PREFACE

A note on how this latest cumulation was constructed appears appropriate. Volume three of Law Books in Print, 1971, was used as the first step. The list of titles under each publisher was sent to that publisher with the request that all out-of-print items be deleted, all new items added, and any bibliographic or price changes be made. From the replies new listings were compiled. At the same time, all new publishers whose works were included in the annual cumulations of Law Books Published beginning in 1970 were similarly addressed. Meanwhile, new items which came to the attention of the editors, with dates prior to 1975 were being added. An effort was thus made to cover everything within the purview of this work, to make it as complete and as accurate a record as possible.

As in previous editions, government documents, statutes, law reports, digests, citators, loose-leaf services and annual Institutes, with few exceptions have been omitted. Some translations of foreign law and a few publications in English of foreign government origin, have been included since it is frequently difficult to find sources for these publications.

Small pamphlets and items under \$.50 (fifty cents) in price have been omitted. Several new features appear in this edition of *Law Books in Print*. New periodical titles which started publication in 1973 or later are now included. Reprints, microfilms, and cassettes are also included, and all are listed both under main entry and under appropriate subjects.

The computer process continues to be used in the production of these volumes. Each entry is keyboarded with complete bibliographical information which is reproduced each time the item appears (authors, editors, title, sub-title where appropriate, subjects). The magnetic tape thus forms the basis for future compilations which will include all items added in *Law Books Published* during intervening years.

The material is divided into two alphabets. One for authors and titles, and one for subjects and selected series. Names of persons *about* whom works are included are entered in the author/title file, for ease in locating. The title of the book will make clear whether it is *by* or *about* the person indicated.

We add a note about Library of Congress card numbers. These were omitted in previous editions of *Law Books in Print*. Titles from earlier editions which required revision for inclusion in this edition have L.C. card numbers added when located. Moreover, titles incorporated from *Law Books Published* have card numbers whenever available.

The editors gratefully acknowledge the assistance of Howard Sugarman, Rosalee Long and Harriet Wu of the Stanford Law Library. In particular, we wish to acknowledge the encouragement and impetus provided by Mr. Philip F. Cohen, president of Oceana Publications, Inc. and the devotion of Mr. Michael Ferdinand, Vice President, Production, of Glanville Publishers, whose dedication to solving all problems made the completion of this work possible.

As in the past, we present these volumes with the hope that they will be found useful to all who expect much from their use, and faithful to the promise of providing the best bibliographical information obtainable anywhere. We apologize for errors of duplication or omission and welcome constructive ideas and criticism for improvement.

HOW TO USE LAW BOOKS IN PRINT

The Author/Title list is arranged simply in alphabetical order, so that the location of an item either by one or more of its authors or editors or its title, is a matter of going down the alphabet until it is found. An example of both author and title listing may be the following:

The Subject listing is similarly alphabetical by subject. The unsubdivided subject appearing first, followed by the same subject subdivided either geographically or subject-wise. Series entries are interspersed among the subjects. Within each subject or series the entries are again alphabetical by author, or when no author is given, by title. An example follows:

Searching through a publisher's list will not only provide the actual books available, but will give some insight into the type of books published under its name, information which can prove very valuable.
