INTRODUCTION

Scope

This book aims to fill a gap in the existing chess literature, namely in the field of periodicals. The original idea for it was borne out of my work on the *Chess Results* series. During my archival research, I realized that periodicals were the main sources to which one could refer for information on chess competitions, and that no comprehensive international list of these periodicals existed.

Focussing at first only on those publications most relevant to the task at hand, before long it occurred to me that I might do a service for researchers in other areas of chess such as theory, studies, problems, correspondence, and history in general. The leading periodicals usually cover all these fields, and are the product of a collective effort by numerous experts (players, problemists, historians, and others) to collect myriad detailed data, news, and ideas over the years.

The various bibliographies that have been published thus far are for the most part general in scope, and cover works written in a given language or in a given country. In contrast, my work aims to provide a record of the chess periodicals published around the world since 1836 (starting with the first issue of the Parisian *Le Palamède*, the first magazine devoted exclusively to chess) through 2008. The list includes magazines, bulletins, newsletters, yearbooks, handbooks, almanacs, calendars, and other types of printed material published

at regular intervals; on-line periodicals, which may become the source for a separate work, have been excluded.

General Plan of the Work

The contents of this book can be used by the reader in multiple ways. For each periodical listed, information is given about the time period, the language, and the country of publication (which may be especially useful for the historian), the topics covered (which can be singled out for particular purposes), and whatever further data are accessible about sponsoring organizations, publishing companies, issue numbers, frequency, and so on. Information about each item's availability in the major chess libraries of the world is included when possible.

The book is divided into two parts. The first comprises three types of publications: magazines, i.e., commercial periodicals identified by issue number and/or date of publication; bulletins, i.e., periodicals published by various organizations, also identified by issue number and/or date; and newsletters, i.e., letters or reports that are circulated periodically, identified by date. The much smaller Part II incorporates all other print publications that perhaps might not properly be called periodicals, although they are of a periodical nature, e.g., yearbooks, handbooks, almanacs, calendars, circulars, directories, pamphlets, ratings updates, and so on.

In both Part I and Part II, items are

presented in alphabetical order (except that titles starting with a number — e.g., 0–0 or 64— are placed at the very beginning). Entries are serially numbered with no interruption between the first and second parts. When the title of a publication begins with an article, this has been put in parentheses at the end, e.g., *The British Chess Magazine* is listed as *British Chess Magazine (The)*. In the many instances where items bear generic titles, these are accompanied by the name of the sponsoring organization in square brackets, e.g., *Bulletin* [Scottish Chess Association]. For the sake of exhaustiveness, variants of a same title have also been included, with a cross-reference to the original entry, e.g., *Buletin Informativ : Fisier-Cartoteca* see *Fisier-Cartoteca*. Cross-references are displayed in bold type throughout.

Each entry is structured as follows:

Title : Sub-title (Year[s] in print) Organization. Numbering. Frequency. Editor(s). Publisher(s). Place where printed. Country. Description. Category. Subject. Language. Notes. Source(s). Availability.

To avoid unnecessary repetitions, whenever the sponsoring organization is also the publisher, its name is put in square brackets alongside the title, e.g., *Chess Canada* [Chess Federation of Canada]. (As noted above, the name of the sponsor/publisher also appears in square brackets to distinguish a generic title.) Finally, no further mention of the sponsor/publisher is made when this is already apparent from the title or subtitle, as in *Chess Collectors Association Newsletter*.

Particular care has been devoted to publication dates, which can be found in parentheses after each title. When the data are known, the year dates of beginning and end of publication are given; a single year indicates the item was only published for one year. However, unlike books, whose dates of publication are usually easy to find, periodicals are often not accessible (especially if they were distributed only locally), and when they are it is not uncommon to find incomplete availability of

issues. The reader will therefore frequently find question marks after, or replacing digits in, a given date. A question mark alongside a year (e.g., 1950?), at either the beginning or the end of publication, means that the date cannot be established with certainty and that the issues that are available were used to make a reliable estimate. When question marks replace one or two digits in a date, they indicate that the exact year when publication began or ended is unknown, and can be estimated only within a certain span of years: if 19?? is given as the date the publication began, one should assume that it began after the year 1900; 195? indicates that the date can be calculated approximately to be between 1950 and 1959. When a question mark is given without a date as end of publication, it indicates that it is not known if and when publication ceased. Lastly, when no date is given after the short dash (e.g., 1950–) the periodical was still in print as of 2008.

The same sort of system has been used to deal with issue numbering and availability.

I also provide the reader with the information needed — including the request numbers — to find the item, when available, in the three main public chess libraries in the world — the Cleveland Public Library (U.S.A.), the Koninklijke Bibliotheek in the Hague (Netherlands), and the State Library of Victoria in Melbourne (Australia). If the item at hand is not available in any of these libraries, I list other important libraries where it can be found.

The book is completed by a list of sources, an index of periodicals listed by country, and a general index of periodicals.

Sources

All information used in the compilation of this book was taken from the main chess bibliographies available at present, and from the paper and online catalogs of the main public chess libraries. A list of all sources cited can be found in the “Sources” section following.
