The British Pharmacopoeia Commission Laboratory

The British Pharmacopoeia Commission Laboratory is situated in Teddington, south-west London. In March 2005, the Laboratory was relocated from its former premises in Canon's Park to new premises on the Laboratory of the Government Chemist campus.

The Laboratory's principal role is in the procurement, establishment, maintenance and sale of British Pharmacopoeia Chemical Reference Substances (BPCRS). The Laboratory also supports the work of the British Pharmacopoeia Commission (BPC) in the establishment of monographs for medicinal products available in the UK. The BPC is responsible for the publication of the British Pharmacopoeia (BP) and British Pharmacopoeia (Veterinary), and the British Approved Names. The BPC also participates in the work of the European Pharmacopoeia.

Quality control is continuously carried out in the Laboratory on almost 500 BPCRS (see catalogue) needed to support the practical monograph tests in both the British Pharmacopoeia and British Pharmacopoeia (Veterinary). New BPCRS are introduced into the BP every year, and the Laboratory aims to make them available as soon as possible following the publication of the new BP and no later than the effective date.

The BPC is part of the Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency (MHRA), an executive agency of the Department of Health. The primary objective of the MHRA is to protect public health by ensuring that medicines, healthcare products and medical equipment are safe for those who use them.

Controlled drugs requirements

Controlled drugs and category 1 precursor chemicals are subject to licensing and controls. It is the responsibility of the customer to obtain the necessary licences and other relevant documentation to comply with the laws of the importing country. For up-to-date information regarding controlled drugs and category 1 precursor chemicals, please refer to the UK Home Office website.

Documentation required for controlled drugs:

For UK customers, for Schedule 2 and 3 controlled drugs, a photocopy of the Home Office licence must be sent with the order. For Schedule 4 controlled drugs, a photocopy of the Home Office authorisation to possess document must be sent. For all non-UK customers, for Schedule 2, 3 and 4 controlled drugs, an import licence from the competent authority in your own country must be obtained and sent with the order.

Documentation required for category 1 precursor chemicals (Ephedrine Hydrochloride; Ergometrine Maleate; Ergotamine Tartrate; Pseudoephedrine Hydrochloride):

For UK and EU customers, a customer declaration of specific use(s) must be sent with the order.

For all customers outside the EU, an import licence from the competent authority in your own country must be obtained and sent with the order.

Example forms are included at the back of the catalogue. These forms may also be obtained at the UK Home Office website. Forms should be completed and signed by a senior responsible person.

British Pharmacopoeia Chemical Reference Substances Terms of Trade and Supply

Usage

British Pharmacopoeia Chemical Reference Substances (BPCRS) are issued under the authority of the British Pharmacopoeia Commission and are supplied solely for use in the tests and assays of the British Pharmacopoeia (BP) or British Pharmacopoeia (Veterinary) in which a BPCRS is required. They are issued for chemical analysis only, and may not be suitable for any other purposes. They are not intended for administration to humans or animals. BPCRS are supplied in unit packs containing sufficient material to carry out the prescribed procedures.

Storage

Customers are advised to **order only the quantities required**, particularly where a BPCRS is to be used for a quantitative test. Although BPCRS are of the required quality when dispatched, there is a risk of deterioration during storage.

BPCRS should be kept under the conditions stated in the appropriate monograph of the British Pharmacopoeia (BP) or British Pharmacopoeia (Veterinary). All BPCRS should be stored in well-sealed containers, and it is recommended that they are stored below 25°C. A BPCRS used for assay purposes should be stored between 2°C and 10°C.

Expiry Dates

All BPCRS are supplied with at least three months' shelf life. The current batch number is always listed on the website at www.bpclab.co.uk

Leaflets

Leaflets accompanying the BPCRS contain all pertinent information regarding analytical data and storage conditions, and advice on safe handling where necessary. **Certificates of analysis are not supplied**. Declared content figures and/or reference chromatograms are supplied where required.
