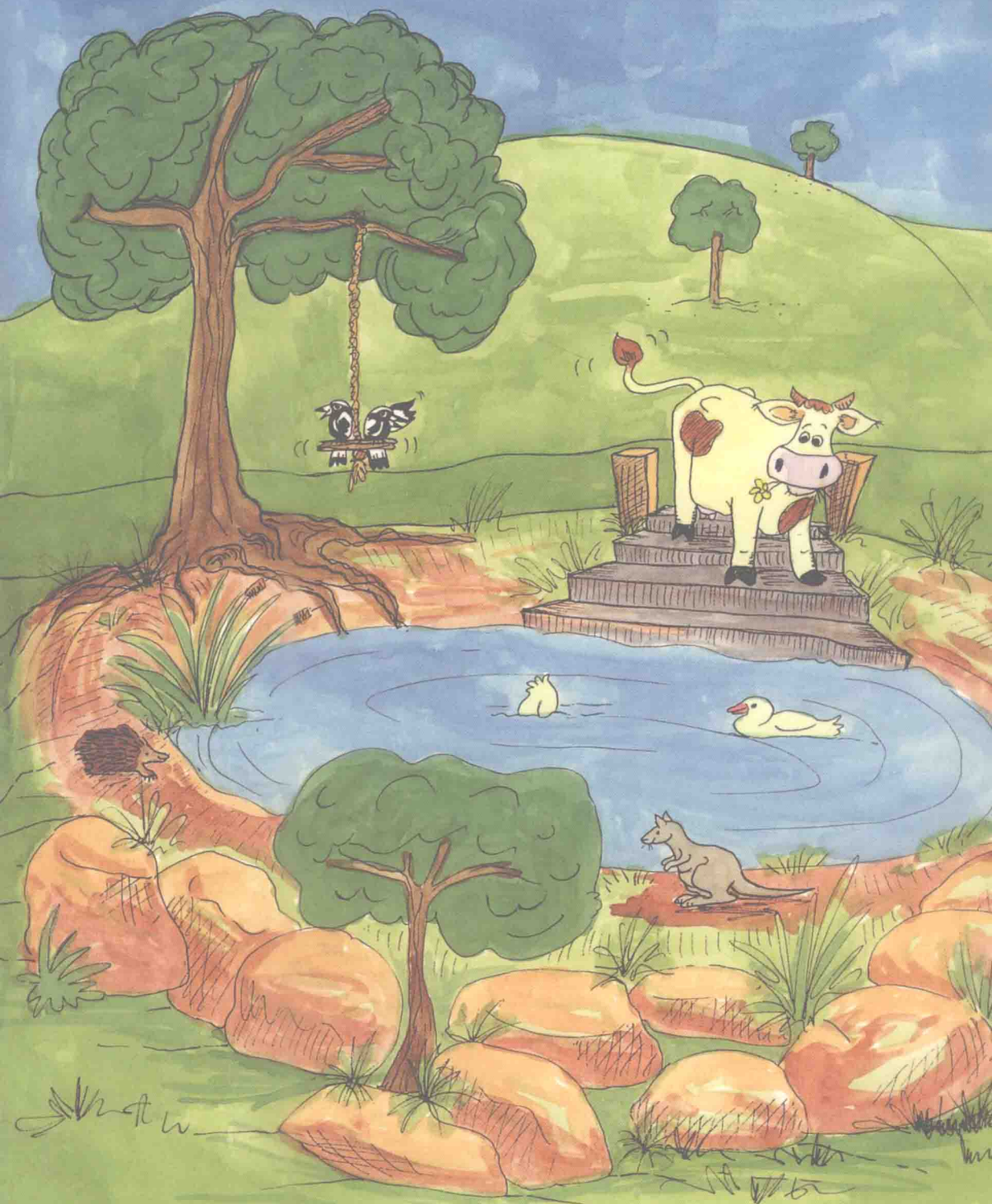
I want to shorten the road ...



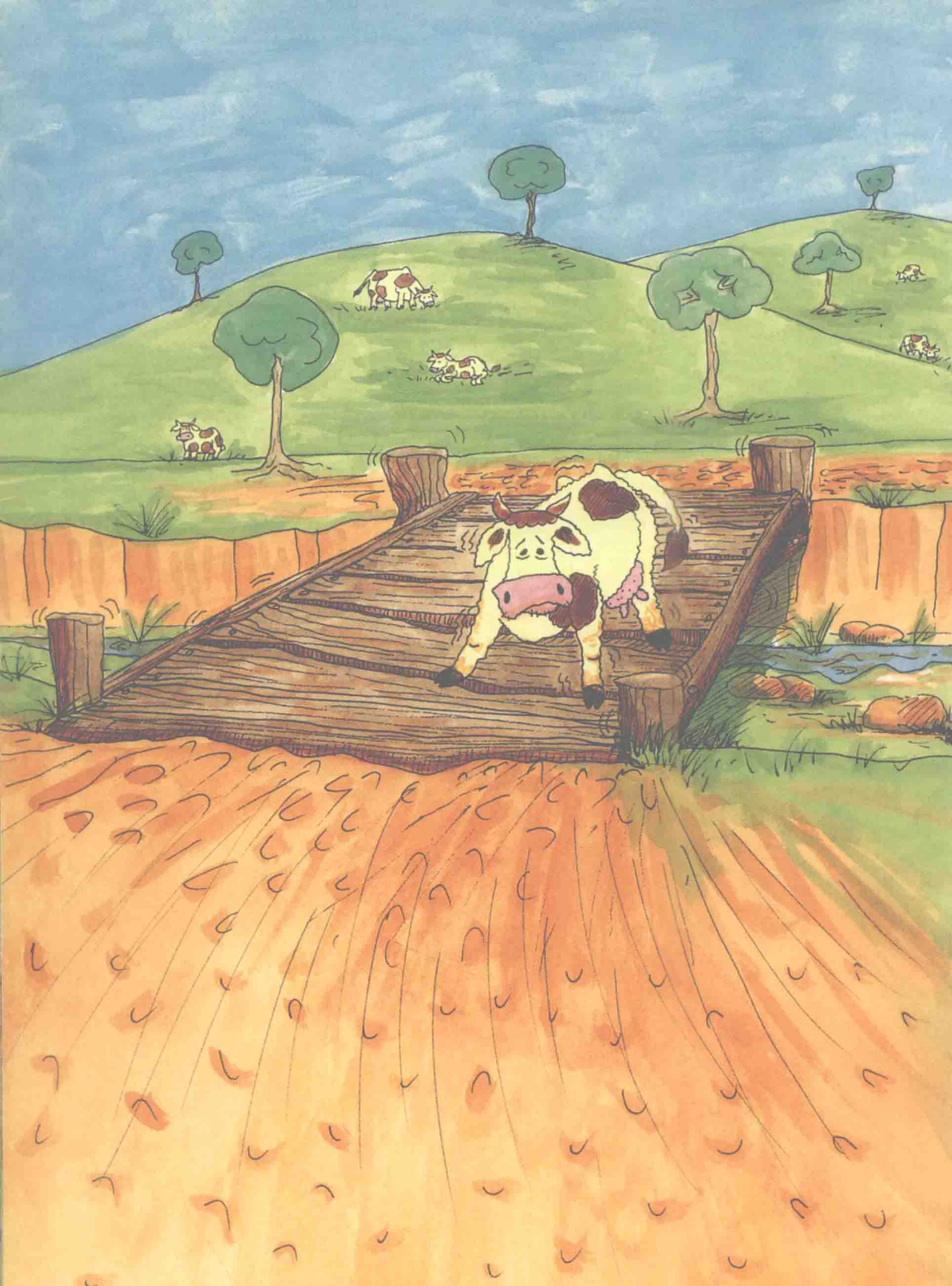
... because we could get to Nan's house that much more quickly.

I wish I could widen the dam where Molly drinks.



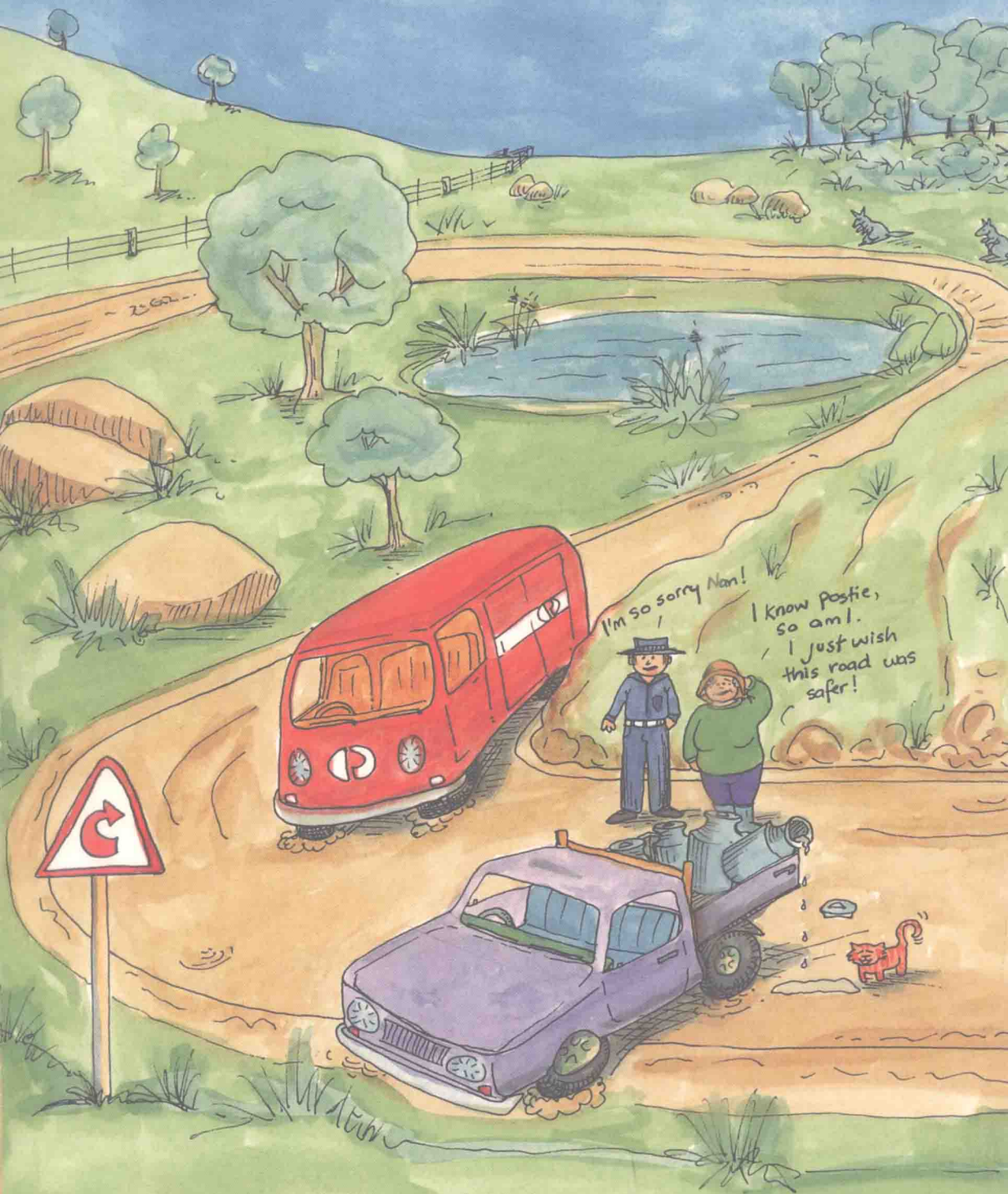
I wouldn't shift the old gum tree.



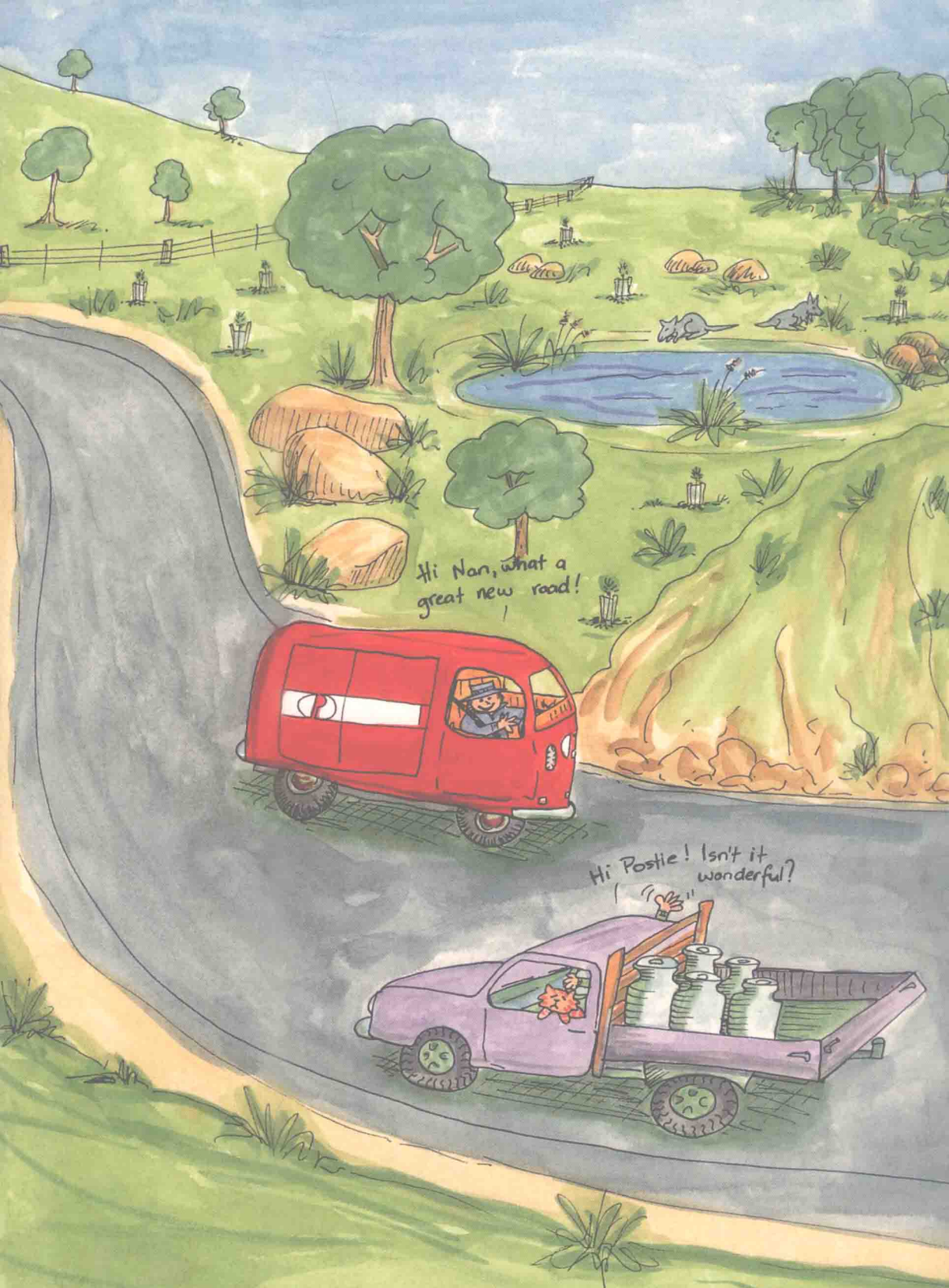
I'd design a stronger bridge ...
