PREFACE

“... there still appears to be considerable ignorance about the consequences which this Convention will soon have for the jurisdiction of our Courts, and ... these deserve study and preparation in advance” (Lord Justice Kerr in *Citadel Insurance Co v Atlantic Union Insurance Co SA* [1982] 2 Lloyd’s Rep 543 at 549).

The Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments Act 1982 is perhaps the most important piece of legislation relating to civil procedure enacted in this country this century. It, together with the amendments to the Rules of the Supreme Court, will effect fundamental changes in the law relating to jurisdiction and judgments in the United Kingdom. The primary purpose of the 1982 Act is to give effect in the law of the United Kingdom to the Brussels Convention of 1968 on jurisdiction and the enforcement of judgments in civil and commercial matters. It introduces a new concept of domicile for the purposes of jurisdiction. The 1968 Convention is given the force of law and similar (but not identical) rules of jurisdiction for intra-United Kingdom cases are applied. There are new provisions for the enforcement of intra-United Kingdom judgments. For the first time non-money judgments given by courts in other Contracting States will be enforceable, and non-money judgments rendered in one part of the United Kingdom will be enforceable in other parts. It cannot be said that the new system will be simple. Thus the jurisdictional rules of the English courts will differ depending on whether the defendant is domiciled in another part of the United Kingdom (1982 Act, Schedule 4), or is domiciled in another Contracting State (1982 Act, Schedule 1), or is domiciled in a non-Contracting State (Ord. 11, r. 1(1)). Foreign judgments will be enforceable under Part I of the 1982 Act (judgments of Contracting States), Part II of the 1982 Act (judgments of UK courts), the Foreign Judgments (Reciprocal Enforcement) Act 1933 (the Isle of Man, Guernsey, Jersey and some eight foreign and Commonwealth countries), the Administration of Justice Act 1920 (most Commonwealth countries) and at common law (particularly those countries with whom there are no reciprocal arrangements, such as the United States).

The object of this book is to provide a commentary on the Act and the Convention, to indicate some of the main areas of difficulty and offer some solutions to them, and to deal with the main changes to the Rules of the Supreme Court. There have now been over 30 judgments of the European Court of Justice on the Convention and I have endeavoured to take account of them, together with some of the more important judgments in the original Contracting States. The European Court has not made any use of decisions of national courts and it is well to bear in mind that “the persuasive value of a particular court’s decision must depend on its reputation and status, the extent to which its decisions are binding on courts of co-ordinate and inferior jurisdiction in its own country and the coverage of the national law reporting system” (*Fothergill v Monarch Airlines* [1981] AC 251, at 284, per Lord Diplock).

Preface

Dr. J H C Morris QC very kindly read a draft of the manuscript and made many helpful comments and suggestions, and his ideas were as valuable as one would expect from one whose contribution to the conflict of laws has been so great (see *The Hollandia* [1982] QB 872, at 884, per Lord Denning MR). Mr. Ulrich Stahl helped me with the German material to which I refer and raised a number of useful points for inclusion. Maureen Higgins, my secretary, dealt excellently, as always, with a difficult manuscript. This book is dedicated to my wife, Sarah.

NOTE

At the time this book went to press, the provisions of the Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments Act 1982 relating to the 1968 Convention and to intra-United Kingdom jurisdiction and enforcement of judgments had not been brought into force. But some of the changes to the general law came into force on 24 August 1982, most notably s. 24(1)(a), (2)(a) and (3) (interim relief and protective measures in cases of doubtful jurisdiction); s. 30 (proceedings for torts to foreign immovable property); s. 32 (foreign judgments given in breach of agreement for settlement of disputes); s. 33 (abolition of the rule in *Harris v Taylor* [1915] 2 KB 580 and *Henry v Geoprosco International Ltd* [1976] QB 726 on what constitutes a submission to the jurisdiction of a foreign court); s. 34 (abolition of non-merger rule).

The amendments to the Rules of the Supreme Court were made in July 1983 (S.I. 1983 No. 1181). The amendments which fall within the scope of this book will not come into force until s. 2 of the 1982 Act comes into force, except for the amendment to Ord. 12, r. 8, which came into force on 1 October 1983.
