PREFACE

为迎接 21 世纪的挑战,进一步提高大学英语教学水平,国家教育部组织有关专家对《大学英语教学大纲》进行了认真修订。新大纲对大学英语教学提出了更高的要求,不但要求培养学生的阅读能力,而且要求培养学生的听、说、写、译能力,使他们能以英语为工具交流信息,实现从“获取专业所需要的信息”到“交流信息”的飞跃。

为切实贯彻新大纲精神,我们组织有丰富教学经验的大学英语教师编写了这套“大学英语综合能力提高系列”丛书。该系列丛书包括《英语语法与词汇》、《英语阅读》、《英语写作》、《英语听力》(配磁带)四本书。其中,《英语听力》一书的突出特点是紧扣大纲,实用性强。全书分学生用书和教师用书两大部分,每部分皆 20 个

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单元, 包含了迄今为止国家教育部考试中心所公布的, 在四、六级统考中可能采用的各种听力题型, 并根据四、六级统考听力测试部分的形式、内容、语速、间隔进行了周密的设计和科学的编排, 使读者能在最短的时间内显著地提高英语听力水平。

该系列丛书适用于大学英语四、六级考试, 也适用于研究生入学和同类程度的英语考试, 亦可用作自学教材。相信广大读者定会从中得到有效的帮助。

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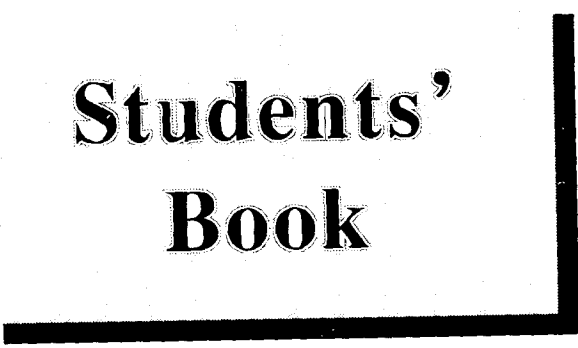
