Introduction

Lawyers and law-related professionals need an easy-to-use tool that leads to the books, periodicals, databases, and organizations that can answer their questions. Those outside the legal profession may also require a tool that directs them to the more basic law books and to the organizations of, and related to, the legal profession.

The *Encyclopedia of Legal Information Sources (ELIS)* is able to meet the needs of both professionals and laypersons. For example, under the topic “Partnership,” *ELIS* citations range from *Partnership Basis and Basis Adjustments*, a highly technical tax management portfolio published by the Bureau of National Affairs, to *The Partnership Book: How to Write Your Own Small Business Partnership Agreement*, published by Nolo Press, which specializes in self-help law books.

Method of Compilation

Extensive research was required in order to gather the sources of information on the hundreds of subjects included in this publication. A wide range of sources was consulted, including online data bases, bibliographies, indexes of the legal literature, and publishers’ promotional brochures. In each instance, the details have been carefully verified and corroborated.

Because of the crucial importance of timeliness in the legal field, only the most recent and up-to-date sources have been cited. Material published prior to 1980 has been excluded, unless considered a landmark or classic contribution in the field. In order to keep pace with new publications and additional law-related topics, interedition supplements are planned.

Subject Headings Narrowly Defined

To assure that information can be located easily, subject headings have been kept as specific as possible. This edition of *ELIS* includes citations under 460 different topics and is supplemented by numerous cross-references.

Subjects were selected for inclusion based upon their timeliness and topical importance in the field of law. To make *ELIS* as useful as possible, the entire range of legal concerns has been incorporated, including specific crimes (Fraud, Libel and Slander); legal specialties (Antitrust Law, Environmental Law, Family Law); trial procedures (Appellate Procedure, Cross-Examination, Sentencing); and current legal issues (Capital Punishment, Euthanasia, Legal Ethics and Malpractice).

Topics Provide Special Assistance

While most of the subjects contained in *ELIS* are fairly self-explanatory, a few require special mention:

- The user who is unfamiliar with legal materials is advised to consult the topic “Legal Research.” Under this heading are listed “how to” books as well as statutes, case reports, digests, encyclopedias, and dictionaries basic to a legal collection. Entries are briefly annotated.
- While subject-specific formbooks, restatements, and uniform laws are listed under each topic, they are also gathered under the topics “Legal Forms,” “Restatements,” and “Uniform and Model Acts.”
- Basic legal materials of each state can be found under the topic “States.”
- Under “State Law Compilations” are listed sources that compile state laws by subject or sources that cite compilations.

—The topic “Treaties and Conventions” includes a special subheading “Collections” under which are listed general and subject-specific collections of treaties.

“Outline of Contents” Speeds Access to Topics

For the most efficient use of this publication, do *not* go directly to the text to look up the subject on which information is sought. Instead, find the appropriate term in the extensive and detailed Outline of Contents, where it is possible to scan the list of headings quickly to determine the exact form of the subject term that has been used and to be guided by cross-references to related subjects. If the term being sought has not been used as a subject heading, the Outline of Contents will refer to the term actually used.

Bibliography Covers 19 Kinds of Sources

Under each heading, citations are found for a wide variety of sources, both print and nonprint, on a particular topic. A complete list of the kinds of sources cited, represented as subheadings in *ELIS*, is outlined below, in the sequence in which they appear (although not all types of sources are listed for each subject).

Type of source categories are arranged in order of importance to the user. Legal researchers would begin an information search by consulting the primary sources—statutes, restatements, and reporters. Additional data could be gathered from secondary bibliographic sources—proceeding from handbooks to textbooks to encyclopedias, etc. Beyond the printed information sources, researchers may find it helpful to contact individual organizations, either by consulting directories and biographical sources or scanning the lists of associations and research centers found in *ELIS*. Online databases can be extremely helpful for legal research. However, because of the cost involved, such an information-gathering device is often impractical. Statistical data is perhaps the least important source, while audiovisuals are primarily a teaching tool.

Arrangement and Form of Entries

Entries are arranged alphabetically by (1) subject, and further subdivided by (2) type of source, and (3) publication title or organization name. Complete citations are provided for each information source. Citations for publications include title, author or editor, publisher’s name and address, and publication date or frequency. For databases, citations include database name, producer, and producer’s address. Citations for organizations include name and address. For example:
