本集共辑录了宋庆龄半个多世纪来的题词 103 条，其中大多数是在 1949 年新中国成立后题写的。从这些题词中，可以看到宋庆龄对祖国、对人民、对亿万儿童的伟大的爱。编辑这本选集是为了纪念敬爱的宋庆龄，为了学习和继承她把一生奉献给祖国和人民的革命精神。

这些题词有的选自历史文物资料，有的是向有关单位或个人征集来的。宋庆龄在长期的中国革命活动和同世界各国人民的友好交往中，一定还有不少珍贵的手迹留存在海内外。我们希望有关方面和人士能提供原稿或复制品，它将会丰富选集的内容。在此，谨向为编辑这本选集给予热情支持的单位和人士致谢。

Editor's Note

Selected Inscriptions of Soong Ching Ling contains 103 inscriptions of Soong Ching Ling in a period of more than half a century; most of them were done after the founding of New China in 1949. They are a witness to the great love of Soong Ching Ling for her country, people and the Chinese children. The collection is edited in commemoration of our beloved Soong Ching Ling; we will emulate and carry on her revolutionary spirit of dedicating the whole life to the people and motherland.

Some of the inscriptions are selected from historical relics and records and some from institutions or individuals. Soong Ching Ling worked for the Chinese revolution and the friendly relations between the Chinese people and the people of other countries in a long span of time; there must be still many other inscriptions of hers at home and abroad that we failed to collect. It is our wish that we could see these precious handwritings, no matter original or duplicate, provided by the holders. These new inscriptions will certainly enrich our collection. We would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge our sincere thanks to the institutions and individuals for their warm support to this collection.
