ABSTRACT

This statistical bulletin reports historical data on the U.S. fresh vegetable market, generally covering the years 1949 through 1980. Production, consumption, acreage, price, export, and import data are reported on asparagus, snap beans, broccoli, cabbage, carrots, cauliflower, celery, sweet corn, cucumbers, lettuce, onions, green peppers, tomatoes, and melons. Data sources include the Statistical Reporting Service, Economic Research Service, the Bureau of Labor Statistics, and the Bureau of the Census.

PREFACE

This publication serves as a basic reference on the U.S. fresh vegetable industry, providing a wide range of production, price, foreign trade, and other benchmark data. It revises and updates Statistical Bulletin No. 558 published August 1976.

Data in this publication were reported as of June 30, 1981, and generally cover the years 1949 through 1980. These statistics serve as a supplement to the Vegetable Outlook and Situation, published four times a year by the Economic Research Service (ERS).

Extensive statistics on processed vegetables are available in Section VI, Raw Products, in the Almanac of the Canning, Freezing, and Preserving Industries, published annually by E.E. Judge and Sons, Westminster, Md. 21157.

Data for the tables in this publication were obtained from the Statistical Reporting Service (SRS), ERS, the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), and the Bureau of the Census. BLS stopped collecting retail prices and consumer price index data for tables 33, 41, 43, and 52 and stopped publishing data for tables 34-40, 42-47, 49, and 50, beginning January 1978. Data for table 54, commercial vegetables for fresh market for U.S. monthly and annual average index numbers of prices received by farmers (1967=100), were discontinued in June 1981 by SRS and replaced with the new index series (1977=100).

This report was compiled in the National Economics Division of ERS by Joan Pearrow and Wilma Davis. The tables were computerized in the Data Services Center of ERS by Ken Kaluziński, Ken King, and Dan Purcell.

NOTE

In the supply and utilization tables 81-97, utilization is simplified to exclude ending stocks, shrinkage, loss, shipment to territories, and military disappearance. Per capita consumption in tables 81-99 is derived by dividing civilian disappearance by the July 1 civilian population:
