## Introduction

Medical acronyms, abbreviations, and symbols have become the shorthand of medicine. Time and economy have necessitated their creation; space has dictated their overwhelming usage. The proliferation of medical research and knowledge in recent years and the subsequent explosion of literature in all areas of the health care field testify to these facts. Rarely is a medical article, journal, or text published today without extensive use of these medical timesavers. Although such terminology is a time- and space-saving device, many writers do not follow the general rule of defining a term when it first appears, placing the burden of identification on the reader. Indeed, acronyms for units of measurement when used with numbers are almost never identified, for instance cm or kd.

The purpose of MASA: Medical Acronyms, Symbols, and Abbreviations is, as in the original edition, to identify medical acronyms and to explain abbreviations and symbols, rather than to dictate correct usage. MASA covers all of the major specialties and subspecialties of medicine and related fields, and it includes terminology commonly used as well as that just recently introduced into the literature. This second edition is the most comprehensive published to date and includes more than 32,000 entries derived from primary sources—an increase of about 12,000 over the first edition.

Compilation has been achieved by a painstakingly thorough search of the medical literature, not just by a pulling together of already existing sources. Our primary sources have been the latest books in the vast range of medical specialties as well as the hundreds of medical journals published each year, where the most up-to-date information is available. In addition, MASA contains certain terms that, even though they are obsolete, are included because they may be found in the older literature and in medical records.

### GUIDE TO USAGE

Usage is often a matter of writing style, and although some attempts have been made at standardization, these are often sporadic and usually limited to one field. For instance, ECG is used by all of the cardiology journals, but EKG is often found in journals far removed from this specialty. For specialists of hematology and thrombosis, t-PA is used for tissue plasminogen activator, but in other areas TPA is more apt to be used.

Alphabetizing is letter-by-letter rather than word-by-word, and numerals have been ignored for the purpose of alphabetizing. Therefore, 2-D will be found under D. For the sake of consistency, the definitions of the acronyms and abbreviations are presented in the singular form, unless the meaning dictates otherwise. There has been no attempt to list all of the possible grammatical forms of a word; thus, EEG may apply to either electroencephalograph, electroencephalographic, or electroencephalogram, depending on context. Acronyms for chemical compounds may represent either the salt or the acid.

A stylistic variation among publishers is the use of periods and capital or lower-case letters. We have followed the general trend of using primarily capital letters for the acronyms unless usage is otherwise firmly established, such as GvHD. The use of periods has been limited to abbreviations of titles or ranks, such as D.R. (Diplomate in Radiology).

Like language itself, acronyms tend to undergo transition and we have noted as many of these changes as possible. In general, when an acronym is less preferred, we have provided the reader with a "see" reference to the more commonly used acronym. For example, Ps is no longer an official abbreviation. We have indicated "See P (Pseudomonas)"; and since there are multiple listings under P, the specific reference is given in parentheses.

"See also" is used for terms that are closely related, such as HSE and HSVE. If a word or phrase has more than one acronym, the alternate acronym is indicated in parentheses with an "also":

N/S normal saline (also NS)

When a definition is not obviously related to its acronym, as often occurs with Latin terms, the source is given in parentheses:

Prox luc the day before (proxima luce)

For terms that have essentially the same meaning, such as computer-assisted and computer-aided, or treatment and therapy, the alternate form is given in parentheses:

CAI computer-assisted (or aided) instruction

We have not included acronyms for hospitals, medical centers, or medical schools, or for journals or books. Chemical symbols are included, but not those for chemical compounds, such as CO or NaCl, although chemical symbols may appear as part of an acronym, for example, FeZ.

We have attempted to make MASA as comprehensive as possible so that it becomes a viable and indispensable research tool in the health care and medical communication fields.
