

Introduction

It is both an honor and a challenge to be appointed the new editors of the YEAR BOOK OF OBSTETRICS AND GYNECOLOGY. Because the specialty of obstetrics and gynecology is becoming more complex and because the number of scientific articles on these topics is increasing each year, it was thought that it would be best to have three editors, each with special expertise. Accordingly, Dr. Kirschbaum has reviewed all the articles related to obstetrics, including maternal and fetal physiology, maternal complications, obstetric complications, fetal surveillance, labor and obstetric operations, analgesia and anesthesia, genetics and teratology, the puerperium, and the newborn. Dr. Morrow is responsible for articles on surgery, breast diseases, and gynecologic oncology, including preinvasive cervical disease, cervical carcinoma, endometrial neoplasia, ovarian tumors, and gestational trophoblastic disease, while Dr. Mishell has reviewed the articles dealing with reproductive endocrinology, infertility, menopause, sexuality, abortion, and ectopic pregnancy, as well as gynecologic infection and female urology.
