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Preface



As publisher of *Technical Analysis of STOCKS & COMMODITIES*, The Trader's Magazine, I get hundreds of calls from readers requesting information on products and services available to traders and investors. To address this continuing need for information, we are publishing our second edition of a product and service directory covering the field of trading and investing. The *Investment Information Directory: Stocks, Bonds, Futures, Commodities, Options, Mutual Funds* compiles a year of research on products and services available to investors, both domestic and international, and breaks the information down into categories: publications (magazines, newsletters, investment letters, charting and research services, text and trade books, reference materials and courses); software; hardware; data services; advisories and brokerages; funds; and exchanges.

In addition to the information on products and services included, for those just starting out in computerized trading or for those who wish to upgrade to keep up with technology, I have added to this edition an evaluation of personal computers (PCs) available on the market today. Not only is the PC a prerequisite for computerized trading, but it is also, plainly and simply, an infinitely helpful tool in managing accounts and portfolios.

For those who are just starting out or who want to increase their exposure to the field of trading, also included is a chapter on forming user groups. A user group is a club or special interest group focusing on using computers, technical analysis or just about any aspect of investing. User groups can serve as a forum for the exchange of ideas, provide support and advice from more experienced investors, and help investors find solutions to problems they may have encountered in trading. User groups may even be able to point investors in some new directions.

Finally, a reading list of classic and reliable texts on technical analysis and trading that will not quickly become outdated is included to serve as a starting place for novice traders and as a resource list for all traders.

Though the purpose of this directory is not to critically evaluate the products and services listed nor to make recommendations for purchasing investment products, those products and services designated with a superscripted "S&C" have been reviewed in our

monthly periodical, *Technical Analysis of STOCKS & COMMODITIES* magazine. After the investor has narrowed down the search for a product using this directory, it would be a good idea to consult an appropriate issue of the magazine for a critical evaluation. *STOCKS & COMMODITIES* is a magazine for professional traders on how to trade and invest in stocks, futures, bonds, options and mutual funds using technical analysis. Each month presents in-depth, step-by-step, how-to articles on trading strategies, price and volume charting and computerized trading methods, as well as reviews of the latest in trading software, books and services.
