



# 序

我国货币历史悠久，种类丰富，绚丽多彩。人民币在我国货币文化历史中占有重要地位。

1948年12月1日中国人民银行成立，同时发行人民币，统一了革命战争时期各革命根据地货币，为支持解放战争在全国的胜利，为中华人民共和国成立后稳定物价、恢复国民经济发挥了重要作用。全国统一发行人民币，结束了国民党政府几十年通货膨胀和我国近百年外币、金银在市场流通、买卖的历史。人民币成为我国历史上少有的集中统一、独立稳定的货币。40年来，人民币在促进社会主义经济建设中起了重要作用，今后必将在经济体制改革和建设有中国特色的社会主义的伟大事业中发挥越来越大的作用。

为了纪念中国人民银行成立和发行人民币40周年，中国人民银行货币发行司的同志收集、整理了中国人民银行成立以来发行的各版人民币，共110种。按第一套人民币、第二套人民币、第三套人民币、流通纪念人民币和第四套人民币发行先后顺序，编辑成册。所有图片按原件尺寸、色彩制印。这是我行第一本较完整的人民币图书资料，为货币收藏家、爱好者提供了可贵的资料和欣赏机会。希望读者能喜欢这本图册。

# Preface

China is known to have a long history of currency, which is bright, colorful and with rich varieties. Renminbi has been very important in the cultural history of the Chinese currencies ever since its issuance.

The People's Bank of China (PBC) was established on December 1, 1948 and began to issue Renminbi as the legal tender at the same time, thus unified the different currencies circulating in each of the revolutionary base areas during the revolutionary war. The issuance of Renminbi played a very important role in the nationwide victory of the revolutionary war, in stabilizing prices after the founding of the People's Republic of China and in recovering the national economy. The issuance of Renminbi as the only legal tender ended the days of inflation, which had been prevailing under the Kuomintang regime and ceased the dealings of foreign currencies, the circulation of gold and silver in the markets, that had lasted for nearly one hundred years in China. Renminbi thus became one of the few centrally unified and stable currencies in the Chinese history. In the past 40 years, Renminbi has played an active part in facilitating socialist economic construction and hence will play an even greater role in the restructuring of the Chinese economic system and the glorious cause of building China into a socialist country with Chinese characters.

To commemorate the 40th anniversary of the founding of the People's

Bank of China and the issuance of Renminbi, staff members of the Currency Issuance Department of the People's Bank of China have collected and collated the 110 sets of Renminbi issued by the People's Bank of China since her establishment and have them compiled into this album of Renminbi according to their time of issuance: the 1st set of Renminbi, the 2nd set of Renminbi, the 3rd set of Renminbi together with sets of circulative commemorative Renminbi and the 4th set of Renminbi. All photos of currencies contained in this album of Renminbi are the same in sizes and colors with the originals. This is the 1st comprehensive album of Renminbi of Renminbi ever published by the People's Bank of China, which gives valuable reference materials and enjoyment to the currency collectors. I sincerely hope, this album of Renminbi is to the liking of the readers.
