

前 言

"为什么单词手册我都背熟了,可一看到文章句子,尤其是一 些长句子时,我就头痛,怎么也搞不懂它的意思呢?"

这是我近些年教授大学英语时学生经常问的一个问题。对此, 起初我不知道如何回答得完满;逐渐地我发现,学生的这类问题非 常普遍, 这迫使我去从多方面寻找答案。终于, 我明白了产生这类 问题的原因是英语语法与中文语法的差别。因此, 从语法入手, 有 效地分析句子结构, 上述问题就会迎刃而解。在大学英语四级考试 以及其他一些英语考试中,单纯语法题目的分值比例并不很大,但 是测试语法的目的不单单是十几道选择题就可以概括的。对语法的 掌握贯穿于英语的听说读写译各个环节,而大学期间教师对系统的 语法讲解较少, 也较枯燥, 学生头脑中的语法体系变得越来越模 糊, 这不是单纯的语法问题, 还在很大程度上影响了学生的英语综 合能力。一位英语专家曾说过:"系统地掌握英语语法、是举一反 三地学习英语和熟练地使用英语的前提。"为此,我们结合1989年 至 2000 年历年大学英语四级考题中的语法题目,对语法重点、难 点、解题技巧进行分析归纳、并且结合大量练习题予以强化、使学 生既能系统地掌握语法, 又能有针对性地应试, 这是我们编写这本 《语法分册》的初衷。

本书的最大特点是针对性强,重点突出,分析深入浅出,不仅适用于四级应试的学生,而且也有助于 TOEFL 考生以及参加其他英语测试的考生备战语法。另外,本书在解析部分运用箭头标志帮助读者迅速找到解题思路,清晰直观。

本书分五大部分:

- 一、热身练习:共有10套语法练习题。
- 二、重点语法讲解:分10章,每章又分4个部分:概述、历年考题汇总、归纳分析、本章练习题。

三、语法模拟试题:共有15套语法模拟题和完形填空题。四、参考答案。

五、完形填空:包括完形填空解题技巧和练习题。

此外, 书后还附有最新《大学英语教学大纲·语法结构表》, 这样有助于考生明确大纲要求, 查漏补缺, 做到考前心中有数。

由于编者水平经验有限,书中不足之处在所难免,敬请读者批评指正。
