## PREFACE

Some occurrences of a date later than November 1979, when this edition had to go to press, could not be recorded in the relevant entries; a number of these, of the most general interest, are listed in a supplement preceding the first page of the biographies. The names in the second part of the supplement of those who received titles gazetted in the New Year Honours List, 1980, include some who have as yet no entry in the body of the book. The obituary, on pages 26–30, includes the deaths reported up to mid-November 1979.

A proof of each entry is posted to its subject every year for personal revision, but this cannot be sent unless an address is given. It should be pointed out that the numbers given of the children of a marriage are, unless otherwise indicated, those of the sons and daughters now living; also, that it is the practice to print the names of London clubs unaccompanied by the word London. Forenames printed within brackets are those which the subject of the entry does not commonly use. While every care is taken to ensure accuracy, neither the publishers nor the printers can admit liability for any loss incurred through misprint or other circumstances.

It cannot be stated too emphatically that inclusion in *Who's Who* has never at any time been a matter for payment or of obligation to purchase the volume.

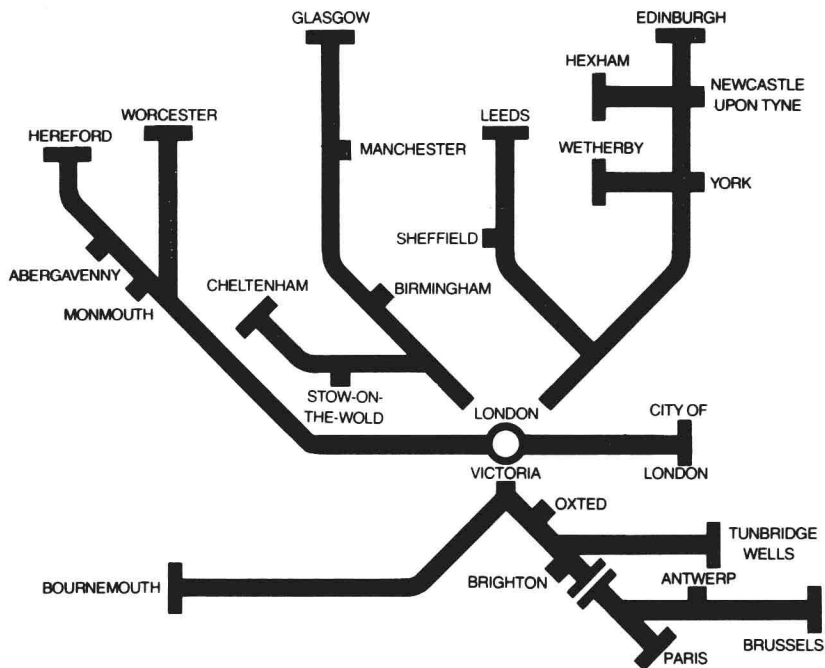

# The Malcolm Sargent Cancer Fund for Children

The Malcolm Sargent Cancer Fund for Children was launched in March 1968, as a lasting and practical memorial to the much-loved British musician whose name it bears. It is the only charity of its kind devoted entirely to children.

Over 500 new cases a year are accepted by the Fund, which must be prepared to give help for several years to any one child. Grants are given for warm clothing, help with heating bills, beds and bedding, nourishing foods, convalescent holidays, etc.

A Social Worker from Somerset wrote, after a grant had been sent to ensure that a child could be visited regularly in hospital: *"It will make such a lot of difference to the family to have this money available. At times like this there are all sorts of minor expenses that crop up and added up together it does look a little frightening at times. Can I say how much I appreciate your swift help. It is so very much appreciated and so very much more helpful to have immediate action. Would you please convey my very grateful thanks to your Trustees. I am certain that Sir Malcolm would have wanted it this way. I myself can always remember his kindness and patience with younger members of his audience and, in the early forties, when I collected his autograph he was such a kind person."*

The Malcolm Sargent Cancer Fund for Children is expanding the scheme of having its own Social Worker attached to the largest cancer centres. There are two Malcolm Sargent Social Workers at the Alder Hey Children's Hospital, Liverpool, one each at the Children's Hospital, Birmingham, Royal Manchester Children's Hospital, Royal Hospital for Sick Children, Edinburgh and the Royal Belfast Hospital for Sick Children. Further appointments will be made as finance permits. Thus the Fund is able to have counselling advice readily available to parents in addition to giving financial support by way of grants.

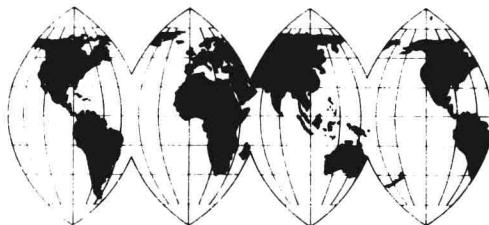
