PREFACE

Welcoming users to the tenth edition of this Handbook, I am both surprised and delighted that this paper product remains not merely viable but buoyant in a world where the printed page is fast being replaced by the electronic screen. The ease with which words can be searched and accessed online by hand-held devices is remarkable, but the sheer physical pleasure of being able to stick strips of repositionable adhesive paper into the pages of one's choice and to underline a word, a phrase or an entire paragraph with a fluorescent felt-tip pen is hard to replicate with the lean, mean confines of a Kindle.

Another edition, another set of laws: some are old favourites, scarcely changed by time and apparently destined to be reproduced forever. Others are familiar but, through substantial amendment, must be re-learned. Yet more are completely fresh and may not be known to the user at all. Just as a garden contains its old oaks and elms, its shrubs and its easy-to-plant, easy-to-replace bedding plants, so too does this collection of intellectual property documents represent the sweep of legislation from the timeless to the transient.

One new entrant in this edition is the controversial Anti-Counterfeiting Trade Agreement, the dreaded "ACTA". On account of its somewhat secretive conception and early evolution, it was criticised and reviled by many people on account of the great evils which it was believed to contain, even before they had seen a word of it. Once a regular flow of leaks and eventual disclosure of its contents gave the world a chance to peruse its contents, it was criticised and reviled by many people on account of the absence of the powerful and coercive provisions which it did not contain. In the cold light of day, ACTA can now be viewed for what it really is: (i) a moderately damp squib so far as enforcement and genuine relief against intellectual property infringement is concerned, (ii) an anguished cri de coeur from countries that have encouraged intellectual property investment and benefited from it to the effect that the current erosion of right-holders' commercial expectations cannot continue indefinitely and (iii) an object lesson in how to alienate a large army of neutral third parties when an opportunity to educate and persuade them is lost.

Another controversial newcomer to the tenth edition is the Digital Economy Act 2010 which, like ACTA, has been attacked from both sides. In fact, it has been attacked on four sides since, apart from rights owners and unauthorised downloaders of copyright-protected materials, internet service providers also have a say, Further, there are those who are quite indifferent to the balance of power between IP owners, users and conduits but who dislike the format of the legislation itself, since it consists principally of a set of powers to make rules rather than laying down the rules themselves.

As in previous issues, there is a list of people and parties entitled to my gratitude. My friends and colleagues at Olswang LLP have provided me with much food for thought and encouragement to eat it. They have also provided me with a chance to try out some of my own ideas, if sometimes trying their patience in the process. Moving on to production, the LexisNexis team has again improved upon its superlatively efficient performance of what are, for most of us, mundane and unglamorous tasks. Finally, I must thank the users of this Handbook who have emailed me with comments and suggestions for its improvement. To all of you I owe a considerable debt.
