities after graduation.

To accomplish all of the above goals we have attempted to design this volume as a teaching tool, eschewing the notion that it should be a scholarly source book for research or other purposes. Our experience has led us to believe that, for the understanding of the nature of the federal rule system and its operation, it is of primary importance to concentrate upon cases which illustrate the operation of the rules in suitable and interesting fact and substantive law contexts. Inherent in this approach is a belief that mere knowledge of the terms of the general rules is of minimum value. Thus, selection of cases has not been confined to leading Supreme Court cases or other appellate cases; rather, opinions which tend to show trial level problems and the relation of the rules to the merits of the case have been preferred.

Various different general arrangements of the materials could have been adopted, but for the most part a chronological arrangement has appeared the most useful in our experience. Therefore the subjects are organized generally in the order in which procedures are employed in the conduct of a lawsuit. Thus the subjects of jurisdiction, commencement of suit and venue are treated first. Once a proper court is chosen, what procedures must be followed or are merely available from the commencement of the suit to the stage of trial? These matters seem to be most easily explored by considering suits which do not involve multiple parties first and then by adding complications which occur in suits involving multiple parties. Finally the

last chapter deals with the effect of judgments. Materials on res judicata/preclusion have been included because the concept may be important in the initial stages of a law suit. Also, the subject matter is rarely considered in any part of the typical law school curriculum, and yet it is of great importance to courts, attorneys and litigants.

Matters of format seem self-explanatory. A federal rules pamphlet must be used as a supplement since the rules are not reproduced in this volume.

The original footnote numbers have been retained in all cases in which the original footnotes to an opinion have been retained and the editors' footnotes are indicated by asterisks. The authors feel that the contents of this book are those which should be covered in a procedure course in either the first or second year. By a careful selection of materials, the book can be used in a two, three or four hour course. The materials are sufficient for a six-hour course.

The emphasis is on procedure under the federal practice and not upon the jurisdiction of the federal courts which is left to a course in Federal Courts or Federal Jurisdiction.

We are indebted to Dean Mason Ladd, the late Professor Sheldon D. Elliott, and Professor Claude Brown for their experience in the publication of previous casebooks in which the authors participated. We also appreciate the permissions of the copyright owners to reproduce the various copyrighted excerpts from law reviews and books which have been included in this volume.
