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# 前言


### 亲爱的读者:

Over the years, most of men have successfully resisted all attempts to make them change their style of dress. The same cannot be said for women. Each year a few so-called "top designers" in Paris or London lay down the law and women over the whole world rush to obey. The rules of the designers are unpredictable. This year, they decide in their fashion, skirts will be short and waists will be high; zips are in and buttons are out. Next year the law is changed and strangely enough, no one is even mildly surprised.

If women are mercilessly exploited year after year, they have only themselves to blame. Because they hate being seen in clothes that are out of fashion, they are cheated by the designers and the big stores every year. Clothes which have been worn only a few times have to be thrown away because of the fashion. When you come to think of it, only a woman is capable of standing in front of a wardrobe full of clothes and complaining sadly that she has nothing to wear.

Changing fashions are nothing more than the purposeful creation of waste. No one can say that the fashion industry contributes anything really important to society. When comparing men and women in the matter of fashion, the conclusions to be drawn are obvious. The constantly changing fashions of women's clothes reflect basic qualities of fickleness and instability while men are too sensible to let themselves be bullied by fashion designers.
