Preface

The *Compendium of Drug Therapy* was developed to meet the health-care practitioner's need for drug information that is at once reliable and comprehensive and yet easily accessible. The drugs covered in depth in this volume represent more than 95% of the medications prescribed by primary care physicians. In addition, basic prescribing information for less frequently used drugs is provided in summary tables. The information is organized according to therapeutic category (see section 1) and can be located by either brand or generic name in the general index or by searching for the drug on the contents page that begins each therapeutic section.

CHART FORMAT AND INFORMATION

The charts provided in this book are based on the manufacturers' most recent package literature and include all current FDA-approved indications. The dosages listed are those recommended by the manufacturer for patients with normal renal and hepatic function. Advice on altering dosages for patients with renal impairment or other special-risk conditions, as well as on the frequency of dosage adjustments, the preparation and delivery of parenteral solutions, and other essential dosage information, is provided in the section headed "Administration/Dosage Adjustments."

All contraindications and pertinent warnings and precautions given by the manufacturer are provided in edited form for conciseness and rapid access. The basic premise underlying the editing of material for these sections was to restrict the information to that considered practical and clinically relevant to the safe and effective use of the drug described. Additional precautions pertaining to the use of the drug in children and in pregnant and lactating women are provided in the boxes at the end of each chart. Also supplied in some instances are appropriately referenced precautions not contained in the manufacturer's package insert but pertinent to the use of the drug in special groups of patients, such as those with hepatic failure.

All adverse reactions reported by the manufacturer are listed according to the organ system affected and generally in order of decreasing frequency. Where known, reactions occurring in 1% or more of patients are printed in *italics*; some of the charts also provide data, when available, on the incidence of particular reactions. The charts also supply overdosage information and summaries of clinically significant drug interactions and altered laboratory values. The information provided in these sections is frequently supplemented by data from the current medical literature.

OTHER FEATURES

In addition to prescribing information, the *Compendium* contains several other features designed to help meet your drug-information needs:

- For quick access to information on a specific drug, a single index, listing drugs alphabetically by both brand name and generic composition, is provided in section 2.
- A full-color drug-identification guide is provided in section 3 to help you identify an unfamiliar drug by color, size, shape, and manufacturer's code number. This section also contains a directory of pharmaceutical manufacturers with emergency numbers you can call for further drug information around the clock, 365 days a year.
- A directory of drug information centers, poison control centers, comprehensive cancer centers, pain clinics, and other patient counseling and referral services is provided in section 1, under the heading "referral centers."

KEEPING UP WITH NEW DRUG INFORMATION

As new drugs are introduced—and new information on existing drugs becomes available—the *Compendium* may be kept up-to-date by using the monthly *Compendium Update* supplements that appear in *Drug Therapy* magazine. These supplements can be saved in the special pocket provided inside the back cover of this volume. Instructions for using the supplements and the yellow labels provided with this book will be found periodically in the *Compendium*. A new, completely revised edition of the *Compendium* is published each year.
