前言

怎样学好英语,这一直是个争议颇多的问题,也是英语教师们一直在思考与研究的课题。图书市场上,英语学习用书名目繁多,各类试题集更是如雨后春笋一般层出不穷。然而,国外已有研究表明,仅仅做大量试题是不可能提高英语运用能力的。因此,我们始终认为,学好英语、提高英语水平,其关键在于要有适量的语言输入(imput),让学生不断接触新鲜的语言环境。在各种考试似已成为一种"产业(industry)"的今天,强调扎实的语言基础、良好的语言修养,则显得尤为重要。

本着这一宗旨,我们编纂了这本词典。本词典的优势集中体现于例句的新颖性、时代性和实用性,具体而言,主要有以下几个特点:第一,所有例句都是从最近几年的英美报纸杂志上选摘而来,而不像某些其他词典那样"相互借鉴、资源共享",从这个意义上说,本词典中的所有例句都是"原创"的。近半年以来,编者像深山老林中的淘金者那样在浩如烟海的资料库中搜索,有时花上一整天时间也只找到



一两个合适的句子——由此可见,本词典的每一个例句都是精挑细选而成的佳句。第二,所选例句既考虑到政治上的时代性,又考虑到语言上的新颖性、内容上的可读性和信息上的有效性。我们相信,读者在使用本词典时定会有茅塞顿开、豁然开朗之感。第三,词典中的所有例句均配有中文释义,既便于读者理解,也使读者同时获得一次学习英译汉的机会。

在编写过程中,我们得到了复旦大学大学 英语教学部和上海科技教育出版社的鼎力协助,在此表示衷心的感谢。

由于编者水平和经验所限,本词典中存在的不足和疏漏之处,恳请广大读者批评指正。

abrupt [▲] a. 突然的,(举止、言谈)唐突的;陡峭的

On our narrow roads, filled with hairpin turns, sudden drops, and ~ hills, speed is a harrowing prospect. 在狭窄的路上,到处都是急转弯、急落的下坡和陡峭的小山,高速驾车想想就可怕。

absence * n. 缺乏,不存在

In the ~ of gravity, people are without the

signals that they depend on for orientation and balance. 没有了重力,人们便失去了他们赖以判断方向、把握平衡的信号。

The ~ of details about his young adulthood, plus his modest educational background, has led some to claim that Shakespeare is just a pseudonym for someone far more distinguished. 人们对莎士比亚的青年时代知之甚少,加上他并没有什么显赫的教育背景,这使得某些人认为"莎士比亚"只不过是某个更杰出的人物使用的假名。

Research libraries should provide hundreds of







computer terminals to provide ~ to online information, coffee shops and other recreational areas where students can interact socially. 研究性图书馆应当提供几百个电脑终端,以便接通网上信息,还应当配备咖啡厅和其他便于学生进行社交的休闲场所。

■ Over the past seven years, 800 million people have gained ~ to safe drinking water. 过去7年当中,8亿人喝上了安全的饮用水。

The Italian government amends its controversial decision to move the vast majority of flights from Milan's Linate airport, to the less ~ Malpensa. 意大利政府修改了那个引起争议的决定,即把绝大多数航班从米兰的里内特机场搬到交通不太便利的马尔潘萨机场。

accident n. 意外,意外因素

It's no ~ that the best new building in Times Square is the smallest one, a ten-story building on the north side of Forty-second Street between Seventh and Eighth Avenues. 时代广场上最好的新建筑就是最小的那一幢,也就是位于第七、第八大街之间第四十二大道北段的那幢10层楼的建筑,这决非偶然。

Though the living Trilling was valued and ~ed, the dead Trilling has been made into a puppet, violated by at least two memoirists: his wife and his son. 尽管特里林生前得到很高的评价,并且十分受人欢迎,死后却成了傀儡,至少是受到他妻子和儿子这两个为他写回忆录的人的污蔑。

My companion was a vegetarian and so, as is often the case, she had a rather limited choice on the menu but an accommodating attitude from the waiters. 我的同伴是位素食者,因此常常会发生这种情况,菜单上可供她选择的菜相当有限,但侍者们都对她非常客气。

■ With the coming of the industrial revolution, engineers and navigators needed ~ numerical tables. 随着工业革命的到来,工程师和航海家都需要准确无误的数据表。

- She ~d him of stealing from her. 她指控他偷了 她的东西。
- He was also ~d of bribery in connection with two other scandals exposed in 1992 and 1997, charges he continues to deny. 在 1992 年和 1997 年 被曝光的另外两桩丑闻中,他亦被指控受贿, 但他一直予以否定。

She was ~ to seeing Laura and her mother, Penny, leave for work together. 她看惯了劳拉 和她母亲彭妮一起离家去上班。

acknowledge * vt. 对人打招呼

■ They didn't speak, didn't ~ their wives, their heartbroken kids. 他们一句话也没说,没与他们的妻子和伤心欲绝的孩子打招呼。

acquaint [▲] vt. (with)使认识,使了解,使熟悉


- He replied that he could be very useful to the government but was not well ~ed with United States laws and preferred to consult with his attorney before making a decision. 他回答说,他将会对政府大有用处,但因为对美国法律不太熟悉,所以在作决定之前要先征求一下律师的意见。

- Man was created with a delicate nervous system and has never lost his ~ sensitiveness to pain. 人类敏锐的神经系统是与生俱来的,对疼痛的感觉非常敏锐。
- Since the world was alerted to the famine that killed nearly one million people in the 1984 至 1985, periodic droughts have caused ~ food shortages in that country. 自从 1984 至 1985 年 该国那场饿死了将近 100 万人的饥馑为世人 所知以来,不断发生的旱灾在那儿造成了严重的食物匮乏。

Tests show that Wavezorb, ~ed from military
