# 英语 8000 词 -同义词和反义词练习

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#### 内容简介

本书运用对比和联想的方式及构词法,以同义词和反义词练习的形式,通过 4000 多常用词来引进次常用词,以达到掌握 8000 词的日的。整个练习分成动词、名词、形容词和副词三个单元,共 359 个练习,每个练习 12 句。在每个练习后,还对不能用构词法推测词义的生词作了扼要的注释。本书练习中心突出,形式统一,做起来容易,是扩大词汇量既经济、有效,又有系统的可靠方法。书后附有答案和字源表。

本书可供出国考试人员、研究生、大学高年级学生以及有志于提高 英语水平的读者使用,亦可作为研究生教材使用。

# 英语 8000 词

#### ——同义词和反义词练习

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# 前言

经常有一些参加过托福考试、英语水平考试和研究生入学考试的同学向我们反映,他们所以未能取得理想的成绩,主要是因为词汇量不够。一般大学毕业生只掌握 4000~5000 词,而托福考试需要 8000词,其他类似的考试也需要大量的词汇。为此,我们从 1986 年开始,先后经过五年的探索和实验,才找到目前这种被同学称作"滚雷球"的方法。此书就是我们反复研究和多次实验的结果。

本书以练习的形式,通过常用词来引进其同义词和反义词,即引进在常用率表上处于 4000~8000 的次常用词。全书共 359 个练习,每个练习 12 句,共约 4300 句。练习中将引进的 4300 个重点词(例句中的划线部分)分成动词、名词、形容词和副词三个单元。重点词的确定是根据托福考试常用词 8000 和桑代克(E. L. Thorndike)的统计而定的。例句的搭配选自托福考题、研究生入学考题和美国当代书刊。练习编写的原则是中心突出,形式统一,做起来容易。

练习中的每一个重点词都只有一组给定的同义词、反义词与之对应,而所给的同义词尽量选用读者较为熟悉的常用词,这样就可通过一个常用词来引进两个次常用词。为了减少遗忘,我们有计划地让重点词在不同的练习中重复出现一次,原来作为反义词出现的词,后来又作为重点词出现。如 descend 在下述两句中就是这样。

1. The balloon ascended quickly.

syn. rose

ant. descended

2. The elevator descended slowly to the ground floor.

syn. dropped

ant. ascended

这就使得 descend 和 ascend 都有了重现的机会。此外,在 4300 个句子中,如果用同义词去替换重点词,又可得出另外 4300 个句子;而且

有些没有限制词的句子,还可用反义词去代替重点词,变成与原句含义相反的句子。

为了巩固成果,练习做完之后,还要定期复习。如果每天做4个练习,3个月就可以做完。做一个练习约需4~6分钟。做练习时,一定要按照要求把具体的词填写出来,然后按照答案进行核对,如有错误,用红笔加以改正。这时要趁热打铁,把更正过的词语,要特别加以记忆。做完这些,每天约需40分钟。在所有练习做完之后,再拿出1个月时间,从头到尾复习一遍。这样初步掌握4000重点词又复习了其他常用词,总共用时4个月,这就是我们称作的"4·4"计划。

本书的部分内容曾在中国科技大学研究生院用作研究生的教材。同学们反映效果很好,认为通过同义词和反义词来扩大词汇量真是"一箭三雕",既可复习旧词还可引进两个新词——同义词和反义词,是扩大词汇量既经济、有效,又有系统的可靠方法。

为节省读者查字典的时间,我们对书中出现的凡不能用构词法 推测词义的生词,还作了扼要的注释。希望读者在阅读本书后转答您 的宝贵意见,以便将来修正。

## 做题指导

在练习中每一个句子都有一个画线的重点词。读者要做的就是 找到这个画线词的同义词和反义词。

在每个练习的前面,有12组备选词(words to be chosen)。对于每个练习的每一句中的重点词,都可以分别从备选词中找到唯一的一对正确的同义词和反义词。为了简化形式,在所有备选词的排列上,都是同义词在前,反义词在后,而且同义词都是尽量采用读者所熟悉的常用词。

如练习1中的第1句为:

In the old society, the scientist often abandoned his research for lack of funds.

做题时常会出现以下两种情况:

1. 读者认识划线词 abandoned。则按照 abandoned 的词义"放弃",在备选词中找出 desert, maintain 这组词, 然后以适当的形式把选定的词填在指定位置。结果如下:

#### syn. deserted

#### ant. maintained

2. 读者不认识划线词 abandoned。这时可利用上下文去推测 abandoned的含义,根据全句内容推测出 abandoned 可能有两种含义:①中断,②放弃。然后根据这两种可能含义在备选词中去挑选,结果选出了 desert,maintain。 desert 并不生疏,是"放弃"的意思,进而可推知 abandoned 的含义是"放弃"。而后在时态上作相应的变化,把 deserted 和 maintained 填在指定的位置。

对于第三单元的形容词和副词,因为没有时态、语态、人称和数的变化,因此在练习中省略了填词部分,读者只需将所选一组词前面的英文字母填在相应句子前面的括号内即可。

如练习128中的第7句为:

Murder is the most abominable crime.

读者如果不认识 abominable,可从上下文推测出 abominable 可能有两种含义:①可恨的,②惨忍的。然后根型这两种可能含义在标有 A~L 的 12 组备选词中去挑选,结果选出了与①"可恨的"含义相当的 A 组词 hateful,desirable,而找不到与②"惨忍的"相应的词。由此可确定 abominable 的含义是"可恨的"。最后,将字母 A 填到句子前面的括号内。结果如下:
