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前 言

高考中采用标准化命题,优点颇多。它容纳的题量大,知识覆盖面广,既便于考察学生的基础知识和基本技能,又便于使用电子计算机阅卷计分。这种命题方法在国外已十分流行,近几年国内高考试卷中标准化试题的分量也在逐年加重。为适应这种情况,我们按照教育部新颁发的"中学 英语教学大纲"的基本要求,以全国现行的统编教材为主要内容,用标准化命题方式编写了此书。本书选题广泛、题型新颖、针对性强,书后附有答案,十分适合高考复习使用。
