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前 言

本书是以国家教育部《高等学校英语专业基础阶段英语教学大纲》为依据,通过对十多年来专业四级真题的分析、归纳和总结,并结合我们十几年来从事英语专业基础阶段的教学经验编写而成。本书主要内容及特点如下:

听力部分:选用较新的材料,以理解性、概括性及有关文化背景的问题为主,检验学生的听力能力。

作文部分:每套题都附有范文供参考。

综合填空:这是检查综合能力的一个项目,众多学生将之视为难点,无计可施,无从下手。我们在本书的解析中,将此项作为重点,从语境、句法、词义辨析及词的搭配入手,引导学生拨开迷雾,看清解决问题的途径。

语法词汇:语法部分较全面地覆盖了大纲所要求的知识点,且在解析中我们进行了深入细致的分析总结,点面结合,以帮助学生弥补不足,纠正错误,完善知识结构。词汇部分检查验收基础阶段应掌握的词汇,从词的搭配、辨析入手,汇集了大量较常用的词和短语。

阅读理解:这部分选材广泛,贴近真题。我们想通过具体操作使学生明白阅读的主旨是掌握信息,看懂一篇文章不一定识辨所有的生词。因此在解析中,我们尽可能把语言注释点减少到最低限度,而把重点放在篇章段落上,把解题的切入点放在主题句、线索词上,以此引导学生提高逻辑思维能

力,快速准确地抓住信息。

总之,我们认为考试是知识和方法的统一。真诚地希望此书能帮助你专业四级考试有一个全面的了解,对自己做一个全面的检测,并通过我们的解析,收到举一反三、触类旁通之功效。
