WHAT IS A FAKE BOOK?

When a musician is asked to play a song he's never played before, he "fakes" it. One of the most valuable possessions any musician can have is a **fake book** which contains the melodies, lyrics and chords for hundreds and hundreds of songs. With the access to the melody, lyrics and chords, the musician can improvise his own arrangement of a song.

In this fake book, **tablature** notation is also included for each song.

ALPHABETICAL LISTING

In the ALPHABETICAL LISTING, the song titles are listed alphabetically, followed by the name of the recording artist. The page on which each song can be found is the number to the left of the song title.




STRUM PATTERNS ABOUT THE STRUMS

The tunes in this fakebook include suggested strum patterns (Strum No. 2). These numbers refer to the numbered strumming patterns on the next two pages. Practice playing them with a flatpick and always keep your strumming wrist loose.

The strumming notation uses arrows to indicate up or down strokes; all other symbols are standard music notation (accents, ties, dotted notes, etc.) except for occasional \underline{x} marks. These refer to the Chuck Berry-style extensions of barred chords, such as the following:




When a strum pattern has an eighth-note feel, strum eight alternating upand-down-strokes, and do not touch the strings with your flatpick where tied notes or rests occur. This will help you strum smoothly and rhythmically. For example, on Strum Pattern No. 2:



Do these strums without touching the strings.

Likewise, when a pattern has a sixteenth-note feel, do sixteen alternating up-and-down-strokes per measure and leave appropriate rests or ties by not touching strings. For example, on Strum Pattern No. 4:



Strum, but do not touch the strings.

Notice that some shuffle beats are expressed two ways: With dotted notes, as is often done in pop and jazz notation, and with triplets, which is technically more accurate. (See Strum Pattern No. 7 for a sample.)


STRUM PATTERNS

No. 1 BASIC ROCK	The most-often-used pattern in rock is all down-strokes. The "extensions" are optional. Examples: DAY TRIPPER, SURFIN' U.S.A. most Chuck Berry tunes.
No. 2 BASIC ROCK	The second-most-used rock strum has a more easy-going feel than Strum Pattern No. 1 Examples: HERE COMES THE SUN, STAND BY ME.
No. 3 FUNK/ROCK	Remember to play all the sixteenth note strokes even though you only touch the strings on half of them. Examples: WILD THING SWEET HOME ALABAMA.
No. 4 FUNK/DISCO	Example: STAYIN' ALIVE
No. 5 ROCK BALLAD	Here are two possible up-and-down stroke patterns. Example: HEY JUDE. (Notice that Strum Pattern No. 5 is similar to a slowed-down Strum Pattern No. 3.
No. 6 FAST ROCK	This strum pattern is two bars long. Be sure to play two bars of alternating up-and-down strokes (eight strokes per bar.) Example: GOOD LOVIN'.
No. 7 ROCK SHUFFLE	The extensions are optional Examples: THAT'LL BE THE DAY, SOME KIND OF WONDERFUL, DOCTOR, MY EYES.
No. 8 BOOGIE SHUFFLE	This is the same as Strum Pattern No. 7, but faster. The alternating up-and-down strokes allow for a speedier tempo. The extensions are optional. Examples: BLUE SUEDE SHOES, AT THE HOP.
No. 9 FAST COUNTRY SHUFFLE	This strum pattern is like Strum Pattern No. 8, but with a little extra swing. Examples: WAKE UP LITTLE SUSIE, CAN'T BUY ME LOVE.

No. 10 AST COUNTRY HUFFLE	Examples: YAKETY YAK, WHO DO YOU LOVE
o. 11 OCK SHUFFLE	Examples: MEMPHIS TENNESSEE, HI-HEEL SNEAKERS' LAY DOWN SALLY
No. 12 O DIDDLEY - TYLE	Examples: BO DIDDLEY, NOT FADE AWAY
No. 13	The accent can also fall on the <i>first</i> sixteenth note of each group of four instead of the <i>third</i> sixteenth note. Example: JIVE TALKIN'
No. 14 BOLERO	Example: BECK'S BOLERO
No. 15 4 ROCK	Example: Pink Floyd's MONEY
No. 16 8 or 12/8 TIME	Play this 6/8 figure twice in a row for one bar of 12/8 time. Examples: SLEEP WALK, RED HOUSE
No. 17 ATIN APACHE HYTHM	Example: APACHE
No. 18 WALTZ	Could be used for backup on Randy Rhoad's DEE

n't hesitate to experiment with all of these Strum Patterns. They can be varied in many different ways. For example, you can add sixteenth note strums to make a strum pattern more energetic and add accents to give a strum pattern a unique sound. It's a good idea to listen to records and other players to gain more ideas.
