

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前 言

本书是一本针对全国高等教育自学考试公共类英语考试专科段的考前强化练习册。

高等教育白学考试是我国高等教育体系的一个组成部分,是国家鼓励自学成才的重要措施,自实施以来,为社会主义建设造就了大批人才,其文凭的含金量为社会所公认。但由于自学者的学习条件有限,要考出所有课程并非易事,特别是英语这门学科,相对其他课程而言及格率更低。这是因为英语是一种技能的学习,与其他学科有所不同,不仅要理解,还要大量、反复、持续地记忆。此外,自考英语又与一般水平考试,如大学四、六级、通用英语等考试有所不同,属于学业考试,考试的内容主要是围绕教材《大学英语自学教程》(高远主编)展开的。根据以上这些特点,本书按自学考试标准题型汇集了1000多道题目,供学生在考试前一段最为有效的时间里进行强化训练,将整本教材的内容从头至尾复习一遍,以帮助考生,特别是部分学理科的、非高中毕业的、外地来沪的以及年龄较长的考生顺利通过这门自考中难度较大的考试。

本书有如下特点:

一、提供可模仿信息

例如在翻译中:

中译英: 那些在事业上成功的人士在许多方面有类似之处。

第一步 提供可模仿信息

代词+who 定语从句

提示: succeed in sth. /career /be similar in

第二步 根据以上信息试着译出英语

第三步 提供答案 Those who have succeeded in their careers are similar in many ways. 以供核实,并将句子译回中文

第四步 要求摆脱提示、重新将该句译成英语

通过如此反复的中英互译,增强语感,提高对句型,词汇,词组的记忆能力。

二、循序渐进

如在语法部分的练习中,先安排时态、语态、非谓语动词、从句等分类练习,然后进行综合训练。

三. 词汇覆盖面大

在练习中尽量收集大纲与教科书中的词汇,并对少数大纲中有的,但教材中没出现过的词汇、词组进行了补充。

四、突出难点,反复交叉地展开练习

对于中英文语序的不同,英语后置修饰的定语、补足语、虚拟语气、各类 it 句、各种比较级等在学习过程中较难掌握的部分有意识地进行强调,通过多项选择、改错、填充、阅读理

解、翻译等项目,从各个角度对难点进行反复操练。

五,选题题材的广泛性与时事性

在照顾到大纲词汇的同时,注重选材的多样性、时事性,特别是"英译中"的练习部分。(惟有这一部分是大纲指定在考试时必须选自教材以外的文章。)在这一练习中收集了与课文内容相一致的科普、经济、社会、时事等方面的短文,锻炼学生英译中的能力。

六. 模拟试题仿真度高

2000年自学考试的题型有所变化,作者根据最新的题型,提供五套模拟试题,帮助考生适应考试中最新的变化。

本书作者有五年自考公共类英语专科段的授课经验,所教班级参加统考的及格率均高于平均及格率 30 个百分点以上。经过对自考大纲、教材、试卷的难点、难度以及自考学生情况的详细分析,作者积累了许多资料与经验,现将其集中于本书,以飨读者。相信在考前经过本书强化训练之后,读者将能从容通过英语考试,在充满挑战的自考道路上跨出一大步。

本书也可用作同等程度教材考前综合复习资料。
