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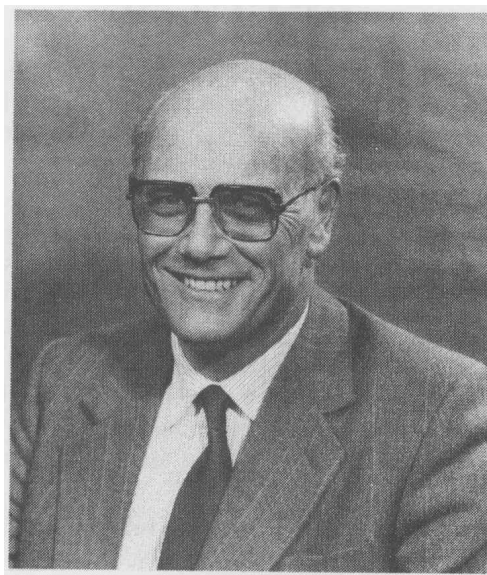
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FOREWORD

PREFACE

The international banking community has always maintained a low-key image that belies its impact on the rest of the world. This lack of prominence makes it almost impossible to find biographical details for any but a handful of bankers from the developed countries. Hence the need for **Who's Who in International Banking**, giving ready access to the lives and careers of those who hold the purse-strings of the world.

This 6th edition of **Who's Who in International Banking** has undergone major changes in both content and style. Only banks and bankers falling within clearly defined criteria have been included and the biographies are now fuller and more clearly presented. As with all Bowker-Saur **Who's Who** publications, entry is by invitation only and limited to those falling within pre-determined criteria. No charge is made to entrants and nor is purchase of any sort a condition of entry.

In *Part I*, over 4,000 biographies (each with a contact address) are given in alphabetical order, all of which have been sent for approval to the entrants themselves. The biographies aim to cover the main aspects of an entrant's personal and professional life, with special emphasis on professional career and interests. Inevitably, the fullness of the individual biographies varies. There are also constraints involved in translating posts and career equivalences from over 100 different national systems and many languages. However, as far as possible, the information has been updated to the end of February 1992.

Part II provides a country-by-country Banking Directory (with full contact details) and Index, covering virtually all senior executives from banks falling within the specified criteria. Coverage is truly international and not limited to the industrialised nations. Wherever possible world ranking, type of bank and total assets are also listed. For the most part, this information is up-to-date as of July 1990. For ease of access international banking organisations are accorded a separate section. Approximately 20,000 individuals are listed in the Directory and a unique index for each country enables the reader to locate any biography with ease.

A work of this magnitude is not possible without the assistance of many people. Special thanks must be given to the small army of researchers and translators who helped compile this Sixth Edition and to the staff at the banks who have been so patient in dealing with our many inquiries. Our final thanks should go to the entrants themselves, without whose co-operation this publication would not have been possible.

Entry Criteria: To be included in the book an individual must be a senior executive of a bank that falls within one of the following categories: the top 1000 banks of the world, the European top 500, the top American 200, the Asian top 200, the top 100 Latin American, the top 50 African banks or other prominent personalities from central banks and international banking institutions.

EDITOR'S NOTE

A proof of each biography is sent to the entrant for updating and amendment. Where necessary responses are translated into English. While every care is taken, neither the publishers nor the printers can admit liability for any loss incurred through misprint or other circumstances.
