

Preface

We have designed *Principles of Writing Research Papers* as a guide to research papers in all disciplines. The text features advice on the judicious handling of research materials alongside extensive coverage of electronic research. Rooted in the fundamentals of thorough library research, this guide encourages Internet searching as well as the value of field research. It endorses the written word while recognizing the value of graphics, audio, video, and slide presentations. Below is a list of its many features.

Emphasis on Writing in the Disciplines

We explore research, style, and format through the lenses of many disciplines, helping students in the humanities, social sciences, and natural sciences to approach a topic in a given field, conduct valid research, and present the results in an appropriate format. As we developed the text, we tried to acknowledge the differences in research style across the disciplines: science students examine and test a hypothesis while literature students advance a thesis statement. Science students do more field research than do philosophy or history students. Science students present their research differently from humanities students. All of these aspects of writing from research are examined and explained in this second edition, which now includes the following:

- Discussion of addressing and fulfilling research assignments across the disciplines, including those that call for theoretical inquiry, empirical inquiry, and analysis for a review article.
- Comprehensive lists of discipline-specific scholarly bibliographies, printed indexes, and encyclopedias.
- Comprehensive lists of websites and web search engines from across the disciplines.

- Coverage of field research, especially useful to researchers in the social and natural sciences, including treatment of laboratory notes.
- Material on how to organize a variety of papers and reports, including a lab investigation or field report, scientific analysis, and other paradigms used in the humanities.
- Sample student papers, of MLA, APA, CBE, and CMS documentation styles.

Coverage of Electronic Research Tools

Chapter 3, "Searching the World Wide Web," offers advice on using every aspect of the Web, including regular search engines and metasearch engines, Internet bibliographies, and discipline-specific search engines. This chapter also provides advice for finding useful home pages, online magazines, and news articles; using listsery, usenet, and chat; and evaluating Internet sources.

Coverage of Field Research

Chapter 4, "Collecting Data Outside the Library," guides students in finding their own primary sources, from reading personal papers and setting up interviews to using media sources, as well as conducting research using questionnaires, case studies, observation, and laboratory tests.

Coverage on the Ethical Dimensions of Research

Coverage of ethics in research focuses on such issues as honoring copyright, working in collaborative groups, crediting online sources, seeking permission to publish material on a website, and plagiarism.
