序 言 PREFACE

人们经常把报纸的版面比之于商品的包装，我一直不甚赞同这种比法，而宁愿把它比作人的容貌和形体。因为商品的包装可能与商品的内在质量不相符，而人的容貌和形体必然是它整体素质的综合反映，包括健康状况、性格品德、文化修养等方面。报纸的版面就是这样，版面的优劣不仅仅是一个“门面”问题，而且反映着一张报纸的导向作用、宣传水平、文化内涵、审美思想等等。版面有没有魅力，直接影响到一张报纸在读者心目中的地位。

正因为如此，我特别看重报纸的版面，甚至可以说，版面如何在某种程度上左右着我订报时的选择。在林林总总的报纸中，我对《深圳商报》的版面一向很有好感，尽管它是一张很年轻的报纸。它的版面端庄而不刻板，亮丽而不花哨，醒目而不扎眼，活泼而不轻佻，而且各版面貌各有特色，但很讲究协调。用圈子内的话说，“度”把握得恰到好处。后来才知道，这家报纸已走进了全国报纸版面的先进行列，我很为自己没有错爱而高兴。同时我也猜想，这里肯定有一批优秀的“设计师”在为这张报纸呕心沥血。直到最近，偶然看到《报纸版面设计与创新》的书稿，我的疑问才得到回答。

这本书的作者是《深圳商报》的陈伟和她的夫人张艳蕾。陈伟是新闻摄影中心的主任，张艳蕾是美术部主任。他俩志同道合，几年来为报纸版面的革新和图片的运用，倾尽心血，不断探索，和其他同志一起，为《深圳商报》版面的改进作出了突出的贡献。这本书，既是他们多年工作实践的总结，也为我国报纸编辑学增添了一份财富。说实在的，这样的“财富”目前不是多了，而是太少，以致我读着它的时候，真有点“空谷足音”之感。这里，我不仅要祝贺他俩在共同事业上的成功，还要庆贺《深圳商报》领导的识才和得人。

我过去经常呼吁，报纸要有版面设计家。“家”不同于

“匠”，他既要懂政治，又要懂哲学、懂艺术。这就是说，在一个版面上，不仅要从政治上懂得该突出什么，不突出什么，而且要在哲学上懂得辩证地处理如何突出和如何不突出的关系。而这种关系鲜明而又巧妙地体现出来，则要靠艺术。人们通常把版面设计称为“画版样”，以为只要明白稿件的孰重孰轻，再加上一点“美化”，就已尽其能事。这只是对“匠”的要求。版面的最高境界，则应是政治、哲学、艺术的完美统一。三者具备，方为大家。

从陈伟和张艳蕾的经历中，我发现他们俩都受过高等美术教育，并有较高的艺术造诣。我想这对他们从事目前的工作有着极为重要的关系。也许我孤陋寡闻，从事报纸版面设计的队伍中，具备这样高的艺术素质和学养的人员可以说是凤毛麟角。他们能够从自己的工作实践总结，如此具有真知灼见的经验和理论观点，说明报纸的改革迫切需要版面设计的高级人才。今天，报纸的激烈竞争，报纸与其他传媒间的抗衡，以及读者不断提高的阅读水平和审美要求，使得报纸工作者不仅在办报理念上和改进报道内容与方法上，而且在版面样式风格、发布手段上，都有了许多新的改进和突破。尤其作为报道载体的版面设计与创新，更是报纸编者与读者共同关心的问题。因此，《报纸版面设计与创新》一书的出版，肯定会为我们提供值得借鉴的新思路、新信息、新经验。

后记

报纸版面设计的重要作用

报纸版面的设计与风格形成，是由多方面因素促成。但有两点十分关键，一是报纸发展业的时代需要；二是办报人对报纸版面设计的重视程度和驾驭能力。如何使报纸版面能跟上时代的发展和竞争的要求，使我们的编辑、记者能够自觉地，而不是被动地，有目的地，而不是盲目地经营设计好报纸版面？看来，了解和认识报纸版面设计的重要作用是十分必要的。

在我国，从十九世纪初，由英国传教士创办的《察世俗每月统计传》中国近代第一张中文报纸，发展到即将迈入21世纪的今天，报纸版面的设计、编排经历了一个从简单的文字发布，到报纸的功能不断扩大，而媒体之间的竞争又日趋激烈的近200年的演进过程。其中每个时期尤以版面设计的改革和演变为标志和突破口。从辛亥革命开始，报刊借用了摄影术，运用新闻照片传播新闻事件，报刊也由此改头换面，采用设计新手段。随着时代的变迁，今天的报纸版面设计更具有审美功能，展示功能和引导功能，版面风格也进入了一个前所未有的繁荣时期。版面设计的重要作用已经被越来越多的报纸工作者所承认，并不断地加以改进和创新。

我们强调新闻报道要讲艺术性，不仅指文章报道的角度、写法及选题要避免呆板、说教，同时也包括了新闻报道的载体报纸版面，也要特别讲求艺术效果。报纸要减少所谓“宣传味”使读者容易接受，愿意接受并从中感到美。报纸版面设计在这种任务面前就扮演着一个十分重要的角色。这就要求版面编辑必须懂得版面设计的规律、技巧，极其慎重地对待版面设计，既不能漫不经心，更不能随心所欲。从哲学的角度上讲，内容可以决定形式；而反过来，形式在许多时候对内容也会起到积极的促进作用。因此，报纸版面形式的改革，可以推动报纸各方面的革新，版面形式的不断推陈出新，已经

事实也是如此，读者感知报纸“第一印象”的好坏，在很大程度上决定着读者对报纸的取舍。在美观已成为人们选择物品的一种普遍尺度的时代，报纸欲引导读者注意，首先应该是具有较高美学原则支撑的版面设计。举一个报纸发展的简单例子。法国《巴黎晚报》1930年的发行量仅有6万份。后来为了与当地报纸竞争，创立了一种新颖的版面设计，即采用大字标题，大量地刊登照片，给读者耳目一新的感觉。1934年，这家报纸发行量猛增到100万份。1937年，这家报纸瞄准当时的另一家大报，又突然改变面目，采用现代设计方法，以满足人们“喜新厌旧”的心理。1938年，该报发行量突破了200万份，成为法国当时屈指可数的报纸之一。

上面这个例子对我们来说，具有极其宝贵的借鉴作用。因此我们讲报纸版面设计的作用不是可有可无，而是关系到报纸竞争生存的大问题。



Rare friendship offers sanctuary, survival during a lifetime behind institutional walls

Anyone who has driven through the town of Eldridge during the past 50 years knows them by sight if not by name — twin envoys in matching Glaxo caps, stationed at the stone pillars of Sonoma Developmental Center.

Slow down and they'll wave a hand. Lean out the window to call for the store and they'll reel off the listing, how many cows and who's on base.

The ubiquitous "Harry and David," so keenly fused it is impossible to imagine one without the other, have developed their seamless union over the years as a safe harbor in a system where the meek could be forgotten.

Consigned to the oblivion of the ward, they found one another. Day by day — each day for a half century — Harry and David forged a greater whole from parts society found flawed.

Life held little promise for Harry Balistreri and David Chong when their straggling immigrant parents left them at the Sonoma State Home back in the 1920s. The old school for the "feeble minded" by the Depression was becoming a catch basin for every social problem, from the mentally ill and orphans to the "lunatics" and juvenile delinquents.

Within that sterile vacuum, where the maddest were punished and the quiet ones ignored, Harry and David connected. Together they discovered a singular interdependency that has held both survival and emotional sanctuary.

Harry became the limbs for the weakened child he still calls "my boy." And David gave voice to speech-impaired Harry.

"He's the only guy who would listen to me," David says of his caretaker, best friend and life mate. "He's the only one who took the time to listen."

Their bond has bridged major shifts in attitude about the "mentally retarded" — from mass warehousing to the current thinking that the developmentally disabled have a right to choose, to whatever extent they are able, where, how and with whom they want to live.

This philosophical change awakened in David — after more than 60 years of institutionalization — a will to seize his remaining years and strike out on his own, an uneasy Harry in tow.

At an age when many of their contemporaries are selling their homes and seeking more secure quarters, these two senior citizens — Harry, 78, David, 66 — this summer embarked on a remarkable and at times frightening 8-mile journey that took them from the safe predictability of the state hospital to their first bachelor apartment, two blocks from the Sonoma Plaza.

They were led by the president of the United States, President Bill Clinton, who had not come to Jerusalem before.



Powell would sweep state, News poll shows

1. 正文

正文是构成报纸版面的基本素材，也是重要因素之一。因为无论怎样重要的信息，都要通过正文才能表达和传递得更加明确和充分。所以正文首先要考虑到读者的阅读方便和习惯。例如正文的字符不易太小，太大的正文文字虽然可以增大版面容量，但读者阅读起来会很吃力，因而放弃阅读。从版面的视觉形式方面要求，太大的正文文字又会造成一种无机理效果，文字与空白，边框分辨不清，起不到“平原草地”的色调铺垫作用，同时也会给读者一种不受尊重，难以悦目的感觉。正文文字当然也不可过大，太大的正文文字不仅浪费有限的版面，使容量锐减，还可能给读者造成粗糙，不精致，缺少理智等感觉。在视觉形式上也破坏了正文与各类标题字之间的第次关系，更起不到美妙的灰色基调的作用。

以中文为例，我国目前报纸版面多以5号报宋体字为正文字级及字体标准。间或插入5号黑体、楷体字等。版面以4开为主，版芯可容纳5号汉字大约14000多字。当然，这也不是一成不变的。例如近年来，国内许多报纸为了给读者以新鲜感受，也采用5号长一、5号扁一等为正文基本字形，读者反映良好。

正文文字的粗细，以及字距，行距，是要按版面呈现效果和人们阅读要求来不断试验，不断调整完善的。

2. 标题

最早的印刷物是没有那么多明显标题的，所以说标题是报纸发展演变的产物。为了使文章主题更加抓人，更加突出；为了使文章有个明确的开始和终结标志，标题才越演越烈。发展到今天，甚至有些现代派报纸，把标题当成版面构成的主要因素。如大标题、二标题、肩题、眉题、多标题、标题新闻等应运而生，用以招徕读者，方便阅读，强化注意。

标题从版面构成的视觉形式方面看，可比作是地球上的高山或沟壑。尤其是标题与留白之间所形成的强烈的衬托对比，更是版面视觉停顿、休息、呼吸等重要方法。加上标题位置的不同设计安排，标题可演绎出许多风格和效果，为版面争彩。

标题字不宜太多，标题字要更有文采，达到鲜明而有力，这些也是至关重要的。



How a thistle from sunny Spain came to thrive in foggy Castroville

CASTROVILLE—At first glance—or even second glance—this burg doesn't look like much. Though it is located no more than a couple of miles from the ocean and less than 10 miles from the tourist havens of Monterey and Carmel, it is, in routine, just another Midwestern farm town transplanted west to the west.

That, of course, is its charm. Just when you think they've passed the entire state, here is a reminder of California's agricultural history, a reminder of how things used to be. There's one main street that is no more than a mile in length, and what passes for downtown is no more than a couple blocks. There's a junk

store, a bar, a small grocery store, an old office building and a track-of-the-century school that has been converted into a pretty good restaurant. At the highway end of town, there are opposing semi-malls. Though there is a vibrant street, the last picture show is long closed. Mostly there is fog, a deep, thick fog that for most of the year rolls in just after sundown and lasts until mid-morning. It's a fog that blankets the rolling hills and none even the vivid sea green of the surrounding fields to monochrome.

图片、图表和插图在版面上起着重要的形象展示作用。尤其是图片的运用，可以给版面带来的纵深感，真是同江河湖海有一样的效果。报纸新闻报道的样式中，图片的形态是最能在版面上产生视觉形式感的。新闻摄影的出现，改变了报纸的面貌和命运，报纸的形象新闻从此开始大显身手。从世界各国，到目前的中国，“图文并重”已得到广泛的承认。版面优劣的标准也多以运用图片、图表、插图的情况而论。图片等在报纸版面上的位置，大小，多少，运用得恰当与否？都是评价一张报纸综合水平的重要标志。现代的报纸多以大图片、多图片为时尚。大的图片在视觉上确能造成重视情感的印象，可以引起人们的兴趣，使人舒服愉快。大凡有朝气的版面，都是用好的图片创造出来的。版面增加图片数量，放大图片使用，可以使版面活泼丰富起来。多照片的应用，还要注意形成大小对比，主次搭配需非常明显，否则会给读者造成分散注意力的感觉。

Everglades bike trail brings you near a wild variety of life

MASH—The steady hiss of trikelets hidden in the Everglades' mangroves sounded like the hiss of electric current, and the midday Florida heat made the humid air shimmer and rise. Up ahead of us, the marauding bicycle path seemed twisted in this distorting motion, contradicting our tour map that showed the curvated leg of the 16-mile Shark Valley trail as as straight as a Mississippi arrow.

We had pedaled no more than a half mile along the pancake flat trail into the Everglades when we saw it. At a distance, the dark clump entering the right-hand half of the trail appeared to be a fallen tree trunk or a large blackened palm frond. As we pedaled closer, however, the outline of the object became clearer: an elongated snout flared into a humped, muscular midsection, then tapered sharply to a tail that curved like a serpent's.

When we closed to within 50 yards, there was no mistaking it: The object stretched horizontally across our path was a large alligator, with an appearance so terrifying that by comparison the snarl of a Dalmatian would seem welcoming. The attention skin along the gator's 12-foot-long body was as dry as dirt. Looking closer, we could clearly see the short, powerful legs covered with porcupine scales and the wart-like bumps along the ridge of its back. It appeared to be sleeping, or else poised for attack.

To the left, the road—a soggy mangrove meadow—stretched to the horizon, dotted here and there with clumps of vegetation and hardwood trees known as hammocks. To



4、报头

报头的设计，关系到报纸的面貌和品位，成功的报头设计，可以带动整个报纸的版面安排和形象，成为这张报纸的标志和灵魂。

报头的样式多种多样，从位置上分有左右、上下、半栏、通栏；从方向上分又有横竖、居中；从风格表情上分还有庄重、活泼、艺术或逻辑的。总之报头放在何处，设计成什么风格，都要由办报人最后想达到的各种目的而定。譬如，有的报纸要靠报头设计来推销报纸；有的要靠报头设计来带动版面走向；有的报头设计是专门考虑为了广告客户来多登广告等等。

从功能含量上来看，报头除给读者明确的识别报纸作用之外，中间还可参入一些附带的信息。如日历，天气预报，刊号、邮发代号及主办单位等。许多新型的报纸版面呈现出多样化的风格，报头在此也展现了各自的风采。


5、栏数、框、线

版面在规定了每栏字数、栏数以及框、线的使用原则之后，构成版面的基本形式骨架也就形成了。例如，是横排栏，还是竖排栏？是六栏、七栏，还是五栏、八栏？都将决定着将来版面编排及演绎的效果。一般的报纸在上述规则被确定后，会有一个明确的版式作标纸，并且是编辑与设计人员在版面上安排文、图走向的骨架或暗轨。“至于死地而后生”的方法就是又有规矩，又有创造。当然，没有按骨骼框架走栏划版的成功例子也屡见不鲜。但是为了生产和制作工艺的方便，为了尊重大多数人的阅读习惯，骨骼框架式的排版方法是最能被编辑者和读者所接受的。

框与线在版面划分，区域间隔上起着重要的作用。因为框与线有着同墙一样的效果，在杂乱版面中设计上框线，若干版块便被清楚地划分出来，给读者以清晰有序的感觉。框线的成功运用，也可使版面有很强的方向感和风格化。框线在版面上是一种视觉支撑，如同人能站立，要靠骨架起作用一样。在实际运用当中，框线的粗细、多少、长短，也要视具体情况而定，根据内容的不同来发挥其作用。
