




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# 前言

各类标准化的英语考试中一般都少不了如听力、阅读理解、词汇、写作等项。既然这几项是必考或常考项，那么其中有无规律可循呢？答案是肯定的。

古人云，审堂下之阴而知日月之行，阴阳之变。对这几项考题进行一番探赜索隐、穷原竟委，大体上可查其端倪。规律反映在前后两个层面上，前一个层面是语言，后一个层面是能力。语言层面主要测试的是对语言知识的掌握，如时态、语态、否定、倒装、虚拟语气、独立主格结构、词语搭配、词汇辨析、惯用句型等。能力层面主要测试的是逻辑思维能力、推理判断能力、抽象概括能力、空间想象能力。前一个层面是后一个层面的体现，后一个层面是起主导作用的人的智商素质。我们找到了这个规律，找出了前后两个层面的相互关系，就有了进一步研究这些考题的理论基础。所谓点拨、做题指导就是在这一理论基础上提出来的。

语言知识和逻辑思维的结合是取得最佳成绩的基础和保障，如本书提出的“借题发挥”就是二者结合的做题技巧之一。

## I. 怎样做听力题

### 1. 熟悉题型

听力理解题有 3 种题型：对话、短文、填空（到目前还未采用过）。

对话的形式为：一男一女各说一句话，然后提出一个问题。听完问题后，考生要从 4 个选项中挑出问题的答案。

短文的形式为：短文只读一遍，然后读听力理解题。听完每道题后，考生要从 4 个选项中挑出答案。

填空：一篇短文中有 5 处空白，要求考生边听边填写。短文读三遍，第一遍全读，考生要集中注意力听懂；第二遍在每一个空白处留出时间（15 - 20 秒）让考生填写；第三遍再通读一遍，以便考生检查。（详见样题二听力部分的 Section C）。

### 2. 预读

预读指提前阅读卷面上的 A、B、C、D 选项。

预读有两次机会，一是利用考试指令的播放时间预读，二是利用每道题播放前的些微时间预读。

### 3. 预知

通过预读可以猜测到与 A、B、C、D 选项相关的试题内容，这就是预知。如果预知准确，那么就相当于看到了该题的准确答案，从而大大提高了选中率。懂得预知手段并认真做的考生通常都有收获，能猜到 2、3 道题。悟性较高的能猜到 3、4 道题。悟性较高又感知到某些试题设计规律的考生能猜到 4、5 道题。

任何事物都有规律性，听力试题设计也不例外。我们用概率论的模式对历年考题进行

了分析、综合和归纳，找出了对话和短文试题设计的一般规律性（详见以下4、5、6）。希望这些规律性能帮助考生提高自己的选中率。

#### 4. 对话

从统计资料中可以看出，听力理解包括三种题型，对话是每次必考的题型，短文是常考的题型，填空至今尚未采用。

对话内容涉及到许多方面。参加过考试的考生中，较聪明而又善一叶知秋者，都能概括出一二点对话内容的规律。我们汲取了某些考生的感悟，系统、理智地把每道题分类，经过条分缕析，总结、概括为17个方面。这样，听完对话的一刹那，甚至在听对话的同时，就可以预知到会提什么样的问题，待到听完提问，就可以径直去选自己认定的选项。这样做的选中率通常会很高。17个方面中，问及较多的是问原因、问中心意思、问言外之意、问涉及的内容、问做事情和状况、问看法。

提问的句型有一定的规律性，不同的对话内容会使用不同的提问句型。提前熟悉这些句型，不仅可以消除临场的生疏感和紧张情绪，而且可以把提问句作为对话内容和选项之间的过渡桥梁，把判断的思路正确、迅速地引向要选的目标。

如果你了解了对话内容的分类，熟悉了提问的句型，那么在考场上面对试卷上的A、B、C、D选项时，不仅不会茫然不知所措，而且可以做到一定程度上的预知，从而沉着、冷静地注意听内容的细节。

##### 1) 问时间

从A、B、C、D四个选项可以预知这道题要问及事情、事件发生的时间。因此，要注意两点：一是要注意听讲话人提到的时间细节，二是要做好准备作一些简单的计算。

常用提问句型：

What time ...?

How long ...?

When ...?

**W:** Your cousin graduated in 1986. What about you?

**M:** I finished school a year later.

**Q:** When did the man graduate?

**M:** I'd like to make two reservations on Flight 651 for June 8th.

**W:** I'm sorry, we're booked up on the 8th. But we still have a few seats available on the 9th.

## 2) 问地点

常用提问句型:

Where will ...?

W: Would you mind sending me champagne and strawberries to my room at 1 a.m. please?

M: I'll try ma'am, but on Wednesday the kitchen staff leave at midnight.

Q: Where does the conversation probably take place?

A. In a bar.

B. In a restaurant.

C. In a grocer.

D. In a hotel.

示例 2:

M: Mary is in charge of the art and music section; and Charles, the sports page.

What about you?

W: I'm responsible for the editorials.

Q: Where does the woman work?

A. At a bookstore.

示例 3:

W: I have a complaint to make, sir. I waited 10 minutes at the table before the waiter showed up. When I finally got served, I found it was not what I ordered.

Q: Where does the conversation most probably take place?

A. At the information desk.

### 3) 问数字

从 A、B、C、D 四个选项可以预知这道题要问及数字。因此，要注意两点：一是要注意听讲人提到的数字细节，二是要做好准备作一些简单的计算。

常用提问句型：

How many ...?

How much ...?

What's the price ...?

示例 1:

W: Why didn't your aunt fly?

M: It would have cost \$ 44.00. The bus fare is only \$ 14.00.

Q: How much did the man's aunt save?

A. \$ 44.00.            B. \$ 14.00.            C. \$ 40.00.            D. \$ 30.00.

示例 2:

W: Here's a ten-dollar bill. Give me two tickets for tonight's show, please.

M: Sure. Two tickets and here's a dollar forty cents change.

Q: How much does one ticket cost?

### 4) 问原因

讲话人谈论某事后，可能会问及事情发生的原因。因此，在听到下面常用提问句型后，要迅速反思讲话人提到的事情发生的原因细节。

常用提问句型：

Why is ...?

Why doesn't ...?

What's the reason ...?

What probably caused ...?

示例 1:

M: I was thinking of staying in tonight to surf the Internet. Do you want to join me?

W: Not really. I work on the computer all day at work. I need a break from computer's screens. What I'd like to do is go out for dinner. There is a new Vietnamese place over on Park Street.

Q: Why doesn't the woman want to surf the Internet tonight?

- A. Her computer is broken.
- B. She wants to go to a restaurant.
- C. She wants to go to the park.
- D. She wants to take a walk.

示例 2:

**W:** Friday's speaker is supposed to be wonderful. Are you going to attend the seminar on that day?

**M:** Yes. But I haven't been able to get the ticket yet. Since the lecture is open to the public, I imagine that the tickets may have already been sold out.

### 8) 问中心意思

对话题型的设计方式之一是让考生在 A、B、C、D 四个选项中找出概括谈话中心思想的词语。因此, 在听讲话人对话时, 注意听谈话的中心思想是什么, 提问句是否在问及中心思想。

常用提问句型:

What do we learn from the conversation?

What can we conclude from the conversation?

示例 1:

**M:** Mrs. Winter, I need your advice. I want to buy a dress for my wife. Can you tell me where I can get one at a reasonable price?

**W:** Sure. Go to Richard's. It has the latest styles and gives a 30% discount to husbands who shop alone.

**Q: What do we know about the Richard's store?**

- A. It gives a 30% discount to all customers.
- B. It is run by Mr. Winter's husband.
- C. It hires Mr. Winter as an adviser.
- D. It encourages husbands to shop on their own.

示例 2:

**M:** Though we didn't win the game, we were satisfied with our performance.
