FOREWORD

Merger control is one of the essential elements in modern competition regulation. The United Kingdom has had a system of merger control for nearly 30 years, introduced by the provisions of the Monopolies and Mergers Act of 1965. Over this period a large number of merger references have been made to the Monopolies and Mergers Commission by successive Secretaries of State. The reports arising from these references are well known to lawyers who practise in this specialist area. It is perhaps surprising therefore that there has until now been a comparative lack of professional textbooks containing detailed information on the procedural and substantive aspects of merger control in this country.

Although this book by Roger Finbow and Nigel Parr carries no official endorsement from the MMC, nevertheless I welcome very much the arrival of this new and detailed work on a subject of such importance. In particular, it will be of value to those lawyers who are asked to advise on proposals for mergers, or act for companies before the OFT or MMC. It will also, I believe, be of value to company executives and financial advisers involved in the detailed planning and negotiation of mergers.

The idea for this book arose out of many years' practice in the area of U.K. merger control, and the realisation that there was no source of guidance for businessmen and their advisers in relation to the law, practice and economic assessment involved in the regulation of acquisitions, mergers and strategic alliances in the U.K.

We have endeavoured to state the law and practice as at November 10, 1994, but have dealt with those areas amended by the relevant provisions of the Deregulation and Contracting Out Act 1994 as if they were already in force. The amendments introducing the possibility of the Secretary of State accepting conduct undertakings in lieu of reference come into force on January 3, 1995 (before the anticipated date of publication of this book) and the amendments to the newspaper merger provisions will enter into effect on a date to be specified, believed to be Spring 1995.
