madame ['mædəm] *n.* a polite form of address to a woman 女士; 夫人; 小姐
(用于姓名前称呼非英语民族, 特别是法国的已婚妇女及有职业的妇女)

disappoint [ˌdɪsə'pɔɪnt] *vt.* fail to satisfy one's desire, wish, etc. 使失望, 使扫兴

Please don't disappoint us again. 请勿再使我们失望了。

What you had done disappointed everyone present.

你的所作所为令在场的每一个人失望极了。

disappointing [ˌdɪsə'pɔɪntɪŋ] *adj.* making (sb.) in a state of disappointment
令人失望的, 令人扫兴的

What disappointing news! 多么令人失望的消息!

Your work is disappointing. 你的工作令人失望。

Our holiday was so disappointing. 我们的假日(过得)令人扫兴。

willing ['wɪlɪŋ] *adj.* ready to do sth. 乐意的; 愿意的; 情愿的

Are you willing to help? 你乐意帮忙吗?

He is willing to wait. 他愿意等。

Nothing is impossible to a willing mind/heart.

世上无难事, 只怕有心人。/有志者, 事竟成。(谚)

devote [dɪ'vəʊt] *vt.* give a lot of time, money, etc. to something 把...奉献;

把…专用（常与介词 to 连用）

Please devote more time to your work. 请把更多的时间用于工作。

For four years he devoted himself to the law.

他花了四年时间潜心研究法律。

She is devoted to her children. 她全心照应于女。

He devoted his life to art. 他献身于艺术。

radium ['reɪdʒəm] *n.* (不可数) 镭

overcoat ['əʊvəkəʊt] *n.* long coat worn over other clothes in cold weather (可数) 外衣, 大衣

When the weather is cold I put on an overcoat before going out of doors.

天气冷的时候, 出门前我都穿上大衣。

How much is the overcoat? 这件大衣多少钱?

succeed [sək'si:d] *vi.* gain a purpose; achieve 成功

Whether he'll succeed or not depends on many factors.

他能否获得成功取决于多方面的因素。

His father succeeded as a doctor. 他父亲作为医生颇有成就。

The experiment has succeeded at last. 试验终于成功了。

I did not succeed in my first lecture. 我第一次讲课不成功。

▷ 接替, 继承, 紧接 (*vt.*)

Elizabeth succeeded Mary. 伊丽莎白接着玛丽当了女王。

Probably Mr Wang will succeed him as manager.

可能王先生要接替他当经理。

The storm was succeeded by calm. 暴风雨之后是一片沉静。

graduation [ˌɡrædʒuː'eɪʃən] *n.* the act of graduating 毕业

After graduation from college, he entered the government service.

大学毕业以后, 他进入了政府部门工作。

Have you finished your graduation paper? 你的毕业论文完成了吗?

▷ graduate *vi.* 毕业

He graduated first in his class. 他以全班第一名的成绩毕业。

It is two years since he graduated. 他毕业两年了。

She graduated from Cambridge with an B. A. degree.

她毕业于剑桥大学，获得文学学士学位。

industrial [in'da:striəl] *adj.* of industries 工业的

Japan is an industrial country. 日本是一个工业(发达的)国家。

Shenyang is one of the important industrial bases in our country.

沈阳是我国的一个重要的工业基地。

In the industrial accident he had a hand cut off.

在那次工伤事故中，他失去了一只手。

▷ **industry** ① (不可数)工业(总称); (可数)产业; 行业

Industry is developing very fast in our country. 我国工业发展很快。

That country has few industries. 那个国家没有什么工业。

The city is going all out to develop travel industry.

这个城市正在全力以赴发展旅游业。

② 勤奋，勤劳

A country's greatest wealth is the industry of its people.

一个国家的最大财富莫过于人民的勤劳。

He is a man of great industry. 他是一个非常勤奋的人。

One should win success by honest industry.

一个人要靠诚实勤劳赢得成功。

uranium [juə'reinjəm] *n.* a radioactive white metallic element 铀 (一种白色的放射性金属元素)

ray [rei] *n.* line; beam of radiant (可数)光线，射线

You are a ray of light to me in a very dark world.

你是黑暗世界中我的一线光明。

I took some X-rays of her. 我给她拍了几张 X 光片。

You should work 100% hard as long as there is a ray of hope.

只要有一线希望，你都要付出百分之百的努力。

The morning sun was slowly rising in the east, pouring down soft rays.

一轮红日在东方冉冉升起，洒下柔和的光线。

radioactive [ˌreɪdiəʊ'æktɪv] *adj.* 放射性的

radioactive pollution 放射性污染

radioactive dust 放射性尘埃

radioactive ray 射线

radioactive heat 放射性线变热

mineral ['minərəl] *n.* substance got from the earth by mining (可数) 矿物, 矿石; 无机物

China is rich in minerals. 中国矿藏丰富。

This sort of mineral water is of high quality and does good to your health. 这种矿泉水质量好, 有益健康。

Africa is a continent exceptionally wealthy in minerals.

非洲是一个矿藏特别丰富的大陆。

polonium [pə'ləuniəm] *n.* 钋

motherland ['mʌðərlənd] *n.* 祖国

构成: mother (母亲) + land (土地)

Hundreds of thousands of martyrs (烈士) died heroically for the liberation of our motherland. 成千上万的先烈为祖国的解放而英勇牺牲。

Our motherland is becoming more and more powerful day by day.

我们的祖国日益强大。

endless ['endlis] *adj.* having no end; never stopping 无止境的; 没完没了的
构成: end (结束) + less (否定后缀)

His mother is a woman with endless patience.

他的母亲是一个非常耐心的女性。

Reading gives me endless pleasure. 阅读给了我极大的乐趣。

He seemed to have endless questions to ask. 他好像总是有问不完的问题。

The line of waiting people seemed to be endless.

等候的长队似乎看不到尽头。

bench [bentʃ] *n.* a long seat (可数) 长凳; 工作台

The park bench is fixed to the ground. 公园长凳是固定在地上的。

The old man sat on the park bench and fed the pigeons.

那个老人坐在公园长凳上喂鸽子。

The bench was covered with tools. 工作台上摆满了工具。

▷ 坐冷板凳; 当替补运动员

Most of the season he sat on the bench. 本赛季大部分时间他是坐冷板凳。

The coach had to keep him on the bench because he had hurt his knees.

教练只好让他暂停参加比赛, 因为他膝盖受了伤。

lead [led] *n.* soft, heavy, easily melted metal 铅

Her father died of lead poisoning. 她父亲死于铅中毒。

His box is made of lead. 这个盒子是用铅制作的。

▷ 铅笔芯

He is sharpening his pencil because the lead is broken.

他正在削铅笔，因为铅笔芯断了。

false [fɔ:ls] *adj.* wrong; incorrect; not real; lying 错的；不正确的；假的；虚伪的

Your view is false. 你的观点是不正确的。

Most false teeth really look natural. 大多数假牙看起来确实像是天生的。

I don't want to give you a false impression. 我不想给你留下错觉。

He turned out to be a false friend. 结果发现他是个虚伪的朋友。

She is false of heart. 她居心不良。

cure [kjʊə] *vt.* bring (a person) back to health 治愈；治疗（常与介词 of 连用）

This medicine cured me of my cold. 这药治好了我的感冒。

The doctor's job is to cure people who are ill.

医生的职责就是给病人治病。

Everyone hopes that she will be completely cured as soon as possible.

大家都希望她尽快痊愈。

Parents should try to cure their children of bad habits.

父母应努力纠正孩子们的不良习惯。

■ *n.* curing, or being cured 治愈，痊愈

There is still no good cure for the common cold. 感冒仍无良药可治。

This medicine should bring about a cure. 这药应该是药到病除的。

Running provides a cure for the disease. 跑步能治好这种病。

He went for a cure at a famous hospital. 他到一家著名的医院接受治疗。

Her cure took six weeks. 治好她的病花了六个星期。

disadvantage [ˌdɪsəd'vɑ:ntɪdʒ] *n.* unfavourable condition (可数) 不利，不利条件；弱点

构成：dis(否定前缀)+advantage(有利，有利条件；优点)

China developed its own nuclear weapons under great disadvantages.

中国在非常不利的情况下发展了自己的核武器。

His bad health is a great disadvantage to him.

他身体不好，这对他很不利。

It is a disadvantage not to be able to drive a car. 不会开车是一个弱点。

He never cares about advantages and disadvantages when doing a job.

他干工作时从不计较利害得失。

effect [i'fekt] *n.* action or influence on sth. (可数)作用, 影响 / the power or ability to bring about results (可数)效果

This had a great effect upon the future of both mother and son.

这件事对母子二人的前途有很大的影响。

Unfortunately, their efforts had no effect.

不幸的是, 他们的努力毫无作用。

The boy fell sick from the effect of weather.

那男孩因天气不好而生了病。

The effects of noise on human behavior were a major topic of the meeting.

噪音对人类行为的影响是会议的一个重要议题。

The new traffic regulations will come into effect on January 1.

新的交通规则自1月1日起生效。

shock [ʃɒk] *vt.* cause unpleasant or angry surprise 使震惊

It shocked me to see how my neighbours treated their children.

看到邻居们对待孩子的行为, 我震惊不已。

The child's bad language shocked everyone present.

这孩子的粗话震惊了在场的每一个人。

I was shocked by his sudden death. 他的突然去世对我震动很大。

▷ *n.* (可数/不可数)震惊; 给人打击(震惊)的事; 震动

The bad news left us all speechless from shock. 这个噩耗把我们惊呆了。

He felt shock rather than anger. 他的感觉是震惊而不是生气。

The whole thing came as a shock to me. 整件事对我打击很大。

The shock of the earthquake was felt for miles.

地震的震动数英里之外都感觉得到。

post [pəʊst] ■ *n.* job; position (可数) 工作; 职位; 岗位

No one may leave his post without permission.

未经允许, 任何人都不得擅自离职守。

We might get you a post as a waitress.

我们可以给你找一件当服务员的工作。

Everyone should stick to his post during office hours.

上班期间, 人人都必须坚守岗位。

■ *vt.* send by mail 投寄; 邮寄

Do you mind posting a letter for me? 帮我寄封信好吗?

I'll post off all my Christmas cards this week.

本周我得把所有的圣诞贺卡寄出去。

■ *n.* mail 邮寄

I'll send the book to you by post. 我会把书邮寄给你。

If you buy this book, it will be sent to you post-free.

如果你买这本书, 可以免费给你寄来。

gram [græm] *n.* (a measure of weight) 1/1000 of kilogram (可数) (重量单位) 克(略作 gm.)

institute [ˌɪnstɪtju:t] ■ *n.* an organization for the promotion of art, science, education, etc. (可数) 学会, 研究所, 院

He is chairman of a scientific institute. 他是一科学协会的会长。

She works in a foreign language institute. 她在外语学院工作。

■ ▷ *n.* (可数) 短训班

Susan is studying in a teachers' institute. 苏珊正在教师短训班学习。

admire [əd'maɪə] *vt.* regard or look at with pleasure and respect 钦佩; 欣赏;

羡慕

I admire him for his bravery. 我钦佩他的勇气。

He much admires your poems. 他非常欣赏你的诗歌。

I gave her an admiring look. 我羡慕地看了她一眼。

determination [dɪ'tɜ:mɪ'neɪʃən] *n.* firmness of purpose (可数) 决心

He has come to a determination of giving up smoking. 他决心戒烟。

They started with a full determination to win.

他们抱着必胜的决心出发了。

It took courage and determination to say good-bye to drugs.

告别毒品需要勇气和决心。

courage ['kʌrɪdʒ] *n.* bravery; the feeling of not afraid (不可数) 勇气, 胆量

He showed great courage in saving the child from death in the burning building. 他从失火的房屋里救出了孩子, 表现出很大的勇气。

I didn't have the courage to tell you the truth.

我没有勇气把事情的真相告诉你。

The child had unusual courage and caught the thief stealing.

这孩子胆略过人, 当场抓住了正在行窃的小偷。

X-ray ['eks'rei] *n.* a powerful unseen beam of light which can pass through solids and make it possible to see into or through them (可数) X 射线, X 光

He has an X-ray examination every year. 他每年都进行一次 X 光检查。

battlefield ['bætlfi:ld] *n.* a place at which a battle is or has been fought (可数) 战场, 战地

构成: battle(战斗) + field(区域, 场地)

Many people came to the city to visit the ancient battlefield.

很多人到这个城市是来考察古战场的。

As a general, he should have a clear picture of the situations on the battlefield. 作为将军, 他应该对战况了如指掌。

Many martyrs died on the battlefield, some even leaving no name.

很多先烈战死沙场, 有的连姓名都没有留下。

debt [det] *n.* something owed to someone else (可数/不可数) 债务; 欠款

Death pays all debts. 死亡抵消所有债务。(谚)

She is under a heavy debt. 她债台高筑。

It's easier to get into debt than to get out of it again. 欠债容易还债难。

After ten years of hard work they paid off their debts at last.

经过十年的艰辛努力, 他们终于还完了所有欠款(债务)。

Poland [ˈpəʊlənd] n. 波兰(欧洲)

Warsaw [ˈwɔːsɔː] n. 华沙(波兰首都)

devote...to... (prep.) 把...献给..., 把...用在...

He devoted his lifetime to training students. 他毕生都在培养学生。

They are all terribly busy men and cannot be expected to devote their time to this investigation.

他们都是非常忙的人, 不能指望他们用全部时间去进行这一调查。

The newspaper devoted a special column to a discussion of the problem of the world's population. 这家报纸开辟专栏来讨论世界人口问题。

■ devote oneself to 意为“献身于; 致力于”。例如:

He devoted himself entirely to music. 他把全副身心都献给了音乐。

She devoted herself to helping the poor. 她致力于帮助穷人(的事业)。

■ be devoted to 为一被动语态结构, 语意仍为“献身于, 致力于”。例如:

His whole life has been devoted to studying the origin of cancer.

他的一生都献给了对癌症起因的研究。

My lecture will be devoted to the research of teaching.

我的报告专门谈教学研究。

The Welsh are the only people in the world whose only national festival is devoted to music and poetry. 威尔士人是世界上把自己民族惟一的节日用于音乐和诗歌表演的惟一民族。

go over 检查; 复习; 研究

He went over our written material word for word to correct and improve it. 他逐字逐句看我们写的材料, 帮助修改提高。

They went over every step again, but without result.

他们把每一个步骤又检查了一遍, 仍没有结果。

They went over everything and found out where the trouble was.

他们把一切检查了一遍, 找出了问题之所在。
